'having a speckled throat,' a pigeon. — *Čitra-kathālāpa-sukha* ('*tā-āl*'). *as*, *ā*, *am*, happy in telling charming stories. — *Čitra-kambala*, *as*, m. a variegated carpet; a painted cloth used as an elephant's housing. — *Čitra-kara*, *as*, m. a painter; [cf. *čitra-kāra* and *čitra-kṛit*.] — *Čitra-karṇa*, *as*, m. 'strange-ear,' N. of a camel. — *Čitra-karman*, *a*, n. any extraordinary act, a wonderful deed; magic; ornamenting, decorating; painting, a painting, picture; (*ā*), m. working wonders, a magician; a painter; the tree *Dalbergia Ougeinensis*; [cf. *čitra-kṛit*.] — *Čitracarma-vīd*, *t*, m. skilled in the art of painting; a painter, a magician. — *Čitra-kāya*, *as*, m. 'having a striped or speckled body,' a tiger, a leopard, panther. — *Čitra-kāra*, *as*, m. a painter; [cf. *čitra-kāra*.] — *Čitra-kuṇḍala*, *as*, m. N. of a son of Dhṛita-rāshṭra. — *Čitra-kūṭa*, *as*, m. 'wonderful peak,' N. of a hill and district, the modern Chitrakote or Chatarcot (near Kampta), situated on the river Paisuni (Piṣuni) about fifty miles S. E. of the town of Bandah in Bundelkhand, lat. 25. 12, long. 80. 47. It was the first habitation of Rāma and Lakshmana in their exile after leaving Ayodhyā, and as the holiest spot of the worshippers of Rāma is crowded with temples and shrines; N. of a town. — *Čitra-kṛit*, *t*, *t*, *t*, astonishing, surprising; (*t*), m. a painter; the tree *Dalbergia Ougeinensis*; [cf. *čitra-karman*.] — *Čitra-keṭu*, *us*, m. N. of a son of Gaṇḍa; also of Vasishṭha; also of Lakshmaṇa; also of Devabhāga; also of a king of the Sūtra-senas. — *Čitra-kola*, *as*, m. a kind of lizard. — *Čitra-kṛtyā*, *f*, painting. — *Čitra-khalra*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, Ved. one whose dominion is brilliant (as Agni); (Sāy.) having various power or one whose wealth is visible. — *Čitra-ga*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, represented in a picture, painted. — *Čitra-gata*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, coloured, variegated; represented in a picture, painted, delineated. — *Čitra-gandha*, *am*, n. yellow orpiment. — *Čitra-gupta*, *as*, m., N. of one of the beings recording the vices and virtues of mankind in Yama's world; N. of a mixed caste, a secretary or writer of a man of rank; a form of Yama; N. of the sixteenth Arhat of the future Utsarpinī. — *Čitra-grīha*, *as*, m. a painted room, or one ornamented with pictures; [cf. *čitra-sālā*.] — *Čitra-grīva*, *as*, m. 'speckled-neck,' N. of a pigeon-king. — *Čitra-čāpa*, *as*, m., N. of a son of Dhṛita-rāshṭra. — *Čitra-jalpa*, *as*, m. talking on various things, talking incoherently. — *Čitra-laṇḍula*, *am*, *ā*, n. f. a medicinal plant said to possess antelmintic virtues; [cf. *viḍ-anga*.] — *Čitra-tala*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, painted or variegated on the surface. — *Čitra-tvač*, *k*, m. 