

अगरु mn. (-रुः-रुः) Agallochum, (Aquilaria agallocha, Rox.) See अगरु.
 अगर्व्य mfn. (-र्व्यः-र्व्यः-र्व्यः) Modest, humble, void of pride. E. अ neg. गर्व्य pride.
 अगस्ति m. (-स्तिः) 1 The name of a saint, celebrated in Hindu mythology, more usually entitled AGASTYA, the son of both MITRA and VARUNA, by URVASI ; he is represented of short stature, and is said by some to have been born in a water jar : he is famed for having swallowed the ocean, when it had given him offence ; at his command also, the VINDHYA range of mountains prostrated itself, and so remains ; hence his present appellation : he is also considered as the regent of the star Canopus. 2. The name of a tree, (Sesbana grandiflora.) E. अग a mountain, and स्ति, with an adventitious meaning, to fix, or in the second instance, to be fixed ; also अग as before, and स्ति Unadi aff.
 अगस्तिद्रु m. (-द्रुः) A tree, (Sesbana grandiflora.) See अगस्ति. E. अगस्ति, and द्रु a tree.
 अगस्त्य m. (-स्त्यः) 1. The name of a saint. 2. A tree. 3. The star Canopus. See अगस्ति.
 अगामजा f. (-जा) A name of PÁRVATI, the daughter of the mountain or Himalaya. E. अग a mountain, and अगामजा daughter.
 अगाध n. (-घः) A hole, a chasm, mfn. (-घः-घा-घं) Very deep, bottomless. E. अ neg. गाघ fixed place.
 अगाधजल m. (-लः) A lake. E. अगाध deep, जल water.
 अगाधता f. (-ता) Depth. E. अगाध and ता aff.
 अगाधत्व n. (-त्वः) Depth. E. अगाध and त्व aff.
 अगार n. (-रः) A house. See आगार. E. अग a mountain, and ऋ to go ; rising like a hill.
 अग्निस m. (-नः) The sun. E. अग्न to go, इन aff.
 अग्निर m. (-रः) 1. The sun. 2. Fire. 3. A demon. E. अग्न to go, and इर aff.
 अगुण m. (-णः) A defect, a fault. mfn. (-णः-णा-णं) 1. Void of good qualities, bad. 2. Void of attributes. E. अ neg. गुण qualities.
 अगुणता f. (-ता) Absence of all good qualities ; also अगुणत्व. E. अ neg. गुण with ता or त्व aff.
 अगुणवादिन् mfn. (-दी-दिनी-दि) Censorious, pointing out defects. E. अगुण and वादिन् declaring.
 अगरु mn. (-रुः-रुः) 1. A fragrant wood, aloe wood, or agallochum, (Aquilaria agallocha, Rox.) 2. Another tree which produces Bedellium, (Amyris agallocha.) 3. A timber tree, commonly Sisu, (Dalbergia sisu, Rox.) mfn. (-रुः-रुः-रुः or -र्व्यः-रुः) Light, not heavy. E. अ priv. and गुर् heavy.
 अगुप्त mfn. (-प्तः-प्तः-प्तं) 1. Unhidden, unconcealed. 2. One who cannot keep a secret. E. अ neg. गुप्त concealed.
 अगुप्तशिखा f. (-षा) A timber tree. (Dalbergia sisu.) The best authorities consider this as formed of two distinct words. See अगरु and शिखा ।
 अगूढ mfn. (ढः-ढा-ढं) 1. Unhidden, unconcealed, manifest, evident. 2. One who is not secret. E. अ neg. गूढ hidden.
 अगूढगन्ध n. (-न्धः) Asafoetida. E. अगूढ and गन्ध smell.
 अगूढभाव mfn. (-वः-वा-वं) Open, honest, candid ; one whose purpose or inclinations are evident. E. अगूढ and भाव nature.
 अगोचर mfn. (-रः-रु-रं) Covert, unseen, unwitnessed. n. (-रः) 1. Absence, unconsciousness ; not being witnessed or known. 2. Any act or event not the object of the senses. 3. The imperceptible, BRAHMA, or the invisible Supreme. E. अ neg. गोचर, object of sense.
 अगौकस् m. (-काः) 1. A bird. 2. A lion. 3. The Sarabha, a fabulous animal with eight legs. E. अग a tree or mountain, कौकस् a house.
 अग्रायी f. (-यी) 1. A goddess, the wife of AGNI, the deity of fire, and presiding over prayers accompanied with burnt offerings. 2. The Treta or second age of the Hindus. E. अग्नि fire, and fem. aff. डीप, with आय substituted for ऐ inserted.

