

- अपह्नीद mfn. (-ता-ची-द) One who conceals or denies. E. अपह्नुच् and दच् aff.
- अपाक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) 1. Immature, raw, undressed or unripe. 2. Undigested. m. (-कः) 1. Immaturity. 2. Indigestion. E. अ neg. पाक ripeness.
- अपाकरण n. (-णं) 1. Payment, liquidation. 2. Removal, abstraction. E. अप and आङ् before क् to make, ल्युट् aff.
- अपाकशाक n. (-कं) Ginger. E. अपाक indigestion, and शाक herb.
- अपाकृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Taken away, removed, destroyed, void of. 2. Paid. E. अप and आ before क्त made.
- अपाकृति f. (-तिः) 1. Removal, taking away. 2. Change of form or condition. E. अप and आ before कृति doing, or अप with, आकृति form.
- अपाच mfn. (-चः-चा-चं) Present, perceptible. E. अप before, and अक्ष an organ of sense, or अक्षि the eye.
- अपङ्क्त mfn. (-क्तः-क्ता-क्ते) 1. Not in a line or row. 2. Not in the same degree or class, unworthy, inadmissible into society, excluded. E. अ neg. पङ्क्ति a line, अण् affix; also similar derivatives as अपाङ्क्ता, &c.
- अपाङ्क्त्य mfn. (-यः-या-यं) 1. Not in a line or row. 2. Not in the same degree or order of society. E. अ neg. पङ्क्ति a line, टक् aff. See अपाङ्कत.
- अपाङ्क्तोपहत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Defiled or contaminated by the presence of impure or improper persons. E. अपाङ्क्ता excluded, उपहत affected by.
- अपाङ्ग n. (-ङ्गं) 1. The outer corner of the eye. 2. A sectarial mark or circlet on the forehead. mfn. (-ङ्गः-ङ्गी-ङ्गं) Maimed, crippled. E. अप before अङ्गि to go, and अच् affix, or अङ्ग a limb.
- अपाङ्गक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Maimed, mutilated. m. (-कः) 1. A plant, (*Achyranthes aspera*.) 2. The outer angle of the eye. E. अप before the body, and क aff.
- अपाङ्गदर्शन n. (-नं) A side glance, a leer, a wink. E. अपाङ्ग the corner of अङ्ग the eye, and दर्शन looking.
- अपाच or अपाच mfn. (अपाङ् अपाची अपाक) South, southern. E. See अवाच्.
- अपाच mfn. (-चः-चा-चं) 1. Southern, southerly. 2. Not to be ripened or digested. E. अपाच्, and यत् affix or अ neg. पाच to be ripened.
- अपाचीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) 1. South, southern. 2. Opposite. E. अपाच् and ख aff.
- अपाटव n. (-वं) 1. Sickness, disease. 2. Awkwardness, inelegance. E. अ priv. and पाटव strength, cleverness, &c. See अपट्.
- अपाण्डियहण n. (-णं) Celibacy. E. अ neg. पाण्डियहण taking the hand, as in marrying.
- अपात्र n. (-त्रं) 1. A worthless or common utensil. 2. An inferior or worthless person. E. अ neg. पात्र a vessel.
- अपाचीकरण n. (-णं) 1. Acting unbecomingly, doing degrading offices, as for a BRAHMAN to receive wealth improperly acquired; to trade, to serve a SUDRA, and to utter an untruth. 2. Excommunication, disqualification. E. अ neg. पात्र a vessel, करणं making, त्रि augment; disqualifying a person from eating out of the same vessel as another.
- अपादान n. (-नं) 1. Removal, ablation, the sense of the fifth or ablative case. 2. Taking away. E. अप from, आदान taking.
- अपान n. (-नं) 1. The anus. 2. A fart, one of the five vital airs. E. अप below, अन to breathe, चञ् aff.
- अपान्नाथ m. (-थः) The ocean. E. अपान् of water, नाथ lord.
- अपान्निधि m. (-धिः) The ocean. E. अपान् of water, निधि receptacle.
- अपाप mfn. (-पः-पा-पं) Sinless, virtuous, pure. So अपापिन् mfn. (-पी-पिनी-पि) E. अ neg. and पाप sin or पापिन् sinner.
- अपामार्ग m. (-र्गः) A plant, (*Achyranthes aspera*.) E. अप, रज्ज to clean, with आङ् prefixed, and चञ् affix; the ashes are used in washing linen.