'having curious bark,' the birch or bhūṛja tree. — *Čitra-čandaka*, *as*, m. the cotton plant, *Arum Campanulatum*; [cf. *ola*.] — *Čitra-darsana*, *as*, m., N. of a Brāhman changed into a bird ('having variegated eyes'). — *Čitra-dīpa*, *as*, m. title of a philosophical work. — *Čitra-dṛśika*, *us*, *ā*, *am*, Ved. looking brilliant or shining. — *Čitra-deva*, *as*, m., N. of one of the attendants of Skanda; (*ṣ*), f., N. of a plant, = *mahendra-vāruṇī*. — *Čitra-dharmā*, *ā*, m., N. of a prince identified with the Asura Virūpāksha. — *Čitra-dhā*, ind. in a manifold way. — *Čitra-dhrajati*, *is*, *is*, *t*, Ved. making a bright line, an epithet of Agni; (Sāy.) having a wonderful course. — *Čitra-dhvanja*, *as*, m., N. of a man. — *Čitra-netrā*, *f*, a small bird called Maina, = *sārikā*; [cf. *čitra-ločanā* and *čitrākṣhi*.] — *Čitra-nasta*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, represented in a picture, painted. — *Čitra-paksha*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, having variegated wings; (*as*), m. the francoline partridge; N. of a demon causing head-ache. — *Čitra-pāṭa* or *čitra-paṭṭa*, *as* or *am*, m. or n. (?), a painting, a picture. — *Čitra-paṭṭa-gata*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, 'committed to a picture,' painted. — *Čitra-patṛikā*, *f*, N. of a plant, = *kapūthā-parṇī* and *drona-pushpī*. — *Čitra-patṛī*, *f*, N. of an aquatic plant; [cf. *jala-pippalī*.] — *Čitra-pada*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, divided into various parts; full of graceful words or expressions; (*ā*), f., N. of the plant

*Cissus Pedata* [cf. *godhāpadī*]; N. of a metre consisting of four lines of eight syllables each; (*am*), n., N. of a metre consisting of four lines of twenty-three syllables each. — *Čitrapada-kramam*, ind. at a good or brisk pace. — *Čitra-parṇikā*, *f*, N. of a plant, commonly Čākuliya, *Hemionites Cordifolia*; Bengal madder, *Rubia Munjista*, = *ati-guhā*, *ghriṣh-ṭhīlā*, *tri-parṇī*, *dirgha-patṛā*, &c. — *Čitra-parṇī*, *f*, N. of several plants, = *prīṣni-parṇī*, *kārṇa-sphoṭā*, *jala-pippalī*, *drona-pushpī*; also = *Rubia Munjista*. — *Čitra-pātala*, *as* or *am*, m. or n. (?), N. of a plant. — *Čitra-pādā*, *f*, a small bird commonly called Maina; — *Čitra-pīchhaka*, *as*, m. 'having a variegated tail,' a peacock. — *Čitra-punkha*, *as*, m. 'having variegated feathers,' an arrow. — *Čitra-pura*, *am*, n., N. of a town. — *Čitra-pushpī*, *f*, N. of a shrub, = *ambashṭhā*. — *Čitra-prīshṭha*, *as*, m. 'speckled-back,' a sparrow. — *Čitra-pratikṛitī*, *is*, *f*, a representation in colours, a painting, a picture. — *Čitra-priya-katha*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, speaking very kindly. — *Čitra-phala*, *as*, m. a kind of fish, commonly Chitala, *Mystus Chitala*; a kind of cucumber, *Cucumis Sativus*; (*ā*), *f*, a kind of fish, commonly Phalāi, = *phalākūṭin*, *mahonnada*, *rāja-grīva*, *Mystus Karpīrat*; N. of several plants, = *čirbhīlā*, *mṛigeravūru*, *mahendra-vāruṇī*, *vātāki*, *kaṅkākāri*; (*ṣ*), *f*, the above fish. — *Čitra-phalaka*, *am*, n. a tablet for painting, a picture, a painting; (*as*), m. a kind of fish; see above. — *Čitra-barha*, *as*, m. 'having a variegated tail,' a peacock; N. of a son of Gaṇḍa. — *Čitra-barhīn*, *ī*, *īnī*, *ī*, having a variegated tail. — *Čitra-barhīs*, *is*, *is*, *is*, Ved. having a brilliant or shining litter (i. e. bed of stars), an epithet of Pūshan and the moon; (Sāy.) strewed with various grasses (as the ground). — *Čitra-bāhu*, *us*, m., N. of a son of Dhṛita-rāshṭra. — *Čitra-bhānu*, *us*, *us*, *u*, of variegated lustre, shining with light; epithet of Agni, Savitṛī, the *Āsṛins*, &c.; (*us*), m. a N. of fire; of Siva; the plant *Plumbago Zeylanica*; the sun; N. of the *Calotropis Gigantea* (= *arka*); the first year of the first cycle of Jupiter; an