day of the war, a little before the fall of Bhisma, twelve Janapadas, among whom were Abhisāhas, Śūrasenas, Śibis and Vasatis, who did not forsake Bhisma, fighting with Arjuna, though they were themselves pierced by arrows and wounded (abhisāhāh śūrasenāh śibayo 'tha vasātayah | ... dvādašaite janapadāh šarārtā vranapīditāh / samgrāme na jahur bhismam yudhyamānam kiritinā //) 6. 114. 76-77; (5) On the fourteenth day of the war, Abhisāhas, Śūrasenas, Śibis and Vasātis were among the tens of thousands of charioteers who followed Kamboja and Śrutayu(dha) who attempted to arrest the march of Arjuna towards Jayadratha; then there was a fierce fight (esām dasasahastrāni rathānām anuyāyinām / abhi sāhāh sūrasenāh śibayo 'tha vasātayah | ... maheşvāsam parākrāntam naravyāghram avārayan || tatah pravavrte yuddham tumulam) 7. 66. 37, 41-43; (6) When Srutayudha and Sudaksina (a Kāmboja) were killed by Arjuna, Abhlsahas, Surasenas, Sibis and Vasatis showered arrows on Arjuna; when Arjuna retaliated, afraid, they ran away; however, they returned and surrounded Arjuna; Arjuna cut off their heads and arms (abhi sāhāh sūrasenāh sibayo 'tha vasātayah / abhyavarşams ... saravarşair dhanamjayam // ... te sma bhi tāh palāyanta ... | te nivṛtya punah pārtham sarvatah paryavārayan //) 7.68.2-6; after the fall of Javadratha, Duryodhana referred to this incident and said that Abhisahas and others had given their life for his sake while fighting with Arjuna (abhi sāhāh sūrasenāh sibayo 'tha yasatayah ... hata madartham samgrāme yudhyamānāh kiritinā //) 7. 125. 31-32: (7) In the night war, Abhlsahas,

Ambaştha m. (pl.): Name of Janapada whose warriors sided with the Kauravas.

A. Location: To the west of Khāndavaprasthāt praticim abhito disam) 2.29.2; at one place they are reckoned among those who lived in the northwest (sāmbaṣṭhāḥ pratīcyodicyavāsinaḥ) 7.6.6. B. Characterization: Referred to as a Janapada (sālvā matsyās tathāmbaṣṭhās ... dvādasaite janapadāḥ) 6.18.13-14; 6.114.77; called Kṣatriyas (ambaṣṭhāḥ ... kṣatriyāḥ) 2.48.14, 16; 6.20.10; according to Parāsara they were a
