

अभ्यन्विषीष m. (-नः) A soldier who faces the enemy valiantly. E. अभि before, or against, अभिन्न an enemy, and ख् affix ; the affix being क् or घत्, the word is also written अभ्यन्विषीय or अभ्यन्विषीय.

अभ्यार्चन n. (-नं) Worship, reverence. E. अभि before अर्च to worship, affix ल्युट्.

अभ्यर्चनी f. (-नी) Respect, worship. E. अभि, and अर्चनी reverence.

अभ्यर्च्य mfn. (-र्च्यः-र्च्यः-र्च्यः) Near, proximate. E. अभि near, अर्च irr. part. past, of अर्च to go.

अभ्यर्चना f. (-ना) Petition, request. E. अभि before अर्च to ask, युच् aff.

अभ्यर्थात् mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Asked, invited. E. अभि, and अर्थात् asked.

अभ्यर्थात् mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Fit, proper, becoming. E. अभि, and अर्थात् proper.

अभ्यवकर्षण n. (-णं) Extraction, drawing out. E. अभि, and अव prefixed to कृष draw furrows, affix ल्युट्.

अभ्यवस्कन्द m. (-न्दः) 1. Striking so as to disable an enemy. 2. Facing an enemy. E. अभि and अव before स्कन्द to go, affix घञ्; also with ल्युट् affix, अभ्यवस्कन्दनं.

अभ्यवहरण n. (-णं) Eating. E. अभि and अव before हृ to make, ल्युट् aff.

अभ्यवहार m. (-रः) Eating. E. अभि and अव before हृ to convey, घञ् aff.

अभ्यवहत् mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Eaten. E. अभि and अव before हृ to convey, and the part. affix क्त.

अभ्यसन n. (-नं) Frequent repetition, use, exercise, especially of the memory, learning by rote. E. अभि frequently, अस to throw or send, ल्युट् aff.

अभ्यस्य mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Angry, vexed. f. (-या) Detraction. Also असूया. E. अभि before असूया envy.

अभ्यस्यक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Detracting, a detractor, a calumniator. E. अभि before असूय to envy or detract, वृन् aff.

अभ्यस्य mfn. (-स्यः-स्या-स्य) To be studied. Also अभ्यसनीय. E. अभि before अस to throw, affix य or अनीयर्.

अभ्यस्त mfn. (-स्तः-स्ता-स्तं) 1. Exercised, practiced. 2. Learnt by heart. 3. Repeated as the radical syllable of a verb. E. अभि frequently, अस to throw or send, क्त aff.

अभ्याकाङ्क्षित n. (-तं) A groundless complaint, a false accusation. E. अभि and आकाङ्क्षित desired.

अभ्याख्यान n. (-नं) A false accusation. E. अभि, and आख्यान saying.

अभ्यागत m. (-तः) A guest, a visitor. mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Arrived. E. अभि, and आगत come.

अभ्यागम m. (-मः) 1. War, battle. 2. Striking, killing. 3. Enmity. 4. Vicinity. 5. Rising, getting up. 6. Coming, arrival, visit. E. अभि near, or before, &c. गम to go, with आ prefixed, and अच् affixed.

अभ्यागमन n. (-नं) Arrival, visitation. E. अभि, and आगमन coming.

अभ्यागारिक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Diligent in supporting a family. E. अभि before आगार a house, ठक् aff.

अभ्याघात m. (-तः) Assault, attack. E. अभि, and आघात assailing.

अभ्यादान n. (-नं) 1. Beginning, commencement. 2. First beginning. E. अभि, and आदान taking.

अभ्यान्त mfn. (-न्तः-न्ता-न्तं) Sick, diseased. E. अभि and आङ् before अन्त to be sick, and the affix क्त.

अभ्यापात m. (-तः) Calamity, misfortune. E. अभि and आङ् before पत to go, घञ् aff.

अभ्यामर्ह m. (-र्हः) War, battle. E. अभि and आ before मर्ह to tread down, अच् aff.

अभ्याश mfn. (-शः-शा-शं) Near, proximate. m. (-शः) Constant repetition. See अभ्यास.

अभ्यास m. (-सः) 1. Practice, exercise. 2. Learning by rote. 3. Practicing archery. 4. (In arithmetic,) Multiplication. 5. (In grammar,) The reduplicate syllable of a verb. mfn. (-सः-सा-सं) Near, proximate. E. अभि before अस to go, &c. घञ् aff.

