

अपराह mfn. (-ङः-डा-ङ्) 1. Criminal, guilty. 2. Erring. E. अप before, राध to accomplish, क्त aff.

अपराहपृषत्क m. (-त्कः) An archer or arrow always missing the butt. E. अपराह erring, and पृषत्क an arrow.

अपराहृ mfn. (-ङा-ङी-ङ्) Offending an offender. E. अप before राध, with ट्च् aff.

अपराध m. (-धः) Offence, transgression, fault. E. अप badly, and राध to accomplish, घञ् aff.

अपराधित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Criminated, condemned. E. अपराध and क्त aff.

अपराधिता f. (-ता) Criminality, guilt. So अपराधित n. (-त्वं) E. तल् or ल added to अपराधिन्.

अपराधिन् mfn. (-धी-धिनी-धि) Offending, culpable, criminal. E. अपराध, and इनि aff.

अपराधीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Independent. E. अप neg. पराधीन dependent.

अपराह्ण m. (-ह्णः) Afternoon, the last watch of the day. E. अपर last, and अह्ण for अह्ण a day.

अपराह्णतन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Belonging to or produced in the close of the day, also अपराह्णतन. E. अपराह्ण the end of a day, with द्यु or द्युल् aff.

अपरिक्लित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Unknown. 2. Unseen. E. अप neg. परिक्लित seen.

अपरिक्लिन्न mfn. (-न्नः-न्ना-न्नं) Dry, not moist, not liquid. E. अप neg. परिक्लिन्न moist.

अपरिगत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Unknown, unobtained. E. अप neg. परिगत obtained.

अपरिग्रह m. (-हः) Non-acceptance. E. अप neg. परिग्रह taking.

अपरिग्राह्य mfn. (-ह्यः-ह्या-ह्यं) Unfit or improper to be accepted, not to be taken. E. अप neg. परिग्राह्य to be taken.

अपरिचयिन् mfn. (-यी-यिनी-यि) 1. Without acquaintance. 2. Misanthropic. E. अप neg. परिचयिन् acquainted.

अपरिचित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Unacquainted with, unknown to. E. अप neg. परिचित known.

अपरिचय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Unsociable. E. अप neg. परिचय to be combined.

अपरिच्छद n. (-दं) Absence of clothing, nudity. E. अप neg. परिच्छद covering.

अपरिच्छन्न mfn. (-न्नः-न्ना-न्नं) Uncovered, unclothed. So अपरिच्छादित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) E. अप neg. परिच्छन्न or परिच्छादित clothed.

अपरिच्छिन्न mfn. (-न्नः-न्ना-न्नं) Continuous, connected without interval. E. अप neg. परिच्छिन्न intersected.

अपरिच्छेद m. (-दः) 1. Want of arrangement or order. 2. Want of distinction or division. E. अप neg. परिच्छेद section.

अपरिच्छेदित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Unarranged, not distinguished or divided. E. अप neg. परिच्छेदित intersected.

अपरिणयन n. (-नं) Celibacy. E. अप neg. परिणयन marrying.

अपरिणीता f. (-ता) An unmarried woman. E. अप neg. परिणीता married woman.

अपरिपक्व mfn. (-क्वः-क्वा-क्वं) Not quite mature. E. अप neg. परिपक्व ripe.

परिपाटि f. (-टिः-टी) Want of order, disarrangement. E. अप neg. परिपाटि order.

अपरिपूत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Unripe, immature, imperfect. E. अप neg. परिपूत perfect.

अपरिमाण mfn. (-णः-णा-णं) Without measure, immense, immeasurable. E. अप neg. परिमाण measure.

अपरिमित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Unmeasured. 2. Unlimited, unbounded. E. अप neg. परिमित measured.

अपरिमेय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Unbounded, illimitable. E. अप neg. परिमेय measurable.

अपरिस्नान mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Pure, clean. E. अप neg. परिस्नान dirty.

अपरिवाद्य mfn. (-द्यः-द्या-द्यं) Not to be reprimanded. E. अप neg. परिवाद्य to be reprovod.

अपरिवृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Uninclosed, unsurrounded. E. अप neg. परिवृत surrounded.

