

*Nau*—the boat in the Ocean; in the river;<sup>1</sup> illustrative of the earth floating on waters.<sup>2</sup>

*Nau*—(Mahīmayī) the divine boat given to Manu (Vaivasvata) by Viṣṇu in the shape of a fish to be tied to its horn;<sup>1</sup> in the deluge it rescued the sun, moon, Brahmā, Narmadā, sage Mārkaṇḍeya, Śiva, the Vedas, Purāṇas and other Vidyas from ruin;<sup>2</sup> Druhyu to ply the ocean with.<sup>3</sup>

*Nyagrodha* (I)—a son of Ugrasena;<sup>1</sup> and brother of Kamsa killed by Balarāma.<sup>2</sup>

*Nyagrodha* (II)—a son of Kṛṣṇa.

*Nyagrodha* (III)—the banyan tree of Ramāṇaka; of the shape of a lotus after which Puṣkaradvīpa is named;<sup>1</sup> during the deluge, Lord Nārāyaṇa in the form of a baby slept on a leaf of the tree.<sup>2</sup>
