

milk and water). — *Kshira-pa*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, drinking milk, who or what drinks milk; epithet of a class of ascetics; an infant, a young child. — *Kshira-paryin*, *ī*, *m*. the plant Calotropis Gigantea; [cf. *arka* and *kshira-dala*.] — *Kshira-palāndu*, *us*, *m*. a kind of onion. — *Kshira-pāka*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, *Ved*. cooked in milk. — *Kshira-pāṇa*, *āś*, *m*, *pl*. the milk-drinkers, an epithet of the Uśnaraś; (*am*), *n*. drinking milk; (*as*, *ī*, *am*), any vessel out of which milk is drunk.

— *Kshira-pāṇi*, *is*, *m*, *N*. of a physician. — *Kshira-pāyin*, *ī*, *ī*, *i*, drinking or sucking milk; drinking or imbibing water repeatedly; (*inas*), *m*, *pl*. the milk-drinkers, an epithet of the Uśnaraś. — *Kshira-bhṛita*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, supported by milk, receiving wages in the form of milk. — *Kshira-maya*, *as*, *ī*, *am*, composed of milk. — *Kshira-močaka*, *us*, *m*. a kind of Moringa, *M*. Hyperanthera; [cf. *močaka*.]

— *Kshira-moraṭa*, *as*, *m*. a kind of creeping plant; [*cf. sitadru*, *sudala*, *kshiraka*.] — *Kshira-yashṭika*, *am*, *n*. a dish of liquorice and milk; (perhaps a wrong form for *kshira-hashṭika*?). — *Kshiratātā*, *f*. the plant Batatas Paniculata; [cf. *kshiravidārī*.] — *Kshira-rat*, *ān*, *ātī*, *at*, *Ved*. furnished with milk; (*ī*), *f*, *N*. of a river. — *Kshira-valli*, *f*. the dark Bhuiocoön, Convolvulus Paniculatus. — *Kshira-vāri*, *is*, *m*. the sea of milk; [*cf. kshiroda*.] — *Kshira-vāridhi*, *is*, *m*. the sea of milk. — *Kshira-vikriti*, *is*, *f*. insipid milk. — *Kshira-vidārī* or *kshira-vidārī*, *f*. the plant Batatas Paniculata. — *Kshira-vishāṇikā*, *f*. the plants Tragia Involucrata (= *vrisicākali*) and *kshira-kākoli*. — *Kshira-vriksha*, *as*, *m*. the glomerous fig tree, *Ficus Glomerata* [*cf. udumbara*]; a common *N*. for the four trees *nyagrodha*, *udumbara*, *āsvattha*, and *madhūka*. — *Kshira-vrata*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, living upon milk in consequence of a vow. — *Kshira-sāra*, *as*, *m*. cream, the surface or skim of milk, curds; [*cf. āmikshā*.] — *Kshira-sīrsha*, *as*, *m*. the resin of the plant *Plums Longifolia*; [*cf. śrī-vāsa*.]

