Kalinga⁹ m. (pl.): Name of a Janapada.

Location: Listed by Samjaya among the northern Janapadas (also called Deśas deśāḥ samkī rtitāḥ 6. 10. 68) of the Bhāratavarṣa (ata ūrdhvam janapadān nibodha gadato mama) 6. 10. 37, 5; (śūrasenāḥ kalingāś ca) 6. 10. 38; these seem to be the Kalingas of the mid-region and are to be distinguished from Kalinga¹ and Kalinga³. [See Kalinga¹, 8]

Kalinga³ m. (pl.): Name of a people. A. Location: They probably lived in the north-west since they are listed by Samjaya along with Kāśmiras, Tukhāras and the Kirāta tribes (kāśmīrāh ... tukhāraś ca ...//... kalingāś ca kirātānām ca jātayah //) 6. 10. 67. B. Characterization: (1) They were probably reckoned by Samjaya as mlecchas (uttarās cāpare mlecchāh) 6, 10. 63; (2) Bhisma counted Kalingas among those who became degraded since they did not respect Brāhmaņas (kalingās ca ... / ... vṛṣalatvam parigatā brāhmanānām adarśanāt) 13. 30. 20-21; (3) A certain Brāhmana told the Kuru assembly that Kalinga people were to be avoided as they followed wrong dharma (kalingān ... durdharmām's ca vivarjayet) 8. 30. 45. [See Kalinga^{1, 2}]

Kalkala m. (pl.): Name of a Janapada.

Listed by Samjaya among the southern Janapadas, (also called Desas desah sam-

kīrtitāḥ 6. 10. 68) of the Bhārstavarṣa (athāpare janapadā dakṣiṇāḥ) 6. 10. 56; (pulindāḥ kalkalaiḥ saha) 6. 10. 60.

Kaśyapadvipa nt : Name of a dvipa.

Two parts of the Sudarśanadvipa are like a large hare; the Kaśyapadvipa forms one of the two 'ears' of this hare (evam sudarśanadvipo ... | ... dviramse ca saso mahān) 6. 6. 15-16; (karnau tu nāgadvipam ca kaśyapadvipam eva ca) 6. 7. 52.

Kahva m. (pl.): Name of a people.

According to king Māndhātr they lived in the countryside but led the life of Dasyus (kahvāś ca... sarve viṣayavāsinah... sarve te dasyujī vinah) 12.65.13,15; he asked Indra the nature of their dharma and how they were to be controlled by kings like him (katham dharmam careyus te... madvidhaiś ca katham sthāpyāh...) 12.65.15; Indra then told Māndhātr the dharma of the Dasyus 12.6.17-21.

Kākṣa m. (pl.): Name of a Janapada.
One of the (northern) Janapadas (also called Deśas (uddeśamātreṇa mayā deśāḥ samkīrtitāḥ 6. 10. 68) of the Bhāratavarṣa listed by Samjaya (ata ūrdhvam janapadān nibodha gadato mama) 6. 10. 37, 5; (kākṣāḥ sāmudraniṣkuṭāḥ) 6. 10. 47.

Kañcya m. (pl.): Name of a people.

Listed by Ulūka among those warriors no joined the army of Duryodhana (rāja-

who joined the army of Duryodhana (rāja-camūm sametām | ... draviḍāndhrakāñcyaiḥ) 5. 153. 19-20.

Kānana m. (pl.): Name of a people.

On the third day of the war, Kānanas were stationed at the left wing of the Garudavyūha of the Kaurava army (gāru-
