

अल्पप्रमाण mfn. (-णः-णा-णं) 1. Of little authority. 2. Of little weight or measure. E. अल्प, and प्रमाण authority, &c.

अल्पप्रमाणक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) 1. Credulous, resting on little evidence. 2. Of little weight or authority. 3. Of short measure. m. (-कः) Common cucumber, (Cucumis sativus.) E. अल्प, and प्रमाण authority, &c. कन् added.

अल्पबल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Feeble, of little strength. E. अल्प, and बल strength.

अल्पबाध mfn. (-धः-धा-धं) Causing little annoyance or inconvenience. E. अल्प, and बाधा pain.

अल्पबुद्धि mfn. (-द्धिः-द्धिः-द्धि) Ignorant, silly, unwise. E. अल्प, बुद्धि understanding.

अल्पमात्र n. (-त्रं) 1. A little, a little only. 2. A short time, a few moments. E. अल्प, and मात्र only.

अल्पमारिष m. (-षः) A kind of amaranth, (Amaranthus polygamus.) E. अल्प, मृष to hurt, and इमच् aff.

अल्पसूक्ति mfn. (-क्तिः-क्तिः-क्ति) Small, diminutive, f. (-क्तिः) A small figure or object. E. अल्प, and सूक्ति form.

अल्पमेधस् mfn. (-धः-धा-धं) Ignorant, silly, of little understanding. E. अल्प, and मेधस् apprehension.

अल्पवयस् mfn. (-याः-या-यः) Young, of few years. E. अल्प, and वयस् life.

अल्पवादिन् mfn. (-दी-दिनी-दि) Taciturn : also अल्पभाषिन्. E. अल्प, and वादिन् or भाषिन् who speaks.

अल्पविषय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Meaning or directing a little. E. अल्प, and विषय object.

अल्पविद्य mfn. (-द्यः-द्या-द्यं) Ill taught, uneducated, ignorant. E. अल्प, and विद्या knowledge.

अल्पशक्ति mfn. (-क्तिः-क्तिः-क्ति) Weak, feeble. E. अल्प, and शक्ति power.

अल्पशस् ind. 1. A little. 2. To a few. E. अल्प and शस् aff.

अल्पसरस् n. (-रः) A basin, a small pond, one which is shallow or dry in the hot season. E. अल्प, and सरस् a pool.

अल्पाकाङ्क्षिन् mfn. (-ङ्क्षी-ङ्क्षी-ङ्क्षि) Contented, satisfied with little. E. अल्प, and आकाङ्क्षिन् who desires.

अल्पायुस् mfn. (-युः-युः-युः) 1. Short lived. 2. Young of few years. m. (-युः) A goat. E. अल्प, and आयुस् life.

अल्पाल्प mfn. (-ल्पः-ल्पा-ल्पं) 1. Very little, minute. 2. Gradual, little at a time. E. अल्प repeated.

अल्पाहार mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Moderate, abstemious. m. (-रः) Moderation, abstinence. E. अल्प, and आहार food.

अल्पाहारिन् mfn. (-री-रिणी-रि) Abstemious, moderate. E. अल्प, and आहारिन् who feeds.

अल्पिष्ठ mfn. (-ष्ठः-ष्ठा-ष्ठं) Least, smallest, very small. E. अल्प, and इष्ठच् of the superlative.

अल्पीकृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Reduced, comminuted, made little or few. E. अल्प and कृत with चि inserted.

अल्पीभूत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Reduced, diminished, become little or few. E. अल्प, and भूत become, चि inserted.

अल्पीयस् mfn. (-यान्-यसी-यः) Very small. E. अल्प and ईयसुन् affix. Also अल्पिष्ठ.

अल्पीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Defective, not quite finished, not wholly entire. E. अल्प a little, ऊन less.

अम्ना f. (-म्ना) A mother, in dramatic language.

अव r. 1st cl. (अवति) 1. To keep, protect or defend. 2. To please. (The following meanings, although found in lists of roots, are rarely used.) 3. To move. 4. To excite affection or be lovely. 5. अवकर m. (-रः) Dust or sweepings. E. अव spreading, and कर what makes.

अवकर्तन n. (-नं) Excision, cutting off. E. अव and कर्तन cutting.

अवकर्षण n. (-णं) 1. Taking or pulling out, extraction, expulsion. 2. Pulling, dragging. E. अव, and कर्षण pulling.

अवकलित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Seen. E. अव and कलित part. past of कल to sound, &c.

अवकाश m. (-शः) 1. Leisure, opportunity. 2. Interval, space. 3. An open or wide space. 4. A receptacle, a repository, a place in which any thing is kept. 5. A place, a spot, a situation. E. अव between, &c. काश to shine, अच् aff.

अवकीर्ण mfn. (-र्णः-र्णा-र्णं) 1. Coarsely pounded. 2. Scattered. 3. Disregarded, violated. E. अव implying separation, कृ to scatter in the irregular part. past.

अवकीर्णिन् mfn. (-र्णी-र्णिनी-र्णि) Violating a vow or engagement to be chaste, abstemious, &c. m. (-र्णी) The religious student who has committed an act of incontinency. E. अव before, कृ to scatter, क्त the part. past, and इनि aff.

अवकीर्णव्रत n. (-तं) Penance for an act of incontinency. E. अवकीर्ण and व्रत religious obligation.

अवकुञ्चन n. (-नं) Bending, curving, flexure, contraction. E. अव and कुञ्चन curving.

अवकुटार mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) 1. Opposite, contrary. 2. Backwards. 3. Downwards. n. (-रं) Reverse, contrariety. E. अव and कुटार aff.

अवकुट्टित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Vexed. 2. Inflamed. 3. Cut off. E. अव, and कुट्ट to heat, &c. क्त aff.

अवकुलहन n. (-नं) 1. Investing, surrounding. 2. Attracting. E. अव before कुल to surround, ल्युट् aff.

अवकुलित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Affected. 2. Surrounded, attracted. E. अव before कुल to surround, क्त aff.

अवकुल्ट mfn. (-टः-टा-टं) 1. Expelled, turned out. 2. Removed, sent away, drawn aside. 3. Extracted. 4. Pulled. 5. Inferior, low. 6. Degraded, outcaste. m. (-टः) A servant who performs the lowest office, a sweeper, a waterman, &c. E. अव out of, and कुल्ट drawn.

अवकुल्य ind. 1. Having drawn out or extracted. 2. Having drawn together or contracted. E. अव, and कुल्य to draw, यत् aff.

अवकेशिन् mfn. (-शी-शिनो-शि) Barren. E. अव privative, केश properly hair, in this instance fruit, and इनि aff.

अवक्तव्य mfn. (-व्यः-व्या-व्यं) 1. Not to be said, improper. 2. Indescribable. E. अव neg. वक्तव्य to be said.

अवक्र mfn. (-क्रः-क्रा-क्रं) 1. Straight. 2. Upright, honest. E. अव neg. वक्र crooked liter. and metaph.

अवक्रन्दन n. (-नं) Weeping aloud. E. अव, and क्रन्दन crying.

अवक्रय m. (-यः) Price. E. अव, and क्री to buy, अच् aff.

अवक्रान्ति f. (-न्तिः) 1. Descent, descending. 2. Approaching, going near to. E. अव, and क्रान्ति passing.

अवक्रिया f. (-या) Neglect, omission, non-performance of prescribed acts. E. अव priv. क्रिया act.
