*Nepālapītham*—one of the eyes of the Veda personified.

*Nemi* (I)—a Rākṣasa was asked by Bali to refrain from battle with Vāmana.

*Nemi* (II)—a Sutapa God.

*Nemi* (III)—one of the sons of Ikṣvāku; a righteous king cursed by Vasiṣṭha to lose his body.

*Nemikṛṣṇa*—a son of Āpādabaddha; ruled for 25 years.

*Nemicakra*—the son of Āsimakṛṣṇa and father of Ukta; Hastināpura being washed away he changed his capital to Kauśāmbī.

*Neṣṭā*—one of the 16 Ṛtviks for *yajña*; created from the thighs of Nārāyaṇa.
