

अजनीद m. (दः) A name of YUDHISHT'HIRA ; the friend of AJA, i. e. E. अज VISHNU or KRISHNA, and ईह to seek, to love, with the participial क्त, the termination of the accusative is retained.

अजनीदा f. (-दा) 1. Common carroway, (Carum carui.) 2. A kind of lovage, (Ligusticum ajwaen, Rox.) 3. A sort of parsley, (Apium involucreatum ; ) this latter application is the one used in the dialects. E. अज a goat, and मोद what pleases, from सुद.

अजम्भ m. (-म्भः) A frog.

अजय m. (-यः) Defeat. mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Unsurpassed, unsubdued, over whom or which no triumph is obtained. f. (-या) Hemp. E. अ neg. जय victory.

अजय्य mfn. (-य्यः-य्या-य्यं) Invincible, not to be subdued or surpassed. E. अ neg. जय्य conquerable.

अजय्ये n. (-य्ये) 1. Friendship. 2. Imperishableness, exemption from infirmity or decay. mfn. (-य्यः-य्या-य्यं) Imperishable, undecaying. E. अ neg. and जय्ये from जृ to decay.

अजर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Imperishable, undecaying. f. (-रा) Aloes. E. अ neg. जरा decay.

अजलस्वन n. (-नं) Antimony.

अजलीमन् m. (-मा) Cowach, (Carpopogen pruriens.) E. अज, and लीमन् the hair of the body, hair, wool.

अजशङ्गी f. (-ङ्गी) A plant ; described as a milky and thorny plant, with a fruit of a crooked figure, like a ram's horn, and used as a medicine for the eyes ; vulg, Méra Sríngi, and Kankara Sríngi. See कर्कटशङ्गी. E. अज a ram, and शङ्गी a horn.

अजस n. Adverbial. (सं) Eternally, continually. E. अ neg. जस to let loose, and र aff.

अजहत्स्वार्था f. (-था) A figure of speech, metonymy, one name being put for another, as 'the spears enter' for the spearmen. E. अ neg. जहत् leaving, स्वार्था sense,

अजहल्लिङ्ग m. (-ङ्गः) In grammar, a noun that does not vary its gender, even when it is used attributively. E. अजहत् not leaving, लिङ्ग gender.

अजहा mfn. (-हः-हा-हं) Not relinquishing, not leaving. f. (-हा) Cowach, (Carpopogen pruriens.) E. अज and ह, from हा to abandon.

अजागर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Not wakeful, not awake. m. (-रः) A plant, (Eclipta, or verbesina prostrata.) E. अ neg. and जागर wakeful.

अजाजी f. (-जी) Cumin seed. E. अज, a goat, and अज to go, affix डोप्.

अजाजीव m. (-वः) A goatherd ; also अजाजीविन् अजापालकः, &c. E. अजा a she-goat, and जीव who lives.

अजात mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Unborn, unproduced. E. अ neg. जात born.

अजातशत्रु m. (-त्रुः) A name of YUDHISHT'HIR. E. अजात unborn, and शत्रु an enemy, who never made an enemy.

अजातारि m. (-रिः) See अजातशत्रु.

अजादनी f. (-नी) A small species of prickly nightshade E. अज a goat, and अदन eating.

अजानय m. (-यः) A horse of a good breed. See अजानेय. mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Fearless, undaunted. E. See अजानेय the initial being made short.

अजात्री f. (-त्री) A potherb, (Convolvulus argenteus.) See female, कृगलानी. E. अज, and अत्र an entrail.

अजापालक m. (-कः) A goatherd. E. अजा a she-goat, पाल to nourish, and पुन् aff.

अजित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Unconquered. 2. Unexcelled, unsurpassed. m. (-तः) 1. The second of the twenty-four principal Jaina Tīrthakaras or deified sages. 2. A name of VISHN'U. 3. A name of BUD'DHA. 4. A name of SIVA. E. अ neg. and जित, participle of जि to conquer.

अजिन n. (-नं) A hide used as a seat, bed, &c. by the religious student ; generally the hide of an antelope. E. अज to go, and the Unadi aff. इनच्.

अजिनपचा f. (-चा-ची) A bat. E. अजिन a hide, and पचा a wing.

अजिनयोनि m. (-निः) A deer, or antelope. E. अजिन a hide and योनि place of origin.

अजिर n. (-रं) 1. A court or yard. 2. Air, wind. 3. The body. 4. An object of sense 5. A frog. E. अज to go, and किरन् aff.

