Born in the kula of Vainateya (Garuda), in the vamsa of Kasyapa; feeding on serpents; marked with śrivatsa, his deity is Viṣṇu; by action a Kṣatriya, not obtaining Brahminhood because indulging in destroying kinsmen 5. 99. 2-8.

Daksa m.: A mythical bird, living in the world of Suparnas 5 99. 12, 1.

Born in the kula of Vainateya (Garuda), in the vamsa of Kasyapa; feeding on serpents; marked with *rīvatsa, his deity is Viṣṇu; by action a Kṣatriya, not obtaining Brahminhood because indulging in destroying kinsmen 5. 99. 2-8.

Dadhimukha¹ m.: A mythical serpent, living in Bhogavatī Purī 5.101.12, 1.

Son of Surasā and Kasyapa 5. 101. 4, 17; description 5. 101. 5-7; also listed by Sūta among the sons of Kadrū 1. 31. 8, 2.

Dadhimukha² m.: A monkey-chief.

Lustrous (śrīmān); old in age, yet strong (harivṛddho 'pi vīryavān); he came to Rāma with a large army of fierce monkeys 3.267.7.

Daksakanyā f. (sg. and pl.): Daughter(s) of Daksa

Thirteen in number: Aditi, Diti, Danu, Kālā, Anāyus, Simhikā, Muni, Krodhā, Prāvā, Ariṣṭā, Vinatā, Kapilā, Kadrū 1. 59. 11-13.

Dāksāyanī¹ f.: Daughter of Dakṣa. Vinatā so called 1. 27. 24.

Dākṣāyaṇī³ f.: Mother of Rājadharman (Nādījangha), the king of cranes, wife of Kaśyapa 12. 164. 2.

Dakṣayaṇi³ f.: Divine (devi); Surabhi so called 12.167, 3.

Dakseyi f.: A mythical female bird. Parrots, her progeny 13. 5. 12 (identical with Suki? 1. 60. 57).

Daruna m.: A mythical bird, living in the world of Suparnas 5. 99. 9, 1.

Born in the kula of Vainateya (Garuda), in the vainsa of Kasyapa; feeding on serpents; marked with śrīvutsa, his deity is Viṣṇu; by action a Kṣatriya, not obtaining Brahmihood because indulging in destroying kinsmen 5. 99. 2-8.

Dilipa m.: A mythical serpent, living in Bhogavatī Purī 5. 101. 15, 1.

Son of Surasā and Kasyapa 5. 101. 4, 17; description 5. 101. 5-7.

Divakara m.: A mythical bird, living in the world of Suparnas 5. 99. 14, 1.

Born in the *kula* of Vainateya (Garuḍa), in the *vaṁśa* of Kaśyapa; feeding on serpents; marked with śrīvatsa, his deity is Viṣṇu; by action a Kṣatrlya not obtaining Brahminhood because indulging in destroying kinsmen 5. 99. 2-8.

Disacaksus m.: A mythical bird living in the world of Suparnas 5. 99. 10, 1.

Born in the kula of Vainateya (Garuda), in the vamsa of Kasyapa; feeding on serpents; marked with śrīvatsa, his deity is Viṣṇu; by action a Kṣatriya not obtaining Brahminhood because indulging in destroying kinsmen 5. 99. 2-8.

Dīrghadarśin adj. : 'One who has fore-thought'.
