

अग्निपरीक्षा f. (-क्षा) The fiery ordeal, by a heated iron or boiling oil, or passing through fire. E. अग्नि and परीक्षा trial.

अग्निप्रस्तर m. (-रः) Fire-stone, flint, or any stone producing fire. E. अग्नि and प्रस्तर a stone.

अग्निभ्रम m. (-मः) Gold. E. अग्नि and भ्रम for भा lustre, brilliant as fire.

अग्निभू m. (-भूः) A name of SKANDA, the Hindu deity of war. See कार्तिकेय and स्कन्द. E. अग्नि and भू being; being, or born, from fire. SIVA having cast his seed into flame, for the purpose of generating a warrior, able to subdue TARA KA, a demon, SKANDA was produced.

अग्निजल n. (-जु) Water, which is generated, in the Hindu cosmogony, from fire.

अग्निभूति m. (-तिः) A proper name. One of the pupils of the last Jaina saint. E. अग्नि and भूति superhuman power; equal to AGNI.

अग्निमणि m. (-णिः) The sun-stone. E. अग्नि and मणि a jewel or gem, brilliant as fire.

अग्निमत् mfn. (-मान्-मती-मत्) 1. Having a consecrated fire. 2. Having fire in general. E. अग्नि and मत्प् poss. aff.

अग्निमन्त्र m. (-न्त्रः) A small tree, (Premna spinosa.) E. अग्नि and मन्त्र churning, because fire is produced by friction of two pieces of its wood.

अग्निमारुति m. (-तिः) A name of the saint, AGASTYA. E. अग्नि fire, i. e. the fire of the stomach, the digestive faculty, and मारुति a name of HANUMAN; because the saint could digest as well as the monkey; the epithet alludes to a story of his devouring and digesting VATAPI, a demon, who had assumed the form of a sheep.

अग्निमुख m. (-खः) 1. A deity. 2. A Brahman. E. अग्नि and मुख the mouth; oblations to the gods passing through fire as their mouths. 3. A plant, (Plumta zeylanica.) 4. Marking nut, (Semecarpus anacardium.) (In this sense it is also fem.-खी) E. as before, from its marking like fire.

अग्निरक्षण n. (-णं) Maintenance of a sacred fire; preserving a fire in a family for perpetuity, which supplies that lighted on occasions of worship. E. अग्नि and रक्षण Preserving.

अग्निरक्षित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Maintaining a sacred fire. E. अग्नि and रक्षित preserved.

अग्निरहित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Being without fire, especially a sacred fire. 2. Devoid of appetite. E. अग्नि and रहित lost.

अग्निरजस् m. (-जाः) An insect of ascarlet color. E. अग्नि and रजस् dust or farina.

अग्निरुहा f. (-हा) The name of a plant.

अग्निवर्ण mfn. (-णं-णां-णीं) Hot, scalding, scorching. E. अग्नि and वर्ण quality; of the property of fire.

अग्निवर्द्धक mfn. (-कः-का-की-कं) 1. Tonic, stomachic. 2. Feeding or exciting fire. E. अग्नि and वर्द्धक what augments.

अग्निवर्द्धन n. (-नं) 1. Exciting fire. 2. Improving the appetite. m. (-नः) A stomachic or any thing improving the appetite. E. अग्नि and वर्द्धन increasing.

अग्निवल्लभ m. (-भः) Resin, pitch. E. अग्नि and वल्लभ a friend, from its exciting or befriending fire.

अग्निवाण m. (-णः) A fiery arrow, a rocket.

अग्निवाह m. (-हः) Smoke. E. अग्नि and वाह what bears.

अग्निबाहु m. (-हु) Smoke. E. अग्नि and बाहु the arm.

अग्निविसर्प m. (-र्पः) Pain from a boil. E. अग्नि and विसर्प a boil.

अग्निबीज n. (-जं) Gold. E. अग्नि and बीज seed.

अग्निवीर्य n. (-र्यं) Gold. E. अग्नि and वीर्य power.

अग्निवृद्धि f. (-द्धिः) 1. Improved digestion, appetite. 2. Increase of fire. E. अग्नि and वृद्धि increase.

अग्निशिख m. (-खः) 1. A lamp. 2. An arrow. 3. A fiery arrow, a rocket. E. The Safflower plant, (Carthamus tinctorius.) mn. (-खः-खं) Saffron, the plant and die. f. (-क्षा) 1. Flame. 2. A plant. (Gloriosa superba.) 3. A medicinal plant, (Menispermum cordifolium.) E. अग्नि aud. शिखा a crest or flame or splendor.

