

आक्षेप m. (-पः) 1. Throw, toss. 2. Abuse, reviling. 3. Censure, blame, reproach. 4. Attraction. 5. A figure in rhetoric, (irony.) E. आङ्, चिप् to throw or send, चञ् aff.

आक्षेपक m. (-कः) 1. Sickness, disease. 2. Convulsion, spasm. 3. A de-tractor, a calumniator or accuser. 4. A thrower. E. आङ् before चिप् to toss, खल् aff.

आक्षेपज्ञ n. (-ज्ञः) Spiritual ignorance. E. अ neg. क्षेपज्ञ wise, and चञ् affix, the initial optionally long.

आक्षीट m. (-टः) A tree, (see पीलु,) growing in mountains : in Hindi, the corresponding name implies the walnut : see अक्षीट and आक्षीड.

आक्षीड m. (-डः) A kind of Pilu, a tree so named, (Careya arborea :) see अक्षीड, अक्षीट and पीलु.

आक्षीद m. (-दः) A Brahman of the Rikshoda mountain. E. अक्षीद and अण् aff.

आक्षीदन n. (-नः) Hunting.

आख m. (-खः) A spade, a hoe. E. आङ्, खन् to dig, ड aff.

आखण्डल m. (-लः) A name of INDRA. E. आङ् and खण्डल to break, अलच् affix ; mountain-breaking, foe-destroying.

आखन m. (-नः) 1. A spade. 2. A digger. E. आङ्, खन् to dig, च aff.

आखनिक m. (-कः) 1. A thief. 2. A rat. 3. A hog. 4. A spade. 5. A digger, a ditcher, a miner. E. आङ्, खन् to dig, and इकन् Una'di aff.

आखनिकवक m. (-कः) 1. A spade. 2. A digger. E. आङ् before खन् to dig, इकवक aff.

आखर m. (-रः) 1. A spade. 2. A digger. E. आङ्, खन् to dig, डर aff.

आखात mn. (-तः) A natural pond : see अखात.

आखान m. (-नः) 1. A spade. 2. A digger. E. आङ्, खन् to dig. चञ् aff.

आखु m. (-खुः) 1. A rat, a mouse. 2. A hog. 3. A thief. 4. A sort of tree : see देवताड. E. आङ्, खन् to dig, and कु Una'di aff.

आखुकर्षी f. (-र्षी) The name of a plant, (Salvinia ocellata.) E. आखु a mouse, and कर्ष an ear ; the leaves are compared to the ears of a mouse.

आखुग m. (-गः) 1. A name of GANESA. 2. A name of KARTIKEYA. E. आखु a rat, and ग who goes ; GANESA is represented riding on a rat.

आखुघात m. (-तः) A Sudra or man of low caste and profession, lit. a rat-catcher. E. आखु and घात a blow.

आखुपर्णिका f. (-का) A plant : see आखुकर्षी. E. आखु and पर्ण a leaf.

आखुपर्णी f. (-र्णी) See the preceding.

आखुपाषाण m. (-णः) A kind of mineral, a loadstone. E. आखु and पाषाण a stone.

आखुभुज् m. (-भुज्) A cat. E. आखु and भुज् who eats.

आखुरथ m. (-थः) A name of GANESA. E. आखु, and रथ a carriage ; whose vehicle is a rat.

आखुविषहा f. (-हा) A kind of grass, (Andropogon serratum.) E. आखु, विष venom, and हा what destroys ; considered as a remedy for the bite of a rat.

आखुल्य m. (-ल्यः) The rising up or coming of rats, a swarm of rats. E. आखु and ल्य from उत् and ल्या with क aff.

आखिट m. (-टः) 1. Chase, hunting. 2. Terror, fright. E. आङ्, खिट to alarm, चञ् aff.

आखिटक mfn. (-कः-का-क) 1. Hunting, a hunter. 2. Frightening, frightful. n. (-कः) Hunting. E. आखिट and कन् pleonastic affix ; or आङ् with खिट and खल् aff.

आखिटशीर्षक n. (-कः) A cavern, a mine. E. आखिट terrifying, and शीर्ष the head or principal, क affix : very gloomy and terrifying.

आखिटिक mfn. (-कः-की-क) 1. Who or what hunts. 2. Terrible, frightful. m. (-कः) 1. A hound. 2. A hunter. E. आखिट chase, and ठक् aff.

आखीट m. (-टः) The walnut tree. E. See अक्षीट, &c.

आख्या f. (-ख्या) A name or appellation. E. ख्या to say, आङ् prefixed, अङ् and टाप् fem. affs.

आख्यात mfn. (-तः-ता-त) 1. Said, spoken. 2. Called, declared. 3. Made known. 4. Inflected, declined, conjugated. E. part. past of आख्या to say, to speak, &c.

आख्यान n. (-नः) 1. A tale, a legend. 2. Saying, declaring. E. आङ् before ख्या to tell, affix ल्युट्.

आख्यायक m. (-कः) A messenger, a feller, an announcer or relater. f. (-यिका) A tale, a true or probable story. E. आख्या to say, ल्युट् affix, य inserted.

आख्येय mfn. (-यः-या-य) Fit or proper to be said. E. आङ् before ख्या to say, affix यत् ; also आख्यातव्य.

आगत mfn. (-तः-ता-त) 1. Arrived, come. 2. Received, obtained. 3. Living or residing in. E. आङ् before गम् to go, क् aff.

आगत्य ind. Having arrived. E. आङ् before गम् to go, ल्यप् aff.

आगतव्य mfn. (-व्यः-व्या-व्य) What will come, what is likely to arrive. E. आङ् and गम् to go, तव्य aff.

आगतु mfn. (-तुः-ता-तु) 1. Coming, arriving