*Nālī*—equal in measurement to dhanurdanda.

*Nālinī*—one of the Eastern entrances to the city of Puranjana; allegorically the nostrils.

*Nāsatya*—a son of Mārtāṇḍa or Sūrya; one of the Aśvins.

*Nāsatyas*—a deva gaṇa.

*Nāsatyau*—the Twins (Aśvins) born of the nostrils of Samjña as mare on the earth; father of Nakula and Sahādeva;<sup>1</sup> visited the hermitage of Cyavana;<sup>2</sup> propitiated during the śrāddha.<sup>3</sup>
