

अर्च 1st cl. (अर्चति) Also 1st and 10th cls. (अर्चयति अर्चयति) To worship, to honour or treat with respect; with सम् prefixed, to worship. This root and its derivatives are also read अर्च, &c. doubling the consonant after र.

अर्चक mfn. (-कः का-कं) A worshipper, one who worships. E. अर्च and क् aff.

अर्चन mfn. (-नः ना-नं) An article of worship. nf. (-न-ना) Worship, the homage paid to deities and to superiors. E. अर्च to worship, युच् affix, and टाप् fem. do.

अर्चनीय mfn. (-यः या-यं) Venerable, respectable. E. अर्च, and णीयर् affix, also अर्च and अर्चयितव्य.

अर्चा f. (-चां) 1. Worship, see अर्चन. 2. An image. E. अर्च to worship, अच् affix, and टाप् fem. do.

अर्चि f. (-र्चिः) Flame. E. अर्च to worship, इन् aff.

अर्चित mfn. (-तः ता-तं) Worshipped, respected, saluted. E. अर्च in the part. past.

अर्चिमत् mfn. (-मान्-मती-मत) Brilliant, resplendent. m. (-मान्) 1. Fire. 2. The sun. E. अर्चिस् flame, and मतप् poss. aff.

अर्चिस् m. (-र्चिः) 1. Flame. 2. A ray of light. 3. Light, luster. E. अर्च to worship, and इति Una di aff.

अर्च्य mfn. (-र्च्यः र्चा-र्च्यं) Reverend, respectable, worshipful. E. अर्च to worship, and यत् aff.

अर्ज्ज् r. 1st cl. (अर्जति) To earn, to gain or acquire, (commonly used with उप prefixed.) 10th cl. (अर्जयति) 1. The same, and; 2. To work or manufacture. 3. To make or prepare. This root and its derivatives are also read अर्ज, &c. doubling the consonant after र.

अर्जक mfn. (-कः का-कं) An acquirer, one who gains or acquires. m. (-कः) Basil, the white sort, (Ocymum villosum.) E. अर्ज to gain, and वुन् aff.

अर्जन n. (-नं) Gain, acquisition of wealth, &c. E. अर्ज, and ल्युट् affix, also written अर्जन.

अर्जित mfn. (-तः ता-तं) Gained, acquired. E. अर्ज to gain, क्त affix, also written अर्जित.

अर्जुन m. (-नः) 1. The third of the Paṇḍavas, the son of INDRA and friend of KRISHNA. 2. The name of a king with a thousand arms. See कर्तवीर्य. 3. A tree, (Pentaptera arjuna.) 4. A peacock. 5. The only son of his mother. 6. White, (the colour.) nf. (-न-नी) 1. Grass. 2. Slight inflammation of the conjunctiva or white of the eye. f. (-नी) 1. A cow. 2. USHĀ, the wife of ANIRUDDHĀ. 3. The Karatoya river in the north of Bengal. 4. A procuress, a bawd. mfn. (-नः नी-नं) White. E. अर्ज to gain, लुन् Una di affix, fem. लीप्, also read अर्जुन.

अर्जुनक mfn. (-कः का-कं) Belonging to ARJUNA. E. अर्जुन and वुन् aff.

अर्जुनतस् ind. On the side or party of ARJUNA. E. अर्जुन and तसि aff.

अर्जुनच्छवि mfn. (-विः वि-वि) White, of a white colour. E. अर्जुन white, and ह्वि light.

अर्जुनध्वज m. (-जः) The monkey HANUMAN. E. अर्जुन, and ध्वज a banner, being ARJUNA'S symbol.

अर्जुनीपम m. (-मः) The teak tree, (Tectona grandis.) E. अर्जुन a tree, &c. उपम like.

अर्च m. (-र्चः) 1. The teak tree. 2. A letter.

अर्चव m. (-वः) The ocean. E. अर्चस् water, व affix, and स is dropped: the व in this and similar words is optionally doubled, as अर्चव, &c.

अर्चवज mfn. (-जः जा-जं) Sea-born, marine. mn. (-जः-जं) Cuttle fish. E. अर्चव, and ज born.

अर्चवमन्दिर m. (-रः) VARUNA, regent of the water. E. अर्चव the ocean, and मन्दिर a house; whose dwelling is the deep.

अर्चवीत m. (-तः) A boat or ship. E. अर्चव, and वीत a boat.

अर्चवयान n. (-यं) A boat or ship. E. अर्चव, and यान vehicle.

अर्चस् n. (-र्चः) Water. E. ऋ to go, असुन् Una di affix, and नट् inserted.

अर्चिद m. (-दः) A cloud. E. अर्चस्, and द what gives.

अर्चमिव m. (-वः) A shell. E. अर्चस्, and मिव being.

