

अन्ववर्ष mf. (-र्षः-र्षी) A man or woman of the fourth tribe. E. अन्व, and वर्ष a tribe.

अन्वावसायिन् mf. (-यी-यिनी) A man or woman of low caste, especially one of seven classes : a Chanda la, a Swapacka or executioner, a Kshatta or insect hunter, a charioteer, a bard, and a Vaideha or attendant on women. 2. A man or a woman of a particular caste living by the chase. See अन्वावसायिन्.

अन्वेष्टि f. (-ष्टिः) A funeral sacrifice. E. अन्व, and ष्टि sacrifice.

अन्वेष्टिक्रिया f. (-या) Obsequies. E. अन्वेष्टि, and क्रिया rite.

अन्व n. (-न्व) An entrail. E. अन्व to be sick, and च Una'di aff.

अन्वकूज m. (-जः) Grumbling of the bowels, borborygmi. E. अन्व, and कूज murmuring; also अन्वकूजन.

अन्ववृद्धि f. (-द्धिः) Inguinal hernia, rupture. E. अन्व, and वृद्धि increase.

अन्वोद m. (-दः) A worm, ascarides, &c. E. अन्व, and उद what eats.

अन्विका f. (-का) A fire-place.

अन्दु f. (-न्दुः) See अन्दु.

अन्दुक m. (-कः) 1. A ring or chain worn on the ankle. 2. The chain for an elephant's feet. E. अदि to bind, कु affix, and कन् final.

अन्दू f. (-न्दुः) 1. An ornament worn round the ancles. 2. The chain for an elephant's feet. 3. A chain, a fetter, a bond or tie. E. अदि to bind, and क् Una'di aff. or with कु affix अन्दु.

अन्दुक m. (-कः) The chain for an elephant's feet. See the last.

अन्दोल (-त) r. 10th cl. (अन्दोलयति) To agitate, to swing.

अन्व (-त) r. 10th cl. (अन्वयति) To be or become blind.

अन्व mfn. (-न्वः-न्वा-न्वः) Blind. n. (-न्वः) 1. Darkness. 2. Water. E. अन्व to be blind, and अच् aff.

अन्वक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Blind. m. (-कः) 1. The name of a country, apparently Behar. 2. The name of a king. 3. Of a Muni. 4. Of an Asura. E. अन्व to be blind, and कन् aff.

अन्वकरिपु m. (-पुः) 1. A name of SIVA, the enemy of the demon ANDHAKA. E. अन्वक a demon so named, and रिपु an enemy.

अन्वकार mn. (-रः-रं) Darkness. E. अन्व blind, and कार what makes.

अन्वकासुहृद् m. (-दुः) A name of SIVA. E. अन्वक, and असुहृद् the enemy. See अन्वकरिपु.

अन्वकूप m. (-पुः) A blind well. E. अन्व, and कूप a well : one of which the mouth is hidden.

अन्वतमस n. (-सः) Great darkness. E. अन्व to make blind, and तमस darkness : also written अन्वतामसं, अ being made long.

अन्वता f. (-ता) Blindness. Also n. अन्वत्व. E. ता or त्व added to अन्व.

अन्वतामिश्र n. (-श्रः) 1. A division of Tartarus, the second of the twenty-one hells. 2. The doctrine of annihilation after death. E. अन्व blind, great, and तामिश्र darkness.

अन्वसूषा f. (-षा) A small covered crucible, with a hole in the side. E. अन्व, and सूषा a crucible.

अन्वसूषिका f. (-का) The name of a grass. See देवताड.

अन्वस् n. (-न्वः) Boiled rice. E. अद to eat, नम् inserted, and असुन् Una'di affix, द changed to च.

अन्वालजी f. (-जी) A blind boil, one that does not suppurate.

अन्वाहि mf. (-हिः-हिः) A kind of fish, vulg. ku'nchiya; a species of eel ? E. अन्व blind, and अहि a snake : from its form and the smallness of its eyes.

अन्विका f. (-का) 1. Night. 2. Gambling. 3. A small kind of mustard. See सर्षप. 4. A woman. 5. A disease of the eye. E. अन्व dark or blind, and कन् affix in the fem. form.

अन्वीकृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Made or become blind. E. अन्व, and कृत made, चि augment.

अन्वीभूत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Become blind. E. अन्व, and भूत become, चि augment.

अन्वु m. (-न्वुः) A Well. E. अन्व to go, and तुक् Una'di affix ; च is substituted for त.

