

अश्रवण n. (-र्षः) Deafness, loss of hearing. E. अ neg. श्रवण hearing.
 अश्रम m. (-मः) 1. Freshness, freedom from fatigue. 2. Laziness, want of exertion. E. अ neg. श्रम fatigue.
 अश्राद्ध mfn. (-द्वाः-द्वा-द्वा) 1. Not performing exequal rites, not entitled to them, not belonging or relating to them. m. (-द्वाः) Non-performance of exequal rites. E. अ neg. श्राद्ध funeral ceremony.
 अश्रान्त adv. n. (-न्तः) adj. mfn. (न्तः-न्ता-न्तः) 1. Eternal, continual. 2. Unwearied. E. अ neg. and श्रान्त wearied, part. past of श्रम.
 अश्रि f. (-श्रिः) 1. The edge of a sword. 2. A corner, the angle of a room or house. E. श्रिञ् to serve, आङ् prefixed, आ becomes अ; also अश्री and आश्रि.
 अश्रीक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Unlucky, unpropitious. E. अ neg. श्री fortune, and कन् aff.
 अश्रीमत् mfn. (-मान्-मती-मत्) Inglorious, unfortunate. E. अ neg. श्रीमत् fortunate.
 अश्रील mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Unlucky, unprosperous. E. अ neg. श्री prosperity, ला to have, affix क.
 अश्रु n. (-श्रु) A tear. E. अ neg. श्रि to serve, डुन् Una'di affix; it is also written अश्रु.
 अश्रुत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Unheard. 2. Not directed by or contrary to the Vedas. E. अ neg. and श्रुत heard, &c.
 अश्रुनाली f. (-ली) Fistula lachrymalis. E. अश्रु and नाली a channel.
 अश्रुपात m. (-तः) A flow of tears. E. अश्रु, and पात fall.
 अश्रेयस् mfn. (-यान्-यसी-यः) 1. Worthless, useless, unprofitable, bad. 2. Inferior, worse. E. अ neg. श्रेयस् excellent.
 अश्रेष्ठ mfn. (-ष्ठः-ष्ठा-ष्ठं) 1. Inferior, worse. 2. Bad, vile. E. अ neg. श्रेष्ठ best!
 अश्रीचिय m. (-यः) A Brahman who has not read the Vedas. E. अ neg. श्रीचिय a learned Brahman.
 अश्लाघ्य mfn. (-घ्यः-घ्या-घ्यं) Worthless, undeserving of honour or praise. E. अ neg. श्लाघ्य to be praised.
 अश्लाघनीय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Undeserving of honour or praise, base, mean, worthless. E. अ neg. श्लाघनीय to be praised.
 अश्लोक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Unlucky, unpropitious. E. As अश्रीक, the र being changed to ल.
 अश्लील mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) 1. Coarse, vulgar. 2. Abusive, blackguard. n. (-लं) 1. Rustic language. 2. Untruth. 3. Low abuse. E. अ neg. श्लील elegant.
 अश्लेषा f. (-षा) 1. The ninth Nakshatra or lunar mansion, containing five stars. 2. Disunion, disjunction. E. अ neg. and श्लेष union.
 अश्लेषाभव m. (-वः) A mane of KE'RU or the dragon's head : see केतु. E. अश्लेषा the asterism, and भव born, born under the sign Aslesha'; or अश्लेषा disjunction, and भव produced; as KE'RU was formed of the lower extremities which had been sundered by VISHNU' from RA'HU.
 अश्लेषाम् m. (-म्) A name of KE'RU. E. As the preceding, भू to be born, with क्तिप् aff.
 अश्व m. (-श्वः) 1. A horse. 2. A set or cast of men horse-like in strength. du. (-श्वौ) A horse and a mare. f. (-श्वी) A mare. E. अश्व to pervade, क्तन् Una'di affix, and टाप् fem. aff.
 अश्वक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Horse-like, acting like a horse, &c. m. (-कः) 1. A bad horse, a hack. 2. A stray horse, one whose owner is not known. 3. Any horse. E. अश्व and कन् added in different senses.
 अश्वकन्दिका f. (-का) A plant, (Physalis floxiosa.)
 अश्वकर्ष m. (-र्षः) A timber tree, commonly Sakwa or Sal (Shorea robusta.) E. अश्व a horse, and कर्ष an ear, the leaves being compared to the ears of a horse.
 अश्वकर्षक m. (-कः) The Sal-tree, (Shorea robusta.) E. कन् added to अश्वकर्ष.
 अश्वकिनी f. (-नी) The first Nakshatra or lunar mansion. E. अश्वक a horse, इनि and डीप् affixes : see अश्विनी.

