

Śveta (ix)—a son of Maṇivara.

Śveta (xi)—a division of Jambūdvīpa.

Śvetakalpa—the first kalpa; explained in the *Vāyavya Purāṇa*,¹ Dharmavṛtā performed tapas in and became turned to a stone;² Vārāha in;³ Śiva takes the *avatār* of Sad-
yojāta, all white, when Gāyatrī also is born with him.⁴

Śvetaketu (i)—a Madhyamādhvaryu.

Śvetaketu (ii)—a son of Lāngali, an *avatār* of the Lord.