अभ्यासता f. (-ता) Constant practice, use, habit. E. अभ्यास and तल् affix, also with त्व, अभ्यासत्.

अभ्यासयोग m. (-यः) The practice of frequent and repeated contemplation on any deity or abstract spirit, repeated recollection, &c. E. अभ्यास, and योग religious exercise.

अभ्यासादन n. (-नं) 1. Striking so as to disable an enemy. 2. Facing an enemy. E. अभि and आङ् before सद to go, in the causal form, and ल्युट् aff.

अभ्यासिन् mfn. (-सी-सिनी-सि) Practicing, exercising, repeating. E. अभ्यास and इनि aff.

अभ्याहार m. (-रः) 1. Robbery. See अभिहार. 2. Eating. E. अभि and आङ् before हृ to take, घञ् aff.

अभ्याहार्य m. (-र्यः) An eatable. mfn. (-र्यः-र्या-र्यं) Eatable, to be eaten. E. अभि and आहार्य to be eaten.

अभ्युक्षण n. (-णं) Sprinkling, wetting. E. अभि, and उक्ष to moisten, ल्युट् aff.

अभ्युक्ष्य ind. Having sprinkled. E. अभि, and उक्ष to moisten, ल्यप् aff.

अभ्युत्थान n. (-नं) 1. Fame, reputation. 2. Rising from off a seat, &c. 3. Rise. 4. Elevation. 5. Sun-rise. E. अभि and उत् before स्था to stay, ल्युट् aff.

अभ्युत्थित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Risen, arisen. 2. Elevated, exalted. E. अभि and उत्थित lifted up.

अभ्युदय m. (-यः) 1. Prosperity, increase. 2. Accident, occurrence. 3. A festival, any religious celebration. E. अभि, and उदय rise, prosperity.

अभ्युदाहरण n. (-णं) An example or illustration of a thing by its reverse. E. अभि, and उदाहरण example.

अभ्युदित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Asleep at sun-rise. 2. Celebrated as a festival. 3. Risen, (as the sun.) 4. Elevated, exalted. 5. Arisen, happened. E. अभि, उत् up, and इत् gone; part. past, of इष्ण to go.

अभ्युद्दिरित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Thrown over or upon. E. अभि and उत् before इरित gone.

अभ्युद्यत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Brought or given unsolicited. E. अभि towards, उद्यत exerted.

अभ्युद्धृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Taken up, delivered. E. अभि, and उद्धृत taken.

अभ्युपगत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Promised, agreed, assented. 2. Gone near to, approached, arrived at. 3. Inferred, probable. 4. Similar, analogous. E. अभि, उप over, गत gone.

अभ्युपगम m. (-मः) 1. A promise, an agreement, a contract. 2. Approaching, going near to. 3. Probable ascertainment. 4. Analogy, affinity. E. अभि, and उप implying association or vicinity, and गम going.

अभ्युपगमित m. (-तः) A slave for a fixed term. mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Obtained by assent or free will. E. अभ्युपगम and इत्च् aff.

अभ्युपपत्ति f. (-त्तिः) 1. Favour, affection. 2. Defence, protection. 3. Agreement, assent. 4. Impregnation of a woman, as of a brother's widow, as an act of duty. E. अभि and उप before पत् to go, affix क्तिन्.

अभ्युपपन्न mfn. (-न्नः-न्ना-न्नं) Agreeing to. E. अभि and उप before पद् to go, affix क्त.

अभ्युपाय m. (-यः) 1. An agreement, a promise, an engagement. 2. A means, an expedient. E. अभि and उप before इष्ण to go, अच् aff.

अभ्युपायन n. (-नं) A bribe, an inducement. E. अभि and उप before इष्ण to go, causal form, ल्युट् aff.

अभ्युपेत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Contracted, promised, agreed. 2. Approached. E. अभि and उप before इष्ण to go, क्त aff.

अभ्युपेत्ययुष्ठा f. (-ष्ठा) A head or title of law, disputes between master and servant. E. अभ्युपेत्य having engaged, अ neg. युष्ठा service.

अभ्युष m. (-षः) 1. Grain, &c. half dressed, slightly scorched, or parched so as to be eaten from the hand. 2. Bread. E. अभि before, उष्ण to burn, क् affix; the vowel may be made also long, which gives अभ्युष, or may be changed to औ, and form अभ्युष; some consider the root to be उष्ण, to be sick.

अभ्युषित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Dwelling with. E. अभि before वस to dwell, क्त aff.