अश्वखुर m. (-रः) 1. A horse's hoof. 2. A perfume, apparently a dried shell-fish : see नखी. f. (-रा-री) A plant, (Clitoria ternatea.) E. अश्व and खुर his hoof; which the perfume and leaves of the plant are supposed to resemble.
 अश्वगन्धा f. (-न्धा) A plant, (Physalis flexuosa.) E. अश्व, and गन्ध smell; having the smell of a horse.
 अश्वगीयुग n. (-गं) A pair of horses. E. अश्व and गीयुग affix implying a pair, a brace, &c.
 अश्वगोष्ठ n. (-ष्ठः) A stable. E. अश्व, and गोष्ठ abode, place.
 अश्वग्रीव m. (-वः) The name of a demon, more commonly named Haya-griva. E. अश्व and ग्रीवा a neck; horse-necked.
 अश्वघ्न m. (-घ्नः) Oleander, (Nerium odorum.) E. अश्व and घ्न what kills or hurts, from हन; horse-destroying.
 अश्वचिकित्सक m. (-कः) A farrier. E. अश्व and चिकित्सक who heals.
 अश्वचिकित्सा f. (-त्सा) Farriery. E. अश्व and चिकित्सा medical treatment.
 अश्वतर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Swift, speedy. mf. (-रः-री) A mule. m. (-रः) 1. One of the chiefs of the Nagas or serpent race, inhabiting the regions under the earth. 2. A Gand'harba or celestial quirister. 3. A male calf. E. अश्व and तर from तृ to pass, to go, affix अप्; or टरच् diminutive aff.
 अश्वल्य m. (-ल्यः) 1. The holy fig tree, (Ficus religiosa.) 2. The fruit of the tree. 3. The time at which it bears. f. (-ल्या) Day of fullmoon. E. अ neg. श्व a future period, and श्व from स्था to remain; of less duration than the Vata or Indian fig; there are several other etymologies.
 अश्वल्यक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) To be given, to be done, &c. when the Aswattha tree bears. n. (-कं) The petals of the Arabian jasmine. E. अश्वल्य and वुन् aff.
 अश्वल्यामन् m. (-न्) The name of a saint and warrior, the son of DRONA. E. अश्व, स्था to stand or stay, and मनिन् affix; the story is that at his birth he made a noise like a horse; also with a final vowel अश्वल्याम.
 अश्वदंष्ट्रा f. (-ष्ट्रा) A plant, (Tribulus lanuginosus.)
 अश्वन्त n. (-न्तः) 1. Death. 2. Termination, limit. 3. A fire-place. 4. A field. 5. Unlucky, inauspicious. E. अश्व vital air, अन्त end; also अश्वमन्त.
 अश्वपाल m. (-लः) A groom. E. अश्व, and पाल who takes care of.
 अश्वबाल m. (-लः) A kind of reed, (Saccharum spontaneum.) 2. Horse-hair. E. अश्व and बाल a tail.
 अश्वभा f. (-भा) Lightning.
 अश्वमहिषिका f. (-का) The natural enmity of a horse and a buffalo. E. अश्व, and महिष a buffalo, वुन् affix of enmity.
 अश्वमार m. (-रः) Oleander, (Nerium odorum.) E. अश्व and मार what kills; the plant is conceived to be deleterious to the horse.
 अश्वमारक m. (-कः) See the preceding.
 अश्वमाल m. (-लः) A kind of serpent.
 अश्वमुख m. (-खः) A Kinnara or celestial quirister. E. अश्व and मुख a face; this kind of demigod being represented with a horse's head.
 अश्वमेध m. (-धः) The actual or emblematic sacrifice of a horse. E. अश्व and मेध sacrifice; this sacrifice is one of the highest order, and performed a hundred times, entitles the sacrificer to the dominion of Swarga or paradise : it appears to have been originally typical; the horse, and other animals being simply bound during the performance of certain ceremonies; the actual sacrifice is an introduction of a later period. See As. R. Vol. viii. p. 442, COLEBROOKE on the Vedas.
 अश्वमेधिक m. (-कः) A horse fit for the sacrifice call'd Aswamedha. E. अश्वमेध as above, कन् added, and इ inserted.
 अश्वमेधीय m. (-यः) A horse fit for an Aswamedha. E. अश्वमेध and इ aff.
 अश्वयुज् f. (-युक्) The first lunar mansion : see अश्विनी. m. (-युक् or -युजः) The month Aswin, (Sept.-Oct.) See आश्वयुज. E. अश्व, युज् to join, affix क्तिप्; also with अ added in the last sense.