अपरिष्कार m. (-रः) Coarseness, rudeness, want of polish or finish, moral or physical. E. अप neg. परिष्कार polish.

अपरिष्कृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Coarse, rude, unpolished, unadorned, morally or physically. E. अप neg. परिष्कृत finished.

अपरिसर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Distant, not contiguous. E. अप neg. परिसर near.

अपरिहरणीय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Not to be abandoned or lost. E. अप neg. परिहृ to leave, अनैयर् aff.

अपरिहार्य mfn. (-र्यः-र्या-र्यं) 1. Not to be avoided, inevitable. 2. Not to be abandoned. 3. Not to be degraded. E. अप neg. परिहृ to leave, ष्यत् aff.

अपरीक्षित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Untried, unproved. E. अप neg. परीक्षित tried.

अपरूप mfn. (-पः-पा-पी-पं) Ugly, deformed, ill-looking, ill-made, monstrous. n. (-पं) Monstrousness, deformity. E. अप bad, रूप form.

अपर्ण mfn. (-र्णः-र्णा-र्णं) Leafless. f. (-र्णा) A name of PÁRVATI. E. अप not, and पर्ण a leaf: the goddess not having even leaves for food, during her performance of religious austerities.

अपर्याप्त mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Unlimited, unbounded. 2. Incompetent, unable, insufficient. 3. Incomplete, not enough. E. अप neg. पर्याप्त extended.

अपर्याय m. (-यः) Want of order or method. E. अप neg. पर्याय order.

अपल n. (-लं) A pin or bolt. E. अप below, and ल्वा to take, ड aff.

अपलाप m. (-पः) 1. Denial or concealment of knowledge, evasion. 2. Affection, regard. 3. Concealing, hiding. E. अप away or kindly, and लप to speak, घञ् affix; also अपलपन n. (-नं)

अपलापिन् mfn. (-पी-पिनी-पि) One who denies or evades. E. अपलाप and इनि aff.

अपलाषिका f. (-का) Thirst. E. अप, लष to desire, कन् aff.

अपवन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Without air, sheltered from wind. n. (-नं) A garden, grove. E. अप, and वन a wood, or अप neg. पवन wind.

अपवरक m. (-कः) An inner apartment, the lying-in chamber. E. अप before, वृञ् to hide or close, अच् and कन् affs.

अपवरण n. (-णं) 1. Covering, screening. 2. A garment, a mantle. E. अप before, वृ to screen, ल्युट् aff.

अपवर्ग m. (-र्गः) 1. Final beatitude, the delivery of the soul from the body, and exemption from farther transmigration. 2. Abandoning, quitting. 3. The fruit or consequences of any completed act. 4. The completion of any act. 5. Any act brought to a conclusion. 6. End, completion. E. अप from, वृञ् to forsake, घञ् affix, and न substituted for ज.

अपवर्गद mfn. (-दः-दा-दं) Conferring final beatitude. E. अपवर्ग, and द् who gives.

अपवर्जन n. (-नं) 1. Gift or donation. 2. Final emancipation or beatitude. 3. Abandoning, abandonment. E. अप before, वृञ् to forsake, and ल्युट् aff. See अपवर्ग.

अपवर्जित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Abandoned, quitted, got rid of, given cast away. E. अप before, वृञ् to forsake, क्त aff.

अपवर्त्त m. (-र्त्तः) 1. Taking away. 2. A common measure in algebra. E. अप away, वृत् to be, घञ् aff.

अपवर्त्तन n. (-नं) 1. Agitating, shaking. 2. Taking away, removal, resumption. 3. Transferring, removing from one place to another. 4. Abbreviation, abridging. 5. Division by a common measure, reduction of a fraction to its lowest terms. E. अप away, वृत् to be, ल्युट् aff.

अपवाद m. (-दः) 1. Censure, blame. 2. An order, a command. 3. Difference, distinction, exception. 4. Contradiction, opposition, denial. E. अप implying aversion, and वाद speech, from वद with घञ्; also अववाद.

अपवादक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) 1. Censuring, accusing. 2. Opposing, objecting to. 3. Excepting, excluding. E. अप before, वद to speak, ल्युट् aff.
