

## PURANA INDEX

*Kuni* (III)—a son of Vedaśiras; an *avatār* of the 15th *dvāpara*.

*Kuṇḍa*—a powerful ally of Jarāsandha; placed at the north gate of Mathurā during its siege, and of Gomanta during its siege: see *Kulinda*.

*Kuṇibāhu*—a son of Vedaśiras; an *avatār* of the 15th *dvāpara*. (See also *Kunī*).
