

Son of Surasā and Kaśyapa 5. 101. 4, 17; description 5-7; also listed by Sūta among the sons of Kadrū 1. 31. 15, 2.

**Trivāra** m. : A mythical bird, living in the world of Suparṇas 5. 99. 11, 1.

Born in the *kula* of Vainateya (Garuḍa), in the *vamśa* of Kaśyapa; feeding on serpents; marked with *śrīvatsa*, his deity is Viṣṇu; by action a Kṣatriya, not obtaining Brahminhood because indulging in destroying kinsmen 5. 99. 2-8.

**Dakṣa** m. : A mythical bird, living in the world of Suparṇas 5. 99. 12, 1.

Born in the *kula* of Vainateya (Garuḍa), in the *vamśa* of Kaśyapa; feeding on serpents; marked with *śrīvatsa*, his deity is Viṣṇu; by action a Kṣatriya, not obtaining Brahminhood because indulging in destroying kinsmen 5. 99. 2-8.

**Dadhimukha**<sup>1</sup> m. : A mythical serpent, living in Bhogavatī Purī 5. 101. 12, 1.

Son of Surasā and Kaśyapa 5. 101. 4, 17; description 5. 101. 5-7; also listed by Sūta among the sons of Kadrū 1. 31. 8, 2.

**Dadhimukha**<sup>2</sup> m. : A monkey-chief.

Lustrous (*śrīmān*); old in age, yet strong (*harivṛddho 'pi vīryavān*); he came to Rāma with a large army of fierce monkeys 3. 267. 7.

**Dakṣakanyā** f. (sg. and pl.) : Daughter(s) of Dakṣa.

Thirteen in number : Aditi, Diti, Danu, Kālā, Anāyus, Simhikā, Muni, Krodhā, Prāvā, Ariṣṭā, Vinatā, Kapilā, Kadrū 1. 59. 11-13.

**Dākṣāyaṇī**<sup>1</sup> f. : Daughter of Dakṣa.

Vinatā so called 1. 27. 24.

**Dākṣāyaṇī**<sup>2</sup> f. : Mother of Rājadharmān (Nādījaṅgha), the king of cranes, wife of Kaśyapa 12. 164. 2.

**Dākṣāyaṇī**<sup>3</sup> f. : Divine (*devī*); Surabhi so called 12. 167. 3.

**Dākṣeyī** f. : A mythical female bird.

Parrots, her progeny 13. 5. 12 ( identical with Śukī ? 1. 60. 57 ).

**Dāruṇa** m. : A mythical bird, living in the world of Suparṇas 5. 99. 9, 1.

Born in the *kula* of Vainateya (Garuḍa), in the *vamśa* of Kaśyapa; feeding on serpents; marked with *śrīvatsa*, his deity is Viṣṇu; by action a Kṣatriya, not obtaining Brahminhood because indulging in destroying kinsmen 5. 99. 2-8.

**Dilīpa** m. : A mythical serpent, living in Bhogavatī Purī 5. 101. 15, 1.

Son of Surasā and Kaśyapa 5. 101. 4, 17; description 5. 101. 5-7.

**Dīvākara** m. : A mythical bird, living in the world of Suparṇas 5. 99. 14, 1.

Born in the *kula* of Vainateya (Garuḍa), in the *vamśa* of Kaśyapa; feeding on serpents; marked with *śrīvatsa*, his deity is Viṣṇu; by action a Kṣatriya not obtaining Brahminhood because indulging in destroying kinsmen 5. 99. 2-8.

**Diśācakṣus** m. : A mythical bird living in the world of Suparṇas 5. 99. 10, 1.

Born in the *kula* of Vainateya (Garuḍa), in the *vamśa* of Kaśyapa; feeding on serpents; marked with *śrīvatsa*, his deity is Viṣṇu; by action a Kṣatriya not obtaining Brahminhood because indulging in destroying kinsmen 5. 99. 2-8.

**Dirghadarsin** adj. : ' One who has forethought '.
