 अतितीव्र mfn. (-त्रः-त्रा-त्रं) Very sharp or pungent. f. (-त्रा) Doob grass. E. अति, and तीव्र sharp.  
 अतितीक्ष्ण mfn. (-क्ष्णः-क्ष्णा-क्ष्णं) Very pungent, sharp, hot or acrid E. अति, and तीक्ष्ण sharp.  
 अतिथि mfn. (-थिः-था) A guest, a person entitled to the rites of hospitality. m. (-थिः) 1. A proper name, the son of KUSA and grandson of RA'MA. 2. Wrath. E. अत to go, and इथिन् Unadi aff.  
 अतिथिक्रिया f. (-या) Hospitality considered as a religious duty. E. अतिथि, and क्रिया act.  
 अतिथिद्वेष m. (-षः) Inhospitality. E. अतिथि, and द्वेष dislike.  
 अतिथिपूजन n. (-नं) Hospitality considered as one of the principal sacraments of the Hindus. E. अतिथि a guest, and पूजन worshipping.  
 अतिथिसत्कार m. (-रः) The rite of hospitality, hospitality. E. अतिथि, and सत्कार pious rite.  
 अतिथिसेवा f. (-वा) Service of a guest, hospitality. E. अतिथि, and सेवा service.  
 अतिदाह m. (-ता) A liberal man. E. अति, and दाह who gives.  
 अतिदान n. (-नं) Munificence, giving largely. E. अति and दान gift.  
 अतिदाह m. (-हः) 1. Great heat. 2. Violent inflammation. E. अति and दाह burning.  
 अतिदिष्ट mfn. (-ष्टः-ष्टा-ष्टं) Substituted, supplementary. E. अति over, and दिष्ट enjoined.  
 अतिदुःसह mfn. (-हः-हा-हं) Intolerable, unbearable, not to be borne or endured. E. अति and दुःसह painful.  
 अतिदुर्गत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) In great difficulty or distress. E. अति and दुर्गत badly off.  
 अतिदुष्कर mfn. (-रः-रा-री-रं) Very arduous, very difficult. E. अति and दुष्कर difficult.  
 अतिदूर n. (-रं) A great distance, afar off. E. अति, and दूर afar.  
 अतिदेश m (-शः) Substitution, supplement. E. अति, and देश direction.  
 अतिदोष m. (-षः) A great fault.  
 अतिष्टुति f. (-तिः) A kind of metre, a stanza of four lines, with nineteen syllables in each line. E. अति and ष्टुति another metre.  
 अतिनौ mfn. (-नौः-नौः-नु) Landed from a boat. E. अति over, beyond, and नौ a boat.  
 अतिपतन n. (-नं) Exceeding, going beyond bounds. E. अति beyond and पत to go, ल्यट् aff.  
 अतिपथिन् m. (-पथा) A good road. E. अति, and पथिन् a road ; a very road.  
 अतिपर m. (-रः) 1. A great enemy. 2. One who has conquered his enemy. E. अति and परः a foe.  
 अतिपात m. (-तः) 1. Neglect of duty. 2. Transgression, deviation from laws or customs. 3. Contrariety, opposition. 4. Going beyond bounds, अति beyond, and पात from पत to go.  
 अतिपातक n. (-कं) Heinous sin, the worst of the great sins. E. अति, and पातक crime.  
 अतिपातकिन् mfn. (-की-किनौ-किं) A great sinner, flagrantly criminal. E. अतिपातक and इनि aff.  
 अतिपारक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Very capable, of great abilities. E. अति, and पारक who traverses.  
 अतिपेशल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Very dexterous or clever. E. अति and पेशल clever.  
 अतिप्रसङ्ग m. (-ङ्गः) Frequent repetition, uninterrupted continuance. E. अति, and प्रसाद connexion.  
 अतिबल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Strong, powerful. m. (-लः) An active soldier. f. (-ला) A plant, (Sida cordifolia, and rhombifolia.) See वायुपुत्री E. अति and बल strong.  