अग्निशेखर m. (-रः) Saffron. E. अग्नि and शेखर a crest.

अग्निष्टुत् f. (-ष्टुत्) An expiatory sacrifice. E. अग्नि and ष्टु to sacrifice, aff. क्तिप् with तुक् added.

अग्निष्टोम m. (-मः) A sacrifice, or rather a series of offerings to fire for five days to be celebrated in the spring. E. अग्नि and ष्टोम oblation, burnt-offering.

अग्निष्ठ n. (-ष्ठं) An iron frying-pan. mfn. (-ष्ठः-ष्ठा-ष्ठं) Placed in or on fire. E. अग्नि and ष्ट what stays or remains, from ष्ठा to stand.

अग्निपुत्र m. pl. (-पुत्रः) Demigods or names to whom funeral oblations are presented. They are said to be the sons of MARICHI, and progenitors especially of the gods. E. अग्नि, स्व own, and पुत्र taken, who receive what is offered them by fire as their own.

अग्निसंस्कार m. (-रः) Any ceremony performed with the consecrated fire. E. अग्नि, संस्कार purification.

अग्निसख m. (-खः) The wind. E. अग्नि and सखा friend.

अग्निसम्भव m. (-वः) Wild safflower. mfn. (-वः-वा-वं) Originating from fire. E. अग्नि and सम्भव born.

अग्निसहाय m. (-यः) 1. A pigeon. 2. The wind. E. अग्नि and सहाय a friend.

अग्निसार n. (-रः) A medicinal application to the eyes, a collyrium from the calx of brass. E. अग्नि and सार strength, essence.

अग्निहोत्र n. (-त्रं) 1. Maintenance of a perpetual or sacred fire. m. (-त्रः) 1. Fire. 2. Ghee. E. अग्नि and होत्र oblation with fire, burnt offerings.

अग्निहोत्रिन् m. (-त्री) One who maintains a perpetual and sacred fire; this is sometimes read अग्निहोत्र, nom. (-त्रः) E. अग्निहोत्र, and णिन्, or ह्र to sacrifice, ह्रन् aff.

अग्नीवृ m. (-वृत्) A priest who attends the fire. E. अग्नि, इन्व to excite, क्तिप् aff.

अग्नीष्व m. (-ष्वः) Officiating priest, whose duty is to attend the fire. f. (-ष्वः) Exciting the sacrificial fire. E. अग्नि and इन्व, to light or kindle; and the aff. रन्; the न of इन्व being dropped.

अग्नीन्वन n. (-नं) Exciting a sacrificial fire. E. अग्नि and इन्वन kindling, exciting.

अग्न्यभाव m. (-वः) 1. Loss or extinction of the sacred fire. 2. Loss of appetite. E. अग्नि, अभाव non-existence.

अग्न्यस्त्र n. (-स्त्रं) Fire-arms; in poetry, it is usually applied to a superhuman power over the element of fire, but occasionally indicates, apparently, a rocket. E. अग्नि, अस्त्र a weapon.

अग्न्यागार m. (-रः) A fire-temple; a chamber or building where the sacred fire is kept. E. अग्नि, आगार house.

अग्न्याधान n. (-नं) Maintenance of a perpetual and sacred fire. n. अग्नि and आधान preserving.

अग्न्याधेय n. (-यं) Consecration of a perpetual fire. E. अग्नि, आधेय placing.

अग्न्यालय m. (-यः) 1. A place in which consecrated fire is kept. 2. A hole with compartments of prescribed dimensions and shape, for the several sacred fires. E. अग्नि and आलय asylum.

अग्न्याह्वित m. (-तः) A household who maintains a perpetual fire; also आहिताग्नि, E. अग्नि, आहित preserved by whom.

अग्न्युत्पात m. (-तः) A fiery meteor, a falling star, a comet. E. अग्नि and उत्पात portent.

अग्र mfn. (-ग्रः-ग्रा-ग्रं) 1. Chief, principal. E. Prior, first. 2. Excessive, more, much. 4. Excellent, best. n. (-ग्रः) 1. Front, fore part. 2. Top, summit, upper part. 3. End, point. 4. Goal, resting place. 5. Assemblage, multitude. 6. A weight equal to one Pala. 7. Limited alms, (four mouthfuls.) 8. (In astronomy) the sun's amplitude. E. अग्नि to go, and the Unadi aff. रन्, the nasal of the derivative is dropped.

अग्रकर m. (-रः) 1. The tip of the extended hand. 2. The right or better hand. 3. The extremity of a ray of light; the focal point. E. अग्र, कर hand or ray.
