

अपतल्वक्र m. (-कः) Spasmodic contraction of the body, emprosthotonos. E. अप away, तल्व will, कन् aff.

अपतर्पण n. (-णं) Fasting, (in sickness.) E. अप bad, and तर्पण satisfaction.

अपतानक m. (-कः) Spasmodic contraction : see the last. E. अप down, तन to spread, लुक् aff.

अपत्य n. (-त्वं) Offspring, male or female. E. अप neg. पत to fall, and यत् affix ; the family being upheld by them.

अपत्यदा f. (-दा) A midwife. E. अपत्य offspring, and दा fem. deriv. who gives.

अपत्यपथ m. (-थः) The vulva. E. अपत्य, and पथ the road.

अपत्यविक्रयिन् m. (-यी) A father who receives a gratuity from his son-in-law, a seller of his offspring. E. अपत्य, and विक्रयिन् who sells.

अपत्यशत्रु m. (-त्रुः) A crab. E. अपत्य offspring, and शत्रु an enemy. The crab being said to perish on producing young.

अपवप mfn. (-पः-पा-पं) 1. Bashful, modest. 2. Immodest. f (-पा) 1. Bashfulness. 2. Want of shame, immodesty. E. अप, and अपा shame.

अपत्रपिण्डु mfn. (-णुः-णुः-णुः) Bashful. E. अप before, प to be ashamed, and इणुक् aff.

अपथ n. (-थं) The absence of a road. E. अप priv. and पथ for पथिन् a road.

अपथिन् m. (-थि) See the preceding.

अपथ्य mfn. (-थ्यः-थ्या-थ्यं) 1. Unsuitable, inconsistent. 2. (In medicine) Contra-indicated, unfit as food or drink in particular complaints. E. अप neg. पथ्य suitable.

अपद mfn. (-द-दा or -दौ-दं) 1. Footless, having no feet. 2. Having no place, no station. adv. n. (-दं) Unseasonably, inopportunately. m. (-दः) A reptile. E. अप neg. पद a foot.

अपदान n. (-नं) 1. Approved occupation. 2. Work well or completely done. E. अप before, दा to give, and ल्युट् aff.

अपदानक n. (-कं) See the above. E. कन् added.

अपदान्तर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Adjoining, contiguous. n. (-रं) Proximity, close, contiguity. E. अप neg. पद a foot, and अन्तर between.

अपदार्थ m. (-र्थः) Nonentity. E. अप neg. पदार्थ a thing.

अपदिश n. or ind. (-शं) Intermediate space, half of a point of the compass. E. अप, and दिश to show, क् aff.

अपदिश्य ind. 1. Dispersing, going or having gone to various quarters. 2. Having shewn or stated. E. अप before, दिश to show, य aff.

अपदेवता f. (-ता) An evil spirit, a goblin. E. अप, and देवता a deity.

अपदेश m. (-शः) 1. Evasion, prevarication. 2. Disguise by dress, &c. 3. Place, quarter. 4. A butt or mark. 5. Cause. 6. Fame, reputation. 7. A contrivance, a pretence, a pretext. E. अप ill, badly, &c. and दिश to shew, with चञ् aff.

अपद्रव्य n. (-व्यं) 1. An impurity, any bad thing. 2. Alloy, adulteration. E. अप, and द्रव्य thing.

अपध्वंस m. (-सः) Degradation, disgrace. E. अप, and ध्वंस loss.

अपध्वंसज m. (-जः) A man of a mixed or impure caste. E. अपध्वंस and ज born.

अपध्वंस mfn. (-सः-सा-सं) 1. Cursed, reviled. 2. Abandoned. 3. Pounded. E. अप implying contempt, &c. part. past of ध्वंस to go, also अपध्वंस.

अपध्वान n. (-नं) Evil thoughts, wickedness. E. अप, and ध्वान meditation.

अपनयन n. (-नं) 1. Taking away, withdrawing, removing. 2. Destroying. 3. Dying. 4. Acquittance of a debt or obligation. E. अप from, णी to take, ल्युट् aff.

अपनीत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Taken away, removed. 2. Paid, discharged. E. अप from, णी to take, क् aff.

अपनीय ind. 1. Having taken away. 2. Having discharged. E. अप before, णी to take, य aff.