epithet of Bhairava, a form of Siva; N. of the father of Vāna-bhaṭṭa, the author of the *Kādambarī*. — *Čitra-bhūta*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, made into a picture, painted. — *Čitra-bheshajā*, *f*, the tree *Ficus Oppositifolia*; [cf. *kakodumbara*.] — *Čitra-maṇḍala*, *as*, m. a kind of snake. — *Čitra-mahas*, *ās*, *ās*, *as*, Ved. having extraordinary abundance; (Sāy.) having conspicuous brightness or splendor. — *Čitra-mṛiga*, *as*, m. the spotted antelope. — *Čitra-mekhala*, *as*, m. 'girdled with spots,' a peacock. — *Čitra-yajña*, *as*, m. title of a comedy by Vaidyanātha. — *Čitra-yāna*, *as*, m., N. of a prince. — *Čitra-yāma*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, Ved. having a splendid or brilliant course (as Agni). — *Čitra-yodhinī*, *ī*, *īnī*, *ī*, fighting in a wonderful manner or in various ways; (*ṣ*), m. an epithet of Arjuna; the tree *Terminalia Arjuna*. — *Čitra-ratha*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, having a bright or splendid chariot (as Agni); (*as*), m. 'having a variegated car,' the sun; the king of the Gandharvas; N. of a snake-demon; of a Vidyā-dhara; of a son of Gada or (according to a various reading) of Kṛishṇa; of a king; of a king of the Angas; of a descendant of Anga and son of Dharmā-ratha; of a son of Ushadgu; of Vṛishṇi; of Gaya; of Su-pārvāka; of Ukta; of a prince of Mṛitīkāvāṇ; of a Sūta; and of others; (*ā*), *f*, N. of a river; [cf. *čaitra-ratha*]. — *Čitra-raśmī*, *is*, m., N. of a Marut ('having variegated rays'). — *Čitra-rūti*, *is*, *is*, *ī*, Ved. granting wonderful or excellent gifts, epithet of the *Āsṛins*. — *Čitra-rādhās*, *ās*, *ās*, *as*, Ved. bestowing excellent favour; (Sāy.) having wonderful wealth. — *Čitra-repha*, *as*, m., N. of a son of Medhāthūti, king of Sāka-dvīpa. — *Čitra-latā*, *f*, the plant *Rubia Munjista*; [cf. *čitra-parṇī*.] — *Čitra-bikhana*, *am*, n. 'variegated drawing,' painting. — *Čitra-likhīta*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, represented, delineated (as in a picture), painted; motionless, dumb (as a picture or statue). — *Čitra-lekhaka*, *as*, m. a painter. — *Čitra-lekhanikā*, *f*, a painter's brush. — *Čitra-lekhā*, *f*, a picture, a portrait; N. of a metre of four lines of seventeen syllables each;

another metre of the same sort; N. of a metre of four lines of eighteen syllables each; N. of an *Apsaras* born from Brāhmā's hand, (she was a friend of Ushā and skilful in painting); N. of a daughter of Kumbhāṇḍa, minister of king Vāna, also a friend of Ushā. — *Čitralekhā-dvīṇyā*, *f*, having Čitralekhā as a second, accompanied by Čitralekhā. — *Čitra-ločanā*, *f*, 'having variegated eyes,' a small bird, commonly called Maina, = *sārikā*; [cf. *čitra-netrā* and *čitrākṣhi*.] — *Čitra-val*, *ān*, *ātī*, *ātī*, decorated with paintings or ornaments; containing the word *čitra*; (*tī*), *f*, N. of a metre of four lines of thirteen syllables each; N. of a daughter of Gada or (according to others) of Kṛishṇa. — *Čitra-vadāla*, *as*, m. the sheat-fish, *Silurus Pelorius*, = *pāhina*. — *Čitra-vana*, *am*, n. 'wonderful wood,' N. of a wood near the Gaṇḍakī; [cf. *čitraka*.] — *Čitra-varman*, *ā*, m. 