अन्वुल m. (-लः) A tree, (Mimosa sirisa, Rox.)

अन्वु m. (-न्वुः) A hunter, one who lives by killing game ; a man of low caste, the offspring of a Vaideha father and Karavara mother ; not allowed to reside within a village or town. 2. A country, modern Telingana ; also अन्वु.

अन्न mfn. (-न्नः-न्ना-न्नः) Eaten. n. (-न्नः) 1. Boiled rice. 2. Food in general. 3. Corn. E. अद to eat, and न्न affix of the part. past, त becoming न.

अन्नकाल m. (-कः) Meal time, proper hour for eating. E. अन्न, and काल time.

अन्नकोष्ठ m. (-ष्ठः) A cupboard, a granary. E. अन्न, and कोष्ठ or receptacle.

अन्नकाष्ठक m. (-कः) 1. VISHNU. 2. The sun. m. (-कः) A granary, a cupboard. E. अन्न food, कोष्ठक a repository.

अन्नगन्धि m. (-न्धिः) Dysentery, diarrhoea. E. अन्न food, गन्ध smell.

अन्नज mfn. (-जः-जा-जं) Springing from or occasioned by food. E. अन्न, and ज born.

अन्नजल n. (-जं) Support, subsistence. E. अन्न, and जल water, meat and drink.

अन्नद mfn. (-दः-दा-दं) One who gives food. f. (-दा) A goddess, a form of DURGA. E. अन्न, and द who gives.

अन्नदातृ m. (-ता) One who gives food, a charitable man. E. अन्न, and दातृ donor.

अन्नदान n. (-नं) The giving of rice or food, the maintenance of a person. E. अन्न, and दान giving.

अन्नद्वेष m. (-षः) Want of appetite, dislike of food. E. अन्न, and द्वेष dislike.

अन्नपरिवर्त m. (-र्तः) Change of diet. E. अन्न, and परिवर्त revolution.

अन्नपूर्णा f. (-र्णा) A goddess, a form of DURGA. E. अन्न, and पूर्ण who fills with.

अन्नपूर्वा f. (-र्वा) A goddess, a form of DURGA. E. अन्न, and पूर्व prior.

अन्नप्राशन n. (-नं) A religious ceremony, in which after presenting oblations to fire, a little rice is, for the first time, put into the child's mouth ; it should take place between the fifth and eighth month. E. अन्न, and प्राशन feeding.

अन्नब्रह्म n. (-ह्म) The deification of food, considering it in the light of BRAHMA, as the pervader and supporter of existence. E. अन्न, and ब्रह्म the Supreme.

अन्नभूमि f. (-भिः) A large collection of food. E. अन्न, and भूमि a heap.

अन्नमय mfn. (-यः-यी-यं) 1. Composed of food, containing food. 2. Derived or made from food. m. (-यः) The body. E. अन्न and मयद् aff.

अन्नमयकोष m. (-षः) The gross material body, that which is sustained by food. E. अन्नमय, and कोष sheath, (of the spirit.)

अन्नमल n. (-लं) Spirituous liquor, the excrement or ferment of rice, &c. E. अन्न, and मल fecula.

अन्नरस m. (-सः) Chyle. E. अन्न, and रस juice.

अन्नलिप्सा f. (-प्सा) Hunger, craving. E. अन्न, and लिप्सा desire.

अन्नवाहिस्त्रोतस् n. (-तः) The oesophagus. E. अन्न, and वाहि what conveys, स्त्रोतस् canal.

अन्नविकार m. (-रः) The seminal secretion. E. अन्न, and विकार change of form.

अन्नशेष m. (-षः) Leavings, offal. E. अन्न, and शेष remainder.

अन्नाद mfn. (-दः-दा-दं) 1. Feeding, eating. 2. The partaker or eater of another's food. m. (-दः) VISHNU. E. अन्न, and अद who eats.

अन्नायिन् mfn. (-यी-यिनी-यि) Hungry ; desiring food. E. अन्न nominal verb to want food, यिनि aff.

अन्नाहारिन् mfn. (-री-रिणी-रि) Eating, feeding. E. अन्न, and आहारिन् who eats.

अन्व mfn. (-न्वः-न्वा-न्वत्) 1. Other, different. 2. Unlike. E. अन्व to live, and यक् aff.

अन्वत् ind. Otherwise. E. See the last.

अन्वगामिन् mfn. (-मी-मिनी-मि) 1. Adulterous. 2. Going to another (place, &c.) E. अन्व another (husband or wife), गामिन् who goes to.