अर्चमल m. (-लः) Blue barleria, (B. caerulea.) E. अर्च exhausted, and मल to drop, the च् is made short, also अर्चमल.

अर्चन n. (-नं) Censure, reproach, abuse. E. ऋति to blame, a sautra root and ल्युट् aff.

अर्चि f. (-र्चिः) 1. Pain. 2. The end of a bow. E. अर्च to hurt, and क्तिन् aff.

अर्चिक mfn. (-कः का-कं) Diseased, pained. m. (-कः) A kind of cake. E. अर्चि pain, and क्त् added.

अर्चिका f. (-का) An elder sister, (in theatrical language.) See अर्चिका.

अर्थ r. 10th cl. (अर्थयते sometimes -ति) To ask or beg.

अर्थ mfn. (-र्थः र्था-र्थं) 1. Rich. 2. Learned. m. (-र्थः) 1. Wealth, property, substance. 2. Meaning, signification. 3. Thing. 4. fruit, consequence. 5. Prohibition. 6. A material substance or object of sense. 7. Cause, origin. 8. Request, asking, begging. 9. Kind, sort, manner. 10. Well, well being. 11. (In law) A suit, an action. E. ऋ to go, and यन् Una di aff.

अर्थकर mfn. (-रः रा-री-रं) Producing yielding wealth, what enriches. E. अर्थ, and कर what makes, also similar compounds, as अर्थकारक mfn. (-कः का-कं) अर्थकारिन् mfn. (-री र्शी-रि) and अर्थजनक mfn. (-कः का-कं) &c.

अर्थकाम m. (-मः) Avarice, desire of wealth. E. अर्थ, and काम desire.

अर्थगरीयस् mfn. (-यान्-यसी-यः) Significant, meaning. E. अर्थ with गृह heavy, ईयसुन् superlative aff.

अर्थघ्न mfn. (-घ्नः-घ्नी-घ्नं) Wasteful, extravagant. E. अर्थ, and घ्न who or what destroys.

अर्थज्ञ mfn. (-ज्ञः-ज्ञा-ज्ञं) Wise, discriminating, understanding the various significations of a word, &c. E. अर्थ meaning, and ज्ञ who knows.

अर्थतस् ind. According to the sense. E. तसि added to अर्थ.

अर्थतत्त्व n. (-त्त्वः) Truth, the real object, nature or cause of any thing. E. अर्थ, and तत्त्व truth.

अर्थद mfn. (-दः दा-दं) 1. Liberal, munificent. 2. Compliant, favourable. E. अर्थ wealth or object, and द who or what gives. Also similar compounds, as अर्थदायक, अर्थदायिन् and अर्थदाट, &c.

अर्थदूषण n. (-णं) Waste, prodigality, extravagance. E. अर्थ, and दूषण spoiling.

अर्थना f. (-ना) Begging, asking. E. अर्थ to ask, and युच् aff.

अर्थपति m. (-तिः) 1. KUVĒRA, the Hindu PLUTUS. 2. A king. E. अर्थ wealth, and पति lord.

अर्थपर mfn. (-रः रा-रं) 1. Intent on gaining wealth. 2. Parsimonious, niggardly. E. अर्थ, and पर intent.

अर्थप्रयोग m. (-गः) 1. Application of wealth as to trade, usury, &c. 2. The profession of usury. E. अर्थ, and प्रयोग application.

अर्थप्राप्ति f. (-प्तिः) 1. Acquisition of wealth. 2. Attainment of an object. E. अर्थ, and प्राप्ति gaining.

अर्थभृत mfn. (-तः ता-तं) A servant who has high wages. E. अर्थ, and भृत maintained.

अर्थभेद m. (-दः) Distinction, difference of meaning. E. अर्थ meaning, and भेद dividing.

अर्थलाभ m. (-भः) Acquisition of wealth. E. अर्थ, and लाभ acquiring.

अर्थलुब्ध mfn. (-ब्धः-ब्धा-ब्धं) Greedy of wealth, covetous, niggardly. E. अर्थ, and लुब्ध desirous.

अर्थलेश m. (-शः) A little wealth. E. अर्थ, and लेश a little.

अर्थलौभ m. (-भः) Avarice, desire of wealth. E. अर्थ, and लौभ desire.

अर्थवत् mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) 1. Wealthy, rich. 2. Significant, having sense or meaning. 3. Designed, intentional, having an object. E. अर्थ, and मतप् poss. aff.

अर्थवाद m. (-दः) 1. Praise, eulogium. 2. Declaration of purpose or object, speech or expression having a certain object, as स्तुत्यर्थवादः speech implying praise, निन्दार्थवादः speech implying censure. 3. Amplification. E. अर्थ substance, thing, and वाद speaking.
