

अपवादित mfn. (-तः-ता-त्) 1. Accused, censured. 2. Opposed, objected to. E. अप before, वद to speak, causal form, क्त aff.

अपवादिन् mfn. (-दी-दिनी-दि) 1. Accusing, defaming. 2. Opposing, objecting to. E. अपवाद and इनि aff.

अपवारण n. (-णं) Disappearance, concealment, covering. E. अप before, वृञ् to hide, in the causal form, ल्युट् aff.

अपवारित mfn. (-तः-ता-त्) Covered, concealed, disappeared. E. अप before, वृञ् to hide, क्त affix, and the vowel is made long.

अपवाये ind. 1. (In theatrical language) Apart, aside. 2. Having concealed. E. अप before, वृञ् to hide, खत् aff.

अपवाह m. (-हः) An inference or deduction. E. अप before, वह् to bear, घञ् aff.

अपवित्र mfn. (-त्रः-त्रा-त्रं) Impure, unclean. E. अ neg. पवित्र pure.

अपवित्रता f. (-ता) Impurity, uncleanness. So अपवित्रत्व n. (-त्व) E. तल् or ल् added to the last.

अपविद्ध mfn. (-द्धः-द्धा-द्धं) 1. Rejected, dismissed, removed. 2. Thrown, sent. 3. Broken to pieces. E. अप before. व्यध to strike, क्त the part. affix, and the semivowel changed to its corresponding vowel द्.

अपविद्धपुत्र m. (-त्रः) A son rejected by his natural parents, and adopted by a stranger; one of the twelve objects of filiation in Hindu law. E. अपविद्ध as before, and पुत्र a son.

अपविषा f. (-षा) A species of grass, (Kyllingia monocephala.) E. अप, and विष poison.

अपवृत्त mfn. (-त्तः-त्ता-त्तं) 1. Reversed, inverted, overturned. 2. Deprived of. 3. Uncovered. E. अप, and वृत्त established.

अपवेध m. (-धः) Piercing any thing in the wrong direction. E. अप, and वेध perforating.

अपव्यय m. (-यः) Prodigality. E. अप, and व्यय expense.

अपव्ययमान mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) 1. Squandering. 2. Denying a debt. E. अप away, व्यय expenditure, used as a verb, शानच् aff.

अपव्ययिन् mfn. (-यी-यिनी-यि) Squandering, wasting, prodigal. E. अपव्यय and इनि aff.

अपशङ्क mfn. (-ङ्कः-ङ्का-ङ्कं) Fearless, having no fear or hesitation. adv. n. (-ङ्) Fearlessly. E. अप, and शङ्क fear.

अपशब्द m. (-द्) A low man. See अपसद.

अपशब्द m. (-ब्दः) 1. Ungrammatical language. 2. Common or vulgar speech, any form of language not Sanskrit. E. अप bad, and शब्द sound.

अपशुच् m. (-शुक्) The soul. E. अप, and शुच् sorrow.

अपशीक m. (-कः) A tree, (Jonesia asoca.) E. अप, and शीक sorrow.

अपष्ट n. (-ष्टं) The end or point of the hook for driving an elephant. E. अप before, ष्टे to surround, and ड aff.

अपष्टम m. (-मः) The point of the hook by which elephants are driven.

अपष्टु m. (-ष्टुः) Time. mfn. (-ष्टुः-ष्टुः-ष्टु) 1. Contrary, opposite. 2. Left, (not right.) ind. 1. Well, properly. 2. Handsomely. 3. Contrary, perversely. E. अप badly, ष्टु what stays, with क्त Una'di affix; ष्टु becomes ष्ट.

अपष्टुर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Opposite, contrary. E. अपष्टु, contrary, and र from रा to obtain, affix ड.

अपष्टुल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Opposite, contrary. E. As before, ल substituted for र.

अपस् n. (-पः) Sacrificing. E. आप to obtain, असुन् Una'di aff.; the radical vowel made short.

अपसद m. (-दः) A low man, an outcaste; it especially applies to the children of six degrading connexions, or of a Brahman with the women of the three lower classes; of a Kshetriya with women of two, the Vaisya and Su'dra; and of a Vaisya with one of a lower class or a Su'dra. E. अप low, सद to abide, and अच् aff.

अपसर m. (-रः) The removal of any thing from one place to another. E. अप before, सृ to go, अच् aff.