 अतिभार m. (-रः) A great or excessive burden. E. अति, and भार aload.  
 अतिभारग m. (-गः) A mule. E. अतिभार, and ग who goes with.

अतिभी m. (-भीः) Lightning, the flash accompanying thunder. E. अति, and भी dread.  
 अतिभूमि f. (-भिः) 1. Something more than was expected or aimed at. 2. Extensive land or limits. 3. Improper conduct, exceeding proper bounds. E. अति, and भूमि land.  
 अतिभृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Carefully cherished or protected. E. अति and भृत cherished.  
 अतिमङ्गल्य mfn. (-ल्यः-ल्या-ल्यं) Very auspicious. m. (ल्यः) A fruit, (Ægle, or Cratœva marmelos) See विल्व. E. अति, and मङ्गल्य auspicious.

 अतिमात्र mfn. (त्रः-त्रा-त्रं) or adverb n. त्रं Much, excessive. E. अति, and मात्र a minute quantity.  
 अतिमानुष mfn. (-षी-षं) 1. Superhuman, more than mortal. 2. Immortal, divine. E. अति, and मानुष human.  
 अतिमाय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) 1. Free from illusion. 2. Entirely liberated or freed. E. अति and माया delusion.  
 अतिमित mfn. (तः-ता-तं) 1. Dry, not wet. 2. Over measured, exceeding. E. अ neg. तिमित moist, or अति and मित meted.  
 अतिसुक्त mfn. (-क्त-क्ता-क्तं) 1. Seedless, barren. 2. Entirely liberated or freed. m. (क्तः) 1. A creeping plant, (Gœrtnera racemosa.) See माषवीलता 2. A tree, (Dalbergia oujeiniensis) E. अति, and सुक्त liberated.  
 अतिसुक्तक m. (-कः) 1. A tree, (Dalbergia oujeiniensis.) 2. Mountain ebony. See तिन्दुक. 3. A creeper. (Gœrtnera racemosa, &c.) E. See अतिसुक्त.  
 अतिमोदा f. (-दा) A tree, (Jasminum arboreum.) E. अति, and मोद delight.  
 अतिरथ m. (-थः) A warrior of a particular order fighting in a car. E. अति, and रथ a chariot.  
 अतिरथिन् m. (-थी) A warrior of a particular class, fighting in a car. E. अति before रथ a car. and इनि aff. also अतिरथ.  
 अतिरसा f. (-सा) A creeper. E. अति, and रस flavour.  
 अतिरिक्त mfn. (-क्तः-क्ता-क्तं) Excessive, exceeding, E. अति, and रिक्त् to flow, with the participial affix क्त.  
 अतिरिक्तता f. (-ता) Increase of bulk or quantity, expansion, enlargement, elevation, &c. E. ता added to the preceding.  
 अतिरेक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Much, excessive. E. अति, and रिक्त् to flow, affix घञ्.  
 अतिरेकिन् mfn. (-की-किणी-किं) More, superior. E. अतिरेक and इनि aff.  
 अतिरोग m. (-गः) Consumption, (Phthisis pulmonalis) E. अति and रोग disease.  
 अतिरोमश m. (-शः) A wild goat, or according to some, a large monkey. mfn. (-शः-शा-शं) Very hairy. E. अति, and रोमश hairy.  
 अतिलुब्ध mfn. (-ब्धः-ब्धा-ब्धं) Very covetous. E. अति, and लुब्ध covetous.  
 अतिलोमश mfn. (-शः-शा-शं) Very hairy. E. अति, and लोमश hairy.  
 अतिवर्त्तन n. (-नं) An accident, a circumstance not capable of being prevented or guarded against. E. अति, and वर्त्तन being.  
 अतिवर्त्तुल m. (-लः) A kind of grain. E. अति, and वर्त्तुल round.
