

असुखपुत्र mf. (-त्रः-त्री) 1. Of a good family, of known origin. 2. The son or daughter of such a one. E. असुख the irr. gen. of अदस् this, and पुत्र a son, &c.

असुखायण mf. (-णः-या) 1. Of respectable birth, of known origin. 2. The offspring of such a one, of a certain person, &c. E. असुख as in the last, and फक् affix, also आसुखायण.

असूडम् mfn. (-डम्) Of such form or kind. E. असू for अदस् this, and क्तिप् affix; also असूडश्च and असूडश्च

असूडश्च mfn. (-श्चः-शा-श्च) Of such a form or kind. E. See the last.

असूडश्च mfn. (-श्चः-चा-श्च) Such, like, of such form or kind. E. See असूडश्च.

असूर्त्त mfn. (-र्त्तः-र्त्ता-र्त्त) Formless, shapeless, unembodied. E. अ neg. सूर्त्त form; the final changed.

असूर्त्ति f. (-र्त्तिः) Shapelessness, absence of shape or form. E. अ neg. सूर्त्त form.

असूल mfn. (-लः-ला-ल) Having no root. Also असूलक. f. (-ला) A plant. See अशिशिला. E. अ neg. and मूल a root.

असूल्य mfn. (-ल्यः-ल्या-ल्य) Invaluable, not to be purchased. E. अ neg. मूल्य price.

असृणाल n. (-ल) The root of a fragrant grass, used in India for taties or screens against the hot winds, commonly called Kaskas, (Andropogon muricatum.) E. अ like, as it were, and सृणाल a fibrous root; also सृणाल.

अमृत n. (-त) 1. The food of the gods, Ambrosia or Nectar. 2. Water. 3. Butter, rice, &c. the residue of a sacrifice. 4. Oiled butter or ghee. 5. Unsolicited alms. 6. Boiled rice. 7. Food. 8. Wealth, property. 9. Gold. 10. Buttermilk. 11. Any thing sweet, a sweetmeat. 12. Milk. 13. Poison. 14. A drug or medicament. 15. Quick-silver. 16. Final emancipation. m. (-तः) 1. A god, an immortal. 2. DHANWANTARI, the physician of the gods. f. (-ता) 1. Emblem myrobalan, (Phyllanthus emblica.) 2. The yellow sort., (Terminalia citrina.) 3. Another plant, (Menispermum glabrum.) 4. Long pepper. 5. Holy basil, (Ocimum sanctum.) 6. Spirituous liquor. It also occurs amongst the synonymes of several plants besides those enumerated. mfn. (-तः-ता-त) 1. Beloved, desired. 2. Beautiful. 3. Immortal, imperishable. E. अ neg. मृड् to die, and क्त affix; what is immortal or what makes so; what supports life, &c.

अमृतकुण्ड m. (-ण्डः) A vessel of nectar. E. अमृत and कुण्ड a hole.

अमृतता f. (-ता) Immortality. E. अमृत and तल् affix; also with ल्, अमृतल.

अमृततरङ्गिणी f. (-णी) Moonlight. E. अमृत, and तरङ्गिणी a sea.

अमृतदीपिति m. (-तिः) The moon. E. अमृत ambrosia, and दीपिति a ray.

अमृतद्रव mfn. (-वः-वा-व) Shedding ambrosia. E. अमृत, and द्रव dropping.

अमृतधार mfn. (-रः-रा-र) Shedding or distilling ambrosia. E. अमृत, and धारा a drop.

अमृतप mfn. (-पः-पा-प) Drinking ambrosia. m. (-पः) A deity. E. अमृत, and प who drinks.

अमृतरस m. (-सः) Nectar, ambrosia. E. अमृत, and रस juice.

अमृतवर्ष m. (-र्षः) A fall of ambrosia from heaven. E. अमृत, and वर्ष rain.

अमृतवल्ली f. (-ल्ली) A species moonseed, (Menispermum glabrum.) See गुडूची. E. अमृत, and वल्ली a pedicle; the plant flourishing for a long time.

अमृतसारज m. (-जः) Raw sugar, molasses. E. अमृत ambrosia, सार essence, and ज produced.

अमृतसू m. (-सूः) The Moon, as the producer of ambrosia. f. (-सूः) A Ma'tri or a divine mother. E. अमृत the ambrosia, and सू who brings forth; from सूड् to bear, and क्तिप् aff.

अमृतसूत् mfn. (-सूत्) Shedding ambrosia. E. अमृत, सू to distil, क्तिप् aff.

अमृतसौदर m. (-रः) A horse. E. अमृत, and सौदर brother: born with nectar at the churning of the ocean.

अमृताम्बु म. (-म्बाः) A deity. E. अमृत, and अम्बु food; whose food is ambrosia.

अमृताफल m. (-लः) The fruit of the Trichosanthes, E. अमृता, and फल fruit.