अग्नि m. (-ग्निः) 1. Fire, always associated with the idea of the deity presiding over it, and who is worshipped by the Hindus. AGNI is also regent of the south-east quarter. 2. A consecrated fire. 3. The fire of the stomach, the digestive faculty, appetite. 4. Bile. 5. Gold. 6. A plant of which the fruit has escharotic properties, (Semecarpus anacardium) 7. Another plant, (Plumbago zeylanica.) E. अङ्ग to mark, and नि Unadi aff. ड being dropped.
 अग्निक् म. (-क्) An insect of a scarlet color, the lady-bird. E. अग्नि fire and क aff. resembling fire.
 अग्निक्षण m. (-णः) A spark. E. अग्नि fire, and क्षण a small particle.
 अग्निकारिका f. (-का) Maintaining a sacrificial fire, &c. E. अग्नि fire, and कारिका making, from कृ to do.
 अग्निकारित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Caused by fire. E. अग्नि and कारित caused.
 अग्निकार्य n. (-र्यः) Maintaining a sacred fire. E. अग्नि and कार्य act.
 अग्निकाष्ठ n. (-ष्ठः) Agallochum. See अगरु, E. अग्नि fire, and काष्ठ wood.
 अग्निकुक्कट m. (-टः) A firebrand, a lighted wisp of straw. E. अग्नि fire, and कुक्कट a wisp of lighted straw.
 अग्निहृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Done with or made by fire, offered with fire. E. अग्नि and हृत done.
 अग्निकोण m. (-णः) The east. E. अग्नि and कोण corner.
 अग्निक्लीडा f. (-डा) Illuminations, fireworks, &c. E. अग्नि and क्लीडा play.
 अग्निगर्भ m. (-र्भः) 1. The sun-stone, crystal, or a fabulous gem ; supposed to contain and impart solar heat. 2. A plant. f. (-र्भा) The name of another plant. E. अग्नि, गर्भ the womb.
 अग्निचित् m. (-चित्) A householder who has placed and consecrated a sacrificial fire. E. अग्नि fire, and चित् who collects.
 अग्निचित्वा f. (-त्वा) Maintaining a sacred fire. E. अग्नि and चित्वा collecting.
 अग्निज m. (-जः) A plant used in medicine, of stimulant properties. mfn. (-जः-जा-जं) 1. Produced by or producing fire, also अग्निजात, 2. Digestive. E. अग्नि fire, and ज who or what is born, from जनः ।
 अग्निजार m. (-रः) A medicinal plant. See अग्निज ।
 अग्निजाल m. (-लः) A medicinal plant. See अग्निज ।
 अग्निजिह्वा f. (-ह्वा) 1. A medicinal plant. See लाङ्गलिकी. 2. A flame of fire. E. अग्नि, and जिह्वा the tongue, growing like a flame of fire.
 अग्निज्वाला f. (-ला) 1. A flame of fire. 2. A plant bearing red blossoms used by dyers, (Grislea tomentosa, Rox.) 3. Another plant, commonly Jalapippali. E. अग्नि and ज्वाला flame, from the fiery colour of its blossoms.
 अग्नित्रेता f. (-ता) The aggregate of the three fires maintained by the Brahman householder, the Garhapatya or domestic, Ahavaniya or consecrated, and Dakshina or southern. E. अग्नि and त्रेता triad.
 अग्निद mfn. (-दः-दा-दं) 1. Setting on fire, incendiary. 2. Supplying with fire. 3. Stomachic, tonic, digestive. E. अग्नि and द what gives.
 अग्निदमनी f. (-नी) A medicinal plant, of narcotic properties, (Solanum jacquini.) See कण्टकारिका, E. अग्नि bile, and दमनी what tames.
 अग्निदग्ध m. (-ग्धः) A Pitri or progenitor to whom oblations are made, mfn. (-ग्धः-ग्धा-ग्धं) Burnt. E. अग्नि and दग्ध burnt.
 अग्निदीप्त mfn. (-प्तः-प्ता-प्तं) 1. Blazing on fire. 2. Digestive. f. (-प्ता) The name of a plant. E. अग्नि and दीप्त inflamed.
 अग्निदेव m. (-वः) 1. AGNI, the god of fire. 2. A worshipper of fire. f. (-वा) A name of the third lunar mansion, identified with the Pleiades : AGNI being the ruling deity of the constellation. Also अग्निदेवता.
 अग्निदेवत्व n. (-त्वः) The supremacy or divinity of fire. E. अग्नि and देवत्व divinity.
 अग्निनिष्वास m. (-सः) The name of a plant, also अग्निजार E. अग्नि and निष्वास decoction or extract.
 अग्निपक्व mfn. (क्वः-क्वा-क्वं) Cooked or dressed with fire. E. अग्नि and पक्व mature.
 अग्निपरिच्छेद n. (-दं) The implements and apparatus used in oblations to fire. E. अग्नि and परिच्छेद accompaniments.
