Augirasa m. : See Angiras.

Ajamīdha m. (pl.): The descendants of Ajamīdha, the family of Ajamīdha.

Epic events: (1) All the kings who had gathered for the Rajasuya congratulated Yudhisthira on completion of the sacrifice and said that he augmented the fame of Ajamidhas (ājamidhānām yasah samvardhitam tvayā) 2. 42. 36; (2) Krsna referred to Kuntl who, as daughter of Sura (and wife of Pandu), had gone over to the Ajamidha family (śūrasya rājno duhitā ājamidhakulam gatā) 5. 88. 90; (3) Draupadl referred to herself as the daughter of Drupada who, as the chief queen of the Pandavas, had gone to the Ajamidha family (sutā drupadarājasya ... ājamī dhakulam prāptā ... mahisi panduputrānām) 5. 80. 22.

Ajyapa m. (pl.): A class of deities.

Mentioned by Kṛṣṇa among those gods who were the creation of Siva ( devāh ... ājyapāś ca // ... śarvāj jātam viddhi tat kirtitam me //) 13. 18. 51, 53.

Atreya m. (sg., pl.): Name of a Janapada and a family of rsis.

(1) Janapada: One of the northern Janapadas of the Bhāratavarşa listed by Samjaya (ata ūrdhvam janapadān nibodha gadato mama) 6. 10. 37, 5; (uttarās ca) 6. 10. 63; (ātreyāh sabharadvājāh) 6. 10. 67; (2) Rṣis: The Atreyas are described as those who observed the best vows (ātreyās cottamavratāh) 3. 27. 8; they are listed by Baka Dālbhya among the Brāhmaņas who gathered around Yudhişthira in Dvaitavana 3. 27. 1, 5; all the Brāhmaņas are said to be ascetics; they observed vows in the holy Dvaita forest and practised

dharma under the protection of Yudhisthira; they were also the best Brahmanas in the whole world (pasya dvaitavane pārtha brāhmanānām tapasvinām /... caranti dharmam punye 'smim's tvayā guptā dhrtavratāh /... sarvasya jagatah šresthā brāhmaṇāḥ samgatās tvayā) 3. 27. 7-8; the sound of the loud recitation of the yajus, re, samans and of prose formulae was pleasing (yajuṣām rcām ca sāmnām ca gadyānām caiva sarvatah | āsīd uccāryamānānām nisvano hrdayamgamah //) 3.27. 3; (3) Rsis who were descendants of Atri: (i) Kundajathara (ātreyah kundajatharah) 1. 48. 8; (ii) Kaundinya (ātreyas tv atha kaundinyah) 3.83.102.

Adidaya m. (pl.): Name of a Janapada and its people.

One of the southern Janapadas of the Bharatavarşa listed by Samjaya for the information of Dhrtaraştra (ata ūrdhvam janapadān nibodha gadato mama) 6. 10, 37. 5; (athāpare janapadā dakṣiṇāḥ) 6. 10. 56; (ādīdāyāḥ sirālās ca) 6. 10. 62.

Adiraștra m. (pl.): Name of a Jana-

Listed by Samjaya among the (northern) Janapadas of the Bharatavarsa (ata urdhvam janapadan nibodha gadato mama) 6. 10. 37, 5; (ādirāṣṭrāḥ sukuṭṭāś ca) 6. 10. 43; also called deśa (uddeśamātreṇa mayā deśāḥ samkirtitāḥ) 6. 10. 68.

Anarta m. (pl., once sg. 3. 180. 25); Name of a country and its people.

A. Location: One of the (northern) Janapadas of the Bhāratavarşa listed by Samjaya (ata ūrdhvam janapadān nibodha gadato mama) 6. 10. 37, 5; (tathaivānartanairṛtāh) 6. 10. 50; also called deśa 6.
