Kalki—the 21st (10th Vā.) *avatār* of Hari, in *Kaliyuga* and emperor of the world by name Pārāśraya with Yājñavalkya as Purohita. Born of a Brāhmaṇa Viṣṇuśāś in Śambalagrāma. His horse would be known as Devadatta. Riding on it, Kalki would rid the earth of the unrighteous and implant *dharma* again.¹ Invoked;² destroyer of Kṣatriyas who became *mlecchas* by character.³ State of the world then.⁴ According to the *Br. Purāṇa*, his name is *Viṣṇuśāś*, and son of Parāśara: the tenth incarnation of Hari, with Purohita Yājñavalkya. After rooting out