— *Kshira-sukrā*, *f* = *kshira-vidārī* and *kshira-kākoli*. — *Kshira-sukta*, *as*, *m*. the plant *Trapa Bispinosa* [*cf. jala-kaṇṭaka*]; another plant, = *rājādāni*; (*ā*), *f*. the plant Batatas Paniculata. — *Kshira-srī*, *is*, *īs*, *i*, *Ved*. mixed with milk. — *Kshira-shashṭika*, *am*, *n*. Shashṭika rice cooked in milk. — *Kshira-santāñikā*, *f*. curds mixed with milk; (a various reading has *santālikā*). — *Kshira-samudra*, *as*, *m*. the sea of milk in *Sveta-dipa*. — *Kshira-sarpis*, *is*, *n*. clarified butter mixed with milk. — *Kshira-sāgara*, *as*, *m*. the ocean of milk; also *N*. of a place. — *Kshirasāgara-sutā*, *f*. an epithet of Lakṣmi as produced from the ocean of milk. — *Kshira-sāra*, *as*, *m*. essence of milk, any product of milk, (in Hindi *pālajīnu*), butter. — *Kshira-sphatīka*, *as*, *m*. a precious stone, described as a kind of milky crystal (opal or cat's eye?); [*cf. ākāśa-sphatīka* and *taila-sphatīka*.] — *Kshiravāminī*, *ī*, *m*, *N*. of a grammarian and commentator on the *Amara-kosha*. — *Kshira-hrada*, *as*, *m*, *N*. of a man. — *Kshirāda* (*ra-ada*), *as*, *m*. an infant at the breast, a sucking child. — *Kshirānnāda* (*ra-anna-ada*), *as*, *m*. an infant which is both fed and suckled. — *Kshirābhdhi* (*ra-abdhī*), *īs*, *m*. the sea of milk, one of the seven seas surrounding the seven divisions of the terrestrial world. — *Kshirābhdhi-jā*, *as*, *m*. the moon; the Amṛita or any one of the precious objects produced at the churning of the ocean; an epithet of Śeṣa; an epithet of Tārkṣya; (*ā*), *f*. an epithet of Lakṣmi; (*am*), *n*. sea-salt, a pearl. — *Kshirābhdhi-tanayā*, *f*. or *kshirābhdhi-mānushī*, *f*. an epithet of Lakṣmi as the daughter of the ocean of milk. — *Kshirāvaha* or *kshirāhvaya* (*ra-āhō*), *as*, *m*. the resin of the plant *Pinus Longifolia*. — *Kshiroda* (*ra-uda*), *as*, *ā*, *am*, containing milk instead of water; (*as*), *m*. the sea of milk; the sea in general. — *Kshiroda-tanayā*, *f*. the daughter of the sea of milk; an epithet of Lakṣmi. — *Kshiroda-tanayā-pati*, *is*, *m*. an epithet of Viṣṇu. — *Kshiroda-bhī* (*ra-ud'*), *is*, *m*. the sea of milk. — *Kshiroda-nandana*, *as*, *m*. the son of the sea of milk, an epithet of the moon.

— *Kshiroda-mathana*, *am*, *n*. the churning of the ocean of milk undertaken by the Devas and Asuras to obtain the Amṛita &c. — *Kshiroṁśi* (*ra-ūr'*), *is*, *m*. a wave of milk, a wave of the sea of milk. — *Kshiraudana* (*ra-od'*), *as*, *m*. rice boiled with milk. — *Kshiraka*, *as*, *m*, *N*. of a plant, = *kshiramorata*.

*Kshiraya*, nom. *P. kshirayati*, *-yitum*, to have the appearance of milk, look like milk.

*Kshiraya*, *as*, *m*. = *kshirā-vāra*, *q.v.*

*Kshirasya*, nom. *P. kshirasyati*, *-yitum*, to long for milk or for the breast.

*Kshirāvī* or *kshirāvīkā*, *f*. a sort of Asclepias, *A. Rosea*, = *dugdhīkā*.

*Kshirika*, *as*, *m*. a kind of serpent; a kind of tree; (*ā*), *f*. a dish prepared with milk; a kind of Datura tree; [*cf. kshirā-kharjūra* and *pindakharjūra*.]

*Kshirin*, *ī*, *īnī*, *i*, milky, yielding milk, abounding in milk, having plenty of milk; containing milky juice or sap (as a tree); (*ī*), *m*. a species of tree, the *Udumbara* (?); according to native lexicographers many plants have this epithet; (*īnī*), *f*. a tree bearing an edible fruit, = *Mimusops Kauki*; a species of the moon-plant or acid Asclepias used in medicine.

*Kshirīya*, nom. *P. kshiriyati*, *-yitum*, to desire milk.

*Kshirīsa*, *as*, *m*. = *kshirā-kāntukin*.

*Kshireyī*, *f*. an oblation of milk, rice, and sugar.

**स्त्रीव** *kshīv*, *cl. 1. 4. P. kshīvati*, *kshevati* and *kshīvati*, *-vītum*, to spit, spatter, eject from the mouth; to be drunk or intoxicated; [*cf. kshīv*, *kshev*, *kshīb*, *shīv*; cf. also *Hib. siobhas*, 'rage, madness.']

*Kshīva* or *kshība*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, excited, drunk, intoxicated. — *Kshīva-ta*, *f*. or *kshīva-tva*, *am*, *n*. intoxication, drunkenness.