'having variegated arrows,' N. of a son of Dhṛita-rāshṭra; also of a king of the Kulūtas; N. of a king of Mathura and Čāmpāvati. — *Čitra-varṣin*, *ī*, *īnī*, *ī*, raining in an unusual manner. — *Čitra-vallika*, *as*, m. a kind of sheat-fish, *Silurus Boalis*; [cf. *čitra-vadāla*.] — *Čitra-vallī*, *f*, N. of two plants, = *mṛigeravūru* and *mahendra-vāruṇī*. — *Čitra-vahā*, *f*, N. of a river. — *Čitra-vāja*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, decorated with variegated feathers; possessed of excellent power; (Sāy.) making wonderful progress or having wonderful riches or strength; (*as*), m. a cock. — *Čitra-vāna*, *as*, m., N. of a son of Dhṛita-rāshṭra. — *Čitra-vāhana*, *as*, m., N. of a king of Maṇi-pūra. — *Čitra-vičitra*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, variously coloured, variegated, multiform. — *Čitra-vidyā*, *f*, the art of painting. — *Čitra-vīrya*, *as*, m. a kind of Ricinus, = *raktairāṇḍa*. — *Čitra-vṛitti*, *is*, *f*, any astonishing act or practice. — *Čitra-vegika*, *as*, m. 'having wonderful velocity,' N. of a Nāga. — *Čitra-veśa*, *as*, m. 'having a variegated dress,' an epithet of Siva. — *Čitra-sālā*, *f*, a painted room, or one decorated with pictures [cf. *čitra-grīha*]; N. of a metre consisting of four lines of eighteen syllables each. — *Čitrasikhāṇḍī-ja* or *čitrasikhāṇḍī-prasūta*, *as*, m. epithet of Bṛihaspati or the planet Jupiter (regarded as the son of the Čitrasikhāṇḍīnas, but more properly of An-giras). — *Čitra-sikhāṇḍin*, *īnas*, m. pl. 'having bright crests,' an epithet of the seven Rishis, Marīčī, Atri, Angiras, Pulastya, Pulaha, Kratu, and Vasishṭha, as represented in the seven principal stars of the Great Bear. — *Čitra-siras*, *ās*, m. 'having a variegated head,' a kind of venomous insect [cf. *čitra-sirshaka*]; N. of a Gandharva. — *Čitra-sirshaka*, *as*, m. a kind of venomous insect. — *Čitra-sōcis*, *is*, *is*, *is*, Ved. shining brilliantly; epithet of Agni. — *Čitra-sravas*, *ās*, *ās*, *as*, Ved. uttering loud cries, songs, &c.; worthy of loud praise; (Sāy.) having wonderful fame. — *Čitra-srī*, *is*, *f*, great beauty, the beauty of variegated colours. — *Čitra-saṁsthā*, *us*, *ā*, *am*, represented in a picture, delineated, painted; [cf. *čitra-gata*, *čitra-stha*, &c.] — *Čitra-sanga*, *as* or *am*, m. or n. (?), N. of a metre of four lines of sixteen syllables each. — *Čitra-sarpa*, *as*, m. a kind of snake, the large speckled snake (*Mālu-dhāna*). — *Čitra-sena*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, Ved. furnished with a brilliant spear; (Sāy.) having a bright weapon; (*as*), m., N. of a snake-demon; also of a leader of the Gandharvas who was a son of Viśvā-vasu; one of the judges or recorders of hell; N. of a son of Dhṛita-rāshṭra; of a son of Parīkṣit; of a son of Sambara; of a son of Narishyanta; of a son of the thirteenth Manu; of a son of Gada; N. of an adversary of Kṛishṇa; of Jarā-sandha's general who is also called Dimbhaka; (*ā*), *f*, N. of an *Apsaras*; also of one of the Mātṛis attending on Skanda; N. of a river. — *Čitrasena-bhaṭṭa*, *as*, m., N. of the author of a commentary entitled *Pingalā-čando-grantha-ṭīkā*. — *Čitra-stha*, *as*, *ā*, *am*, represented in a picture, painted; [cf. *čitra-gata* and *čitra-saṁsthā*.] — *Čitra-hasta*, *am*, n. a particular position of the hands in fighting. — *Čitrākṛitī* ('*ra-āk*'), *is*, *f*, a painted resemblance, portrait, picture. — *Čitrākṣha* ('*ra-āk*'), *as*, m. 'having variegated eyes,' N. of a son of Dhṛita-rāshṭra; also of a