- अपान्यति m. (-तिः) 1. The ocean. 2. A name of VARUNA. See अपपति. E. अपान् genitive case of अप water, and पति master.
- अपाम्पित n. (-त्) Fire. E. अपाम् of water, and पित्त bile; drying it up.
- अपाय m. (-यः) 1. Destruction, annihilation. 2. Separation, disunion. 3. Loss, injury. 4. Departure, going away. 5. Retreat, flight. E. अप away, अय going.
- अपायिन् mfn. (-यी-यिनी-यि) 1. Going away, departing, perishing. E. अपाय and इनि aff.
- अपार n. (-रं) The opposite bank of a river. mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Unbounded, boundless, interminable. E. अ neg. पार shore.
- अपारक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Incompetent, impotent. E. अ neg. पारक who gets through or over.
- अपार्थ mfn. (-र्थः-र्था-र्थं) 1. Useless, unprofitable. 2. Unmeaning. E. अप without, अर्थ object, also with कन् added अपार्थक.
- अपार्थकरण n. (-णं) A false plea in a law suit. E. अपार्थ, and करण making.
- अपावर्त्तन n. (-नं) 1. Turning away or from. 2. Retreat, repulse. 3. Returning. E. अप and आङ् before, वृत् to be, ल्युट् aff.
- अपावृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Self-willed, unrestrained. 2. Covered, concealed. 3. Surrounded, inclosed. 4. Opened. 5. Driven away. adv. (-रं) Immoderately, unreservedly. E. अप priv. वृच् to hide, with आङ् prefixed, and त्त aff.
- अपावृति f. (-तिः) 1. Enclosing, surrounding. 2. Covering, screening. E. अप and आङ् before, वृत् to hide, क्तिन् aff.
- अपावृत्त mfn. (-त्तः-त्ता-त्तं) 1. Rolling on the ground, (as a horse.) 2. Uncovered. 3. Driven back or to the rear, repelled. E. अप before, वृत् to stand, and त्त aff.
- अपावृत्ति f. (-तिः) 1. Retreat, repulse. 2. Returning. E. अप and आङ् before, वृत् to be, क्तिन् aff.
- अपाश्रय m. (-यः) An awning spread over a court or yard. mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Helpless, destitute. E. अप, and आश्रय protection.
- अपासङ्ग m. (-ङ्गः) A quiver; also उपासङ्ग.
- अपासन n. (-नं) 1. Quitting, foregoing, discarding. 2. Killing, slaughter. E. अप, अस to be, and ल्युट् aff.
- अपासरण n. (-णं) Departing, departure, removal. E. अप and आङ् before, सृ to go, ल्युट् aff.
- अपासित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Thrown or cut down, injured, destroyed. E. अप with अस to throw, त्त affix and इट् augment.
- अपासृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Gone, departed, gone away. E. अप, and आङ् before, सृ to go, त्त aff.
- अपास्त mfn. (-स्तः-स्ता-स्तं) 1. Thrown off, set aside. 2. Driven away, expelled. 3. Discarded, abandoned. 4. Disregarded, contemned. E. अप and अस to throw, त्त aff.
- अपास्य ind. 1. Having quitted or left. 2. Having thrown away. 3. Disregarding. E. अप, and अस to throw, य aff.
- अपि ind. A preposition and particle corresponding to even, though, yet, assuredly, &c. and implying. 1. Interrogation. 2. Earnest interrogation or enquiry. 3. Doubt. 4. Possibility. 5. Reproof; and. 6. Conjunction. 7. It is often an expletive. E. अ neg. and पि to go, with क्तिप् aff.
- अपिगीर्ण mfn. (-र्णः-र्णा-र्णं) Praised. E. अपि before, गीर्ण part. past, irregularly formed from गृ to sound.
- अपिच ind. Moreover, also.
- अपिच्छल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Clear, free from sediment or soil. E. अ neg. पिच्छल muddy.
- अपितु ind. If, if indeed, yet, but yet. E. अपि, and तु but, and, &c.
- अपितृक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) See the next. E. अ neg. पितृ a father, कन् added.
- अपितृ mfn. (-तृः-तृ-तृ) Uninherited, acquired, not ancestral or paternal. E. अ neg. पितृ a father, क्वप् aff.
- अपिधान n. (-नं) Covering, concealment, disappearance. E. अपि before धा to have or hold, and ल्युट् aff. See पिधान.
- अपिनद्ध mfn. (-द्धः-द्धा-द्धं) Clothed, accoutred. E. अपि, and नद्ध part. past of नह् to bind.
