the Sabhā (ete hi sarve kuravah sametāh) 2. 68. 12; 7. 107. 13; in the Kuru assembly, Karna reviled Draupadi as the wife of the Dasas ( sabhamadhye ... dasabharyeti pāncālim abravit kurusamsadi) 8. 5. 79; Karna spoke bad words to Draupadi in the presence of the Kuru heroes in the assembly (sabhāyām kuruvīramadhye) 8. 46. 39: the Kurus, including Dhrtarastra, were dejected when Draupadi sought help (in the Sabhā) 15. 23. 12; Dhrtarāstra remembered what Bhlma vowed to do within the hearing of the Kurus (kurūnām śrnyatām tadā) 7. 110. 16; Duryodhana vowed in the midst of the assembly that the kingdom of five rivers would be of Yudhisthira if he carried out the terms of the second game of dice, and if the Kauravas were defeated they would live out for the same period (bravimi satyam kurusamsadi ha tavaiva tā bhārata pañca nadyah) 3. 35, 10-11; it was not proper to act contrary to what was agreed upon in the midst of the Kuru heroes (kuruvi ramadhye) 3. 35. 18; Duḥśāsana addressed the Pāndavas as 'cow, cow' in the midst of the Kurus (madhye kurunām ... gaur gaur iti smāhvayan muktalajjah) 2. 68. 19; 5. 126. 10; 5, 135, 21; 9, 58, 7 (Ni, on Bom. Ed. 2. 77. 19: madhuparke gaur gaur iti trir niveditāyā gor vadha utsargas ca drstah I tatsāmānyāt antakarūpāyātithaye niveditāh / pāndavapasava utsṛṣṭāḥ / ); the Kurus in the Sabha were fortunate that they were not burnt down by Draupadi (by the fire of her anger) 2. 70. 6; Narada cursed the Kauravas in the midst of the Kuru assembly (sabhā madhye kurūnām agratah sthitah) 2. 71. 29; Duryodhana and Karna spoke harsh words to Drau-

padl in the Kuru samsad 2, 72, 17; that the Kurus were not killed before, tormented Bhima's heart 4, 20, 3; Arjuna challenged Karna to carry out everything of which he boasted in the midst of the Kurus 4. 55, 3; the Kurus in the assembly did very sinful things (karma pāpīya eva sabhāmadhye ... kurūnām) 5. 29. 30; the Kurus, chief among whom was Bhisma, ignored the harassment of Draupadi (in the assembly) 5. 29. 31; Duryodhana offended Bhima in the presence of the Kuru chiefs (pasyatām kurumukhyānām) 5, 88, 82; the pieces of dice which Sakuni threw in the Kuru assembly were, in fact, arrows and the Kurus assembled there, as gamblers, formed the army of Duryodhana (kuravah paryavasthitāh | senām durodaram viddhi) 7. 105. 16-17 (Ni. on Bom. Ed. 7. 130. 18: durodaram dyūtakārinam): Duryodhana and Sakuni had invited the wrath of the Pandavas in the Kuru samsad 7. 126. 18; 2. Kurus in their general Sabhā at Hāstinapura: Dhrtarāstra seated among the Kurus (in the Sabha) was to be informed that the Pandavas lived happily due to his prowess (āsinam kurubhih parivāritam | tavaiva rājan viryena sukham jivanti pāndavāh //) 5. 31. 5; also Duryodhana seated with the Kurus (in the Sabha) to be told not to force the Pandavas to kill the Kurus (madhye kurunam asinam ... mā vadhisma kurūn iti) 5.31.12-13; Kurus were to hear Yudhisthira's message brought by Samjaya in the Sabha (pratah śrotarah kuravah sabhāyām) 5. 32. 30; Pāndavas, through Samjaya, greeted all the Kurus in the order of their age 5. 46. 15: Arjuna's message to be conveyed to Duryodhana in the midst of the Kurus 5, 47, 3; when