अजिह्व mfn. (-ह्वः-ह्वा-ह्वं) Straight, not crooked, literally or metaphorically ; upright, sincere, honest, direct. m. (-ह्वः) A frog. E. अ neg. and जिह्व crooked.

अजिह्वग m. (गः) An arrow. mfn. (-गः-गा-गं) Going or moving in a straight line. E. अजिह्व straight, direct, and ग what goes.

अजिह्व mfn. (-ह्वः-ह्वा-ह्वं) Tongueless, having no tongue. m. (-ह्वः) A frog. E. अ neg. and जिह्व from जिह्वा a tongue.

अजीर्त m. (-र्तः) A Rishi, the father of Sunasephas.

अजीर्ण n. (-र्णं) 1. Flatulency, indigestion. 2. Vigor, absence of old age or decay. mfn. (-र्णः-र्णा-र्णं) 1. Undigested. 2. Undecayed, unimpaired. E. अ neg. and जीर्ण old, digested.

अजीव m. (-वः) 1. Death. 2. Non-existence. mfn. (-वः-वा-वं) 1. Lifeless, dead. E. अ neg. and जीव life.

अजीविनि f. (-निः) Non-existence ; used as an imprecation. See अकरेणि, अजीविनिस्तस्य भूयात्. E. अ neg. जीव and अनि aff.

अजितव्य mfn. (-व्यः-व्या-व्यं) Invincible, not to be conquered or overcome. E. अ neg. जितव्य conquerable.

अजिय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Invincible, insuperable, not to be overcome or surpassed. E. अ neg. जिय to be conquered.

अजैकपाद m. (-दः) One of the eleven Rudras or deities so named, forms of SIVA. Sometimes read अज एकपाद. E. अज SIVA, एक one, and पाद a quarter, a part.

अञ्जुका f. (-का) A courtesan, (in theatrical language.) E. अज to go, or here, to gain, and उक्त् affix ; sometimes read अञ्जुका, from अज्ज to earn, to gain.

अजम्भटा f. (-टा) A plant. (Flacourtia cataphracta.) E. अन् particle of surprise, and भट to be entangled.

अज्जल n. (-लं) A shield. E. अज्ज to join, and अलच् aff.

अज्ञ mfn. (-ज्ञः-ज्ञा-ज्ञं) Ignorant, unwise, foolish. E. अ priv. and ज्ञ who knows.

अज्ञता f. (-ता) Ignorance ; also अज्ञत्व. E. ता added to अज्ञ.

अज्ञत्व n. (-त्वं) Ignorance. E. अज्ञ and त्व aff.

अज्ञात mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Unknown. 2. Unknowing. E. अ neg. ज्ञात known.

अज्ञान n. (-नं) 1. Ignorance. 2. Spiritual ignorance, worldly illusion or belief in external appearances. mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Ignorant, unwise. E. अ neg. and ज्ञान knowledge.

अज्ञानता f. (-ता) Ignorance, also अज्ञानत्व.

अज्ञानिन mfn. (-नि-निनी-नि) Ignorant, unwise. E. अ neg. ज्ञानिन् knowing.

अज्ञेय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Incomprehensible. E. अ neg. ज्ञेय to be known.

अञ्च r. 1st cl. (ञ्) (अञ्चति) 1. To adore, to worship, to treat with respect. (ञ, उ.) (अञ्चति-ते) 2. To go, to approach. 3. To ask or beg. 4. To speak indistinctly. With प्र, to move in an eastern direction ; with प्रति, to go westerly ; with उत्, to go northerly ; with अ, to move southerly ; with परा, to turn aside or away. r. 1st and 10th cl. (अञ्चति अञ्चयति) To discriminate, to individualize, to possess especially. See अञ्च.

अञ्चति m. (-तिः) Air, wind. E. अञ्च to go, and अति Unadi aff.

अञ्चल m. (-लः) The end or border of a cloth, veil, shawl, &c. E. अञ्च to go, and अलच् aff.

अञ्चित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Worshipped, revered. 2. Admired. 3. Gone. E. the participial derivative of अञ्च to worship, &c.

अञ्चितभ्रू f. (-भ्रूः) A woman having beautiful eye-brows. E. अञ्चित, and भ्रू the brow.

अञ्च r. 7th cl. (ञ, ऊ, जि) (अञ्चति) 1. To make clear. 2. To anoint. 3. To be beautiful. 4. To go : with अभि, to anoint : with वि, to make manifest, to call into being, to create, to mark or designate.
