Dhrtarāstra paid no heed to what Bhisma and Drona said, all the Kurus (in the Sabha) lost hope of their lives 5. 48. 47; Samjaya was asked in the Sabha of the Kuru assembly who were the allies of the Pandavas (sabhayam kurusamsadi) 5. 49. 10; Samjaya addressed Dhrtarastra in the Sabha of the Kurus 5. 49. 13; Bhisma spoke to Duryodhana among the Kurus (madhye kurunām) 5. 61. 14; Krsna agreed to go to the assembly of the Kurus (yāsyāmi kurusamsadam) 5.70.79; Kṛṣṇa to address Duryodhana in the midst of the Kurus (kurumadhye) 5. 78. 11; the divine sages and the royal sages desired to listen to the words which Kṛṣṇa would speak to the kings among the Kurus (kurusu rājamadhye) 5. 81. 69; Kṛṣṇa joked with the Kurus and, surrounded by them, established contact with them (sarvān parihasan kurun | aste sambandhakam kurvan kurubhih parlvāritah) 5. 87. 20 (Ni. on Bom. Ed. 5. 89. 20: parihasan narma kurvan sāmbandhikam dhanañ jayādisambandhahetukam vyavahāram); Kṛṣṇa had his initial contact with the Kurus in their assembly after his arrival at Hastinapura (kurubhih kurusamsadi) 5. 87. 22; Kṛṣṇa assured Vidura that he would try for conciliation between Kurus and Srnjayas who would otherwise perish in war (kurunam srhjayanam ca samgrāme vinašisyatām) 5. 91. 8; Krsna honoured by the Kurus while proceeding to the Sabha; he honoured them duly in return (sampūjyamānah kurubhih ... yathārham pratisatkurvan) 5. 92. 26; Krsna covered the Kurus in the Sabhā with his lustre 5. 92. 32; Kurus honoured Kṛṣṇa 5. 92. 39; after Kṛṣṇa, Jāmadagnya and Kanva addressed the Kuru assembly (kurusamsadi) 5. 94. 3; 5. 95. 1; Duryodhana replied to Kṛṣṇa in the Kuru assembly (kurusamsadi) 5. 125. 1; Krsna's rejoinder in the Kuru assembly 5. 126. 1; later in the epic, Kṛṣṇa reported to Uttanka that he had tried to frighten the Kurus pointing out the great danger they faced 14. 53. 20; Duḥśāsana spoke to Duryodhana in the Kuru assembly (kurusamsadi) 5. 126. 21; according to Kṛṣṇa, all the Kuru elders had seriously transgressed (the correct path) (sarveşām kuruvrddhānām mahān ayam atikramah) 5. 126. 33; Vidura alerted Dhrtarastra in the Kuru assembly (kurusamsadi) 5. 128. 17; Dhrtarastra and others were witness to what transpired in the Kuru assembly (pratyaksam etad bhavatām yad vṛttam kurusamsadi) 5. 129. 30; in the presence of the Kurus (of the Sabha) Kṛṣṇa left to meet Kunti 5. 129. 34; Kṛṣṇa reported to her what transpired in the Kuru assembly 5. 130.1; when Kṛṣṇa left, the Kurus of the assembly talked among themselves about the great wonder shown by Kṛṣṇa in the Sabhā 5. 135. 25; when Kṛṣṇa proceeded from the Kurus to the Pandavas, Vidura lamented in the presence of Kuntl 5. 142. 1; Kṛṣṇa reported to Yudhişthira what transpired in the Sabha of Kurus and also what Bhisma said (madhye kurunam ... sabhayam 5. 145. 13; (yad vrttam kurusamsadi) 5. 148. 6, 18; Uluka said that time had come for Arjuna to prove his boast reported by Samjaya to the Kurus 5. 157. 5; he also reported what Duryodhana had asked him, within the hearing of the Kuru heroes, to convey to the Pandavas (smvatam kuruvirānām) 5. 158. 6; 5. 160. 10; Duryodhana's consultations with Karna and others in