अपसर्जन n. (-नं) 1. A gift or donation. 2. Killing. 3. Final emancipation. 4. Abandonment. E. अप before, सृञ् to leave, and ल्युट् aff.

अपसरण n. (-णं) Going out, egress. E. अप before, सरणं going.

अपसर्प m. (-र्पः) A secret emissary or agent, a spy. So अपसर्पक m. (-कः) E. अप bad, &c. सर्प who goes; from सृप with अच् aff.

अपसलवि ind. The space between the thumb and the forefinger.

अपसव्य mfn. (-व्यः-व्या-व्यं) 1. Opposite, contrary. 2. Right, (not left.) n. (-व्यं) The space between the thumb and the forefinger. E. अप, and सव्य left.

अपसव्यक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) See the above. E. कन् added.

अपसार m. (-रः) 1. Egress, passage for going forth. 2. Going out or away. E. अप before, सार a going.

अपसारित mfn. (-तः-ता-त्) Gone out, got out, escaped, fled. E. अप before, सारित gone.

अपस्तर m. (-रः) 1. Any part of a carriage. 2. The anus. 3. Faeces. E. अप, and कर from कृष to furrow, or कृ to do; ष is inserted for the sake of euphony.

अपस्नात mfn. (-तः-ता-त्) 1. Bathed or bathing after mourning, or upon the death of a connexion. 2. Bathed after death. (the corpse,) preparatory to other ceremonies. E. अप, and स्नात bathed, from स्ना, and क्त aff.

अपस्नान n. (-नं) 1. Funereal bathing, upon the death of a connexion, after mourning, &c. 2. Impure bathing, or bathing in water with which a person has previously washed. E. अप, and स्नान bathing.

अपस्यश mfn. (-शः-शा-शं) 1. Being without spies or emissaries. 2. Wanting the introduction or explanation, (grammar.) E. अप with स्यश a spy, or अ and पस्यश the first section of the Bha'shya.

अपस्मार m. (-रः) Epilepsy, falling sickness. E. अप privation, स्मृ to remember, and घञ् affix; loss of memory or sense.

अपस्मारिन् mfn. (-री-रिणी-रि) Epileptic, convulsed. E. इनि added to the last.

अपहत mfn. (-तः-ता-त्) Destroyed. E. अप, and हत killed.

अपहरण n. (-णं) 1. Taking away, carrying off, stealing, &c. 2. Taking back, resuming. E. अप before, हृ to take, ल्युट् aff.

अपहरणीय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) 1. To be taken away, carried off, stolen, &c. 2. To be taken back or resumed. E. अप before, हृ to take, अनीयर् affix; also अपहर्त्तव्य, and अपहायं.

अपहस्त n. (-स्तं) 1. Taking away or off. 2. Stealing, plundering. E. अप, and हस्त the hand.

अपहस्तित mfn. (-तः-ता-त्) Lost, gone, parted with or deprived of. E. अप, हस्त the hand, इतच् aff.

अपहानि f. (-निः) 1. Exception, exclusion. 2. Quitting, leaving. 3. Leaving off, stopping. E. अप, and हानि abandoning.

अपहाय ind. Having left or abandoned. 2. Except, excepting. E. अप before, हा to abandon, य aff.

अपहार m. (-रः) 1. Loss. 2. Taking away. 3. Theft, stealing. 4. Secreting. 5. Spending another person's property. E. अप before, हृ to take, घञ् aff.

अपहारक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) One who takes away, seizing, taking a thief. E. अपहृ to take away, खुल् aff.

अपहारिन् mfn. (-री-रिणी-रि) One who takes away, who seizes, steals, &c. a plunderer, a thief. E. अपहृ to steal, णिनि aff.

अपहास m. (-सः) Silly or causeless laughter. E. अप before, हास laughter.

अपहत mfn. (-तः-ता-त्) 1. Taken away, carried off, stolen, &c. 2. Taken back, resumed. E. अप before, हृत taken.

अपहृव m. (-वः) 1. Denial or concealment of knowledge. 2. Affection. E. अप before, हृङ् to conceal, and अच् aff.

अपहृत mfn. (-तः-ता-त्) Concealed, denied. E. अप before, हृ and क्त aff.

अपहृति f. (-तिः) 1. Denial or concealment of knowledge. 2. A figure of rhetoric, applying a description or simile to other than its obvious application. E. अपहृङ् and क्तिन् aff.