अपनुत्ति f. (-त्तिः) Removing, taking or sending away. E. अप, नुद to send, क्तिन् aff.

अपनीद m. (-दः) Removing, taking away. E. अप, and नुद to send, affix चञ्.

अपनीदन n. (-नं) 1. Removing, destroying. 2. Expiating. E. अप before, नुद to send, ल्युट् aff.

अपपाव mfn. (-वः-वा-वं) Of low caste, using separate vessels. n. (-वं) A separate vessel, one from which no one else will eat. E. अप apart, पाव a vessel.

अपपाचित m. (-तः) A person who has lost caste, one with whom his kindred will not eat or drink, from a common pa'tra or vessel. E. अपपाव, and इतच् aff.

अपभी mfn. (-भीः-भीः-भि) Fearless, undaunted. E. अप away, भी fear.

अपभ्रंश m. (-शः) Ungrammatical language. E. अप from, भ्रंश to fall, and चच् affix ; also अपभ्रंस.

अपम m. (-मः) Declination, (in astronomy.) E. अप, मा to measure, ड aff.

अपमान n. (-नं) Disrespect, disgrace. E. अप reverse, and मन to respect, affix चञ्.

अपमानित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Disrespect, disgraced. E. अपमान disgrace, इतच् aff.

अपमान्य mfn. (-न्यः-न्या-न्यं) Disreputable, dishonourable. E. अप before, मन to mind, खत् aff.

अपमिन् mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Neglect in dress or person, unadorned. 2. Disrespected, disgraced. E. अप before, मा to measure, क्त् aff.

अपमिल्यक n. (-कं) Debt. E. अप from, मि to throw, and त्यकन् aff.

अपमृत्यु m. (-त्युः) Sudden death, dying of some casualty, not of sickness or decay. E. अप, मृत्यु death.

अपयशस् n. (-शः) Disgrace, infamy. E. अप before, यशस् fame.

अपयशस्कर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Disgraceful, occasioning infamy. E. अपयशस् and कर what makes.

अपयान n. (-नं) Retreat, flight. E. अप from, and यान going.

अपर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) 1. Other. 2. Opposite, contrary. 3. Posterior, (in place or time.) 4. Similar, same. 5. Friendly, not adverse. n. (-रं) The hind quarter of an elephant. f. (-रा) 1. The womb. 2. Suppressed menstruation in pregnancy. 3. The west. E. अप neg. and पर from पृ to nourish or fill, and अच् affix ; or अप neg. and पर other.

अपरच् ind. Again, moreover. E. च the particle added to the last.

अपरत्न n. (-त्नं) 1. Opposition, contrariety. 2. Posteriorly, (in place or time ; ) also अपरता f. (-ता) E. त् or तल् added to अपर.

अपरति m. (-तिः) Stopping, ceasing. E. अप from, रत्न to please, and क्तिन् aff.

अपररात्र m. (-त्रः) The end of the night, the last watch. E. अपर the end, रात्र from रात्रि a night.

अपरलोक n. (-कं) Another world, paradise. E. अपर, and लोक world.

अपरव m. (-वः) 1. Contest, dispute. 2. Discord. E. अप, and रव sound.

अपरवक्र n. (-क्रं) A kind of metre of four lines, having every two lines the same.

अपरवीकृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Undisturbed, undisputed. E. अपरव, and उक्कित free from.

अपरस्वर adj. mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) or adv. n. (-रं) 1. Continued, uninterrupted. 2. Continually, (applied to action.) E. अप neg. and परस्वर mutual.

अपरास्तुख mfn. (-खः-खी-खं) Not having the head downwards or reverted. 2. Presenting a firm front in battle or danger. E. अप neg. परास्तुख reverted.

अपराजित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Unconquered, unsurpassed. m. (-तः) 1. A name of SIVA. 2. Also of VISHNU. 3. A sage. f. (-ता) 1. A name applied to several plants. 2. (Clitoria ternatea,) see गिरिकर्षी. 3. Aeschynomene sesban, see जया. and, 4. Another plant, see अश्वत्थी. 5. A name of the goddess DURGA. 6. A species of the शर्कर metre of four lines, with fourteen syllables in each line. 7. The north-east quarter. E. अपर another, अप neg. and जित conquered, excelled, &c.

अपराजेय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Unconquerable, invincible. E. अपर, and अजेय unconquerable.
