

Dhṛtiman (iv)—a son of Sudaridra (s.v.) of Pāñcāla-deśa.

Dhṛtiman (v)—a son of Purūravas and Urvaśī.

Dhṛtiman (vi)—a son of Yavīnara and father of Satyadhṛti.

Dhṛtivrataṁ—observance of this vow described; the performer becomes a king in the next Kalpa.

Dhṛṣṭa (ii)—a son of Vaivasvata Manu; an ancestor of the Dhṛṣṭa race of warriors, 3000 in number;¹ father of three sons Dhṛtaketu, Citraratha and Ranadhṛṣṭa.²
