

*Agnimātā*—a second disciple of Bāṣkala, in charge of a śākhā of the *R̥gveda*.

*Agnimitra* (I)—the son of Puṣyamitra Śuṅga and father of Sujyeṣṭha;<sup>1</sup> reigned for eight years.<sup>2</sup>