अमृताशन m. (-नः) A deity. E. As before, अशन eating.

अमृतासङ्ग m. (-ङ्गः) A collyrium, extracted from the Amomum anthoriza. See कर्परी.

अमृताहरण m. (-णः) A name of GARUDA, the bird of VISHNU. E. अमृत, ह to convey, with आङ् prefixed, and ल्युट् affix; GARUDA having upon one occasion stolen the Amrita.

अमृतोत्पन्ना f. (-न्ना) A fly. E. अमृत, and उत्पन्न born.

अमृतोद्भव m. (-वः) A kind of collyrium. See अमृतासङ्ग. E. अमृत, and उद्भव born.

अमृति f. (-तिः) A drinking vessel.

अमृत्यु f. (-त्युः) Immortality. E. अ neg. मृत्यु death.

अमेघ mfn. (-घः-वा-घ) Cloudless. E. अ neg. मेघ a cloud.

अमेघस् m. (-घाः) A food, an idiot. E. अ neg. मेघ to understand, and अण् aff.

अमेध्य mfn. (-ध्यः-ध्या-ध्य) Impure, foul. n. (-ध्य) Faeces, excrement. E. अ neg. and मेध्य pure.

अमेध्यल n. (-ल) Foulness, filthiness. E. ल added to अमेध्य, also with तल्, अमेध्यता.

अमेध्ययुक्त mfn. (-क्तः-क्ता-क्त) Filthy, foul. E. अमेध्य, and युक्त joined.

अमेध्यलित mfn. (-लितः-लित-लित) Smear'd with ordure, foul, defiled. E. अमेध्य, and लित smear'd.

अमेध्यलेप m. (-पः) Mearing with ordure. E. अमेध्य, and लेप plastering.

अमेध्याक्त mfn. (-क्तः-क्ता-क्त) Soiled by ordure. E. अमेध्य, and अक्त smear'd.

अमेय mfn. (-यः-या-य) Inmense, immeasurable. E. अ neg. मेय to be measured.

अमेयात्मन् mfn. (-त्मा-त्मा-त्मा) Magnanimous, possessing extraordinary powers of mind. E. अमेय, and आत्मन् self.

अमोच m. (-चः) 1. Bondage, confinement. 2. Confinement to life. mfn. (-चः-चा-च) Unliberated, unloosed. E. अ neg. मोच liberation.

अमोच mfn. (-चः-चा-च) Productive, fruitful, not vain or barren. m. (-चः) The name of a river. f. (-चा) 1. Trumpet flower, (Bignonia suaveolens.) 2. A plant of which the seed is used as a vermifuge, (Erycibe paniculata, Rox.) See विडङ्ग. 3. Yellow myrobalan. See हरीतकी. E. अ not, मोच vain, barren.

अमोचन n. (-न) Non-liberation, not loosing or letting go. E. अ neg. मोचन loosing.

अमोचित mfn. (-तः-ता-त) Confined, not liberated. E. अ neg. मोचित loosed.

अम्ब r. 1st cl. (अम्बति) To move, to go.

अम्बक n. (-क) 1. The eye. 2. Copper. E. अम्ब to go, and बुन् aff.

अम्बर n. (-र) 1. The sky or atmosphere. 2. Clothes, apparel. 3. A perfume, (Ambergris.) 4. Cotton. 5. Talc. E. अम्ब to go, and अरन् aff.

अम्बरयुग n. (-युग) The two principal female garments, or upper and lower cloths or mantles. E. अम्बर, and युग a pair.

अम्बरान्त m. (-न्तः) 1. The horizon. 2. The end of a garment. E. अम्बर and अन्त end.

अम्बरिष mn. (-षः-ष) A frying pan. See the next.

अम्बरीष mn. (-षः-ष) 1. A frying pan. 2. War, battle. m. (-षः) 1. A name of SIVA. 2. Also of VISHNU. 3. A young animal, a colt, a boy. 4. The name of a king of the solar race, celebrated as a worshipper of VISHNU. 5. A division of hell. 6. The sun. 7. Repentance. 8. A tree, (Spondias mangifera.) E. अम्बि to sound, and ईषन् Una'di affix, but irregularly formed.

अम्बुष्ट m. (-ष्टः) 1. The name of a country, stated to be in the eastern division of India, and supposed by Mr. WILFORD, to be the abode of the AMBASTÆ of Arrian. 2. The offspring of a man of the Brahman, and a woman of the Vaisya tribe, a man of the medical cast. f. (-ष्टा) 1. A sort of jasmín, (Jasminum auriculatum.) 2. A plant, (Cissampelos hexandra.) See वनतिक्त्तिका. 3. Woodsorrel, (Oxalis corniculata, Rox.) E. अम्बा a mother, ष्टा to stand, and क्त affix, what cherishes like a mother.