**सू** *1. kshu*, *cl. 2. P. kshauti*, *ćukshāvā*, *kshavishyati*, *akshāvīt*, *kshavitum*, to sneeze, to make any sound like sneezing; to cough. — *Caus. kshāvayati*: Desid. of *Caus. cūkshāvayishati*; [*cf. Lith. czaudmī*.]

*Kshava*, *as*, *m*. sneezing, cough, catarrh; a black species of mustard, *Sinapis Dichotoma*; [*cf. rājīkā*.]

*Kshava-krit*, *t*, *t*, *t*, anything which causes sneezing; making a sneeze, sneezing, coughing.

*Kshavaka*, *as*, *m*. the plant *Achyranthes Aspera*, = *apāmārga*, black mustard; (*am*), *n*. a kind of pot-herb; (*īkā*), *f*. a kind of *Solanum*; a species of rice; a woman.

*Kshavartha*, *us*, *m*. sneezing; catarrh; congh; irritation of the throat; sore throat.

*Kshut*, *t*, *f*. a sneeze, sneezing. — *Kshut-kari*, *f*, *N*. of a plant, commonly *kankālīkā*, black mustard (?).

*Kshuta*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, one who has sneezed; sneezed upon; (as a less correct form for *kshēvuta*), sharp; (*as*, *ā*, *am*), *m*, *f*. a sneeze, sneezing, cough.

*Kshutā-vat*, *ān*, *ātī*, *at*, sneezing. — *Kshutābhijanana* (*ta-abhī*), *as*, *m*. black mustard; [*cf. kshudhābhijanana*.]

*Kshutaka*, *as*, *m*. black mustard.

*Kshuti*, *is*, *f*. sneezing.

*Kshuvat*, *an*, *ātī*, *at*, sneezing, coughing, &c.

**घ** *2. kshu*, *n*. (fr. *ghas*?), *Ved*. food.

*Kshu-mat*, *ān*, *ātī*, *at*, *Ved*. abounding in food, nourishing, nutritious; strong; powerful, robust, valiant.

**चुण** *kshupa*, *as*, *m*. the soap-berry plant, *Sapindus Saponaria*; [*cf. arishṭa*.]

**चुण** *kshunna*. See below under *kshud*.

**सूर** *kshud*, *cl. 7. P. A. and Ved. cl. 1. P. kshud*, *kshunattī*, *kshunte*, *kshodati*, *ćukshoda*, *ćukshude*, *kshotyati*, *-te*, *akshudat*, *akshautīt*, *akshutta*, *kshottum*, to strike against, stamp or trample upon, pound; to bruise, crush, shiver, shatter, reduce to powder, dash to pieces, shake by stamping

on; *A*, to move, to be agitated or shaken: Caus. *P. kshodayati*, *-yitum*, to crush, pound, comminute, pulverize, reduce to powder, diminish; shake or agitate by stamping; [*cf. Gr. ξεω, ξέω for ξεω, ξερός, ξερός*; Lith. *skausti*?].

*Kshunna*, *as*, *ā*, *am*. pounded, bruised, crushed, stamped or trampled upon; broken to pieces, pulverized, shattered, pierced; violated (as a vow); exercised, practised, skilful; one versed in sacred science but unable to explain or teach it; defeated, overcome.

— *Kshunna-manas*, *āś*, *āś*, *as*, contrite in heart, penitent.

*Kshunṇaka*, *as*, *m*. a kind of drum beaten at a funeral.

*Kshuda*, *as*, *m*. flour, meal.

*Kshudra*, *as*, *ā*, *am* (compar. *kshodiyas*, superl. *kshoditha*), minute, diminutive, tiny, very small, small, little, trifling; mean, low, vile, niggardly, base, avaricious; wicked; cruel; poor, indigent; (*ā*), *m*. a small particle of rice; a bee or wasp; the plant *Artocarpus Lacucha* [*cf. lakuća* and *dahu*]; (*āś*), *m*, *pl*. a peculiar class of writings, see *kshudra-kalpa*; (*ā*), *f*. a woman maimed or crippled; a base or despicable woman; a whore, a harlot; a dancing girl; a quarrelsome woman; a bee, fly, gnat; several plants, *Solanum Jacquini*, = *vṛihati*; also = *āṅgerikā*; also = *gavedhukā*; (*am*), *n*, *Ved*. a particle of dust, flour, meal; [*cf. Lith. kūdikis*, 'an infant'; Pers. كودك kūdak, 'small, a boy.']. — *Kshudra-kantakārī*, *f*. the plant *Solanum Jacquini*, = *agni-damanī*. — *Kshudra-kantaki*, *f*. a kind of *Solanum*, = *brihatī*. — *Kshudra-kānāsa*, *am*, *n*. of a lake. — *Kshudra-kambu*, *us*, *m*. a small shell. — *Kshudra-kalpa*, *as*, *m*. 'the smaller ritual' title of a class of works.

— *Kshudra-kāralikā*, *f*. (for *kshudra-kāralikā*?), and *kshudra-kāravelī*, *f*. a kind of Cucurbitaceous plant. — *Kshudra-kulisa*, *as*, *m*. a precious stone; [*cf. vaikrānta*.] — *Kshudra-kushha*, *am*, *n*. a mild form of leprosy, (comprising eleven varieties, whereas the *māhā-kushha* contains seven severe forms of leprosy). — *Kshudra-kshura* and *kshudra-gokshuraka*, *as*, *m*. a variety of the plant *Asteracantha Longifolia*. — *Kshudra-ghāntikā*, *f*. a tinkling ornament, a girdle of small bells. — *Kshudra-gholi*, *f*, *N*. of a plant, = *civillikā*. — *Kshudra-ćāni*, *us*, *f*, *N*. of a plant. — *Kshudra-ćandana*, *am*, *n*. red sandal-wood. — *Kshudra-ćirbhītā*, *f*, *N*. of a plant, = *gopāla-karkaṭī*. — *Kshudra-ćūḍā*, *as*, *m*. a kind of small bird, commonly called *gostālikā*. — *Kshudra-ćājantu*, *us*, *m*. any small animal; a kind of worm, *Julus* (*sata-padi*). — *Kshudra-jātiyāhala*, *am*, *n*. a kind of *Myrobalan*; [*cf. āmalaka*.] — *Kshudra-ćīra*, *as*, *m*. small cummin. — *Kshudra-ćīvā*, *f*, *N*. of a plant, = *jīvanti*. — *Kshudra-ćara*, *as*, *ī*, *am*, following small or minute or trifling matters. — *Kshudra-ćandula*, *as*, *m*. a grain of rice. — *Kshudra-ćātā*, *f*. or *kshudra-tva*, *am*, *n*. minuteness, smallness; inferiority, insignificance; meanness. — *Kshudra-ćulasi*, *f*. a kind of *Ocimum*, = *arjaka*. — *Kshudra-ćānsikā* or *kshudra-ćānsi*, *f*. a small gad-fly. — *Kshudra-durālabhā*, *f*, *N*. of a thorny plant much eaten by camels. — *Kshudra-duḥsparsā*, *f*. the plant *Solanum Jacquini*, = *agni-damanī*. — *Kshudra-đhātri*, *f*, *N*. of a plant; [*cf. karkata*.] — *Kshudra-đhānya*, *am*, *n*. shrivelled grain. — *Kshudra-đāsi*, *as*, *ī*, *am*, having a small nose. — *Kshudra-pakshīka*, *as*, *m*. a small bird. — *Kshudra-patrā*, *f*, *a*. kind of wood-sorrel, *Oxalis Monadelpha*, = *āṅgerī*; (*ī*), *f*, *N*. of another plant, = *vācā*. — *Kshudra-pānasa*, *as*, *m*. the plant *Artocarpus Lacucha* (*lakuća*). — *Kshudra-parna*, *as*, *m*. a kind of *Ocimum*, = *arjaka*. — *Kshudra-pāshāṇa-bhedō* or *ī*, *f*, *N*. of a plant, = *catuh-pattrī*, *pārvatī*, *naga-bhū*, &c. — *Kshudra-pippali*, *f*. wild pepper (= *vāṇapippali*). — *Kshudra-prishati*, *f*, *Ved*. covered with small spots. — *Kshudra-potikā*, *f*, *N*. of a pot-herb. — *Kshudra-phalaka*, *as*, *m*, *N*. of a plant, = *jīvana*, *Celtis Orientalis*. — *Kshudra-phalā*, *f*, *N*. of several plants, *Ardisia Solanacea*, = *bhāmi-jambu*, and others. — *Kshudra-buddhi*, *is*, *ī*, *of* little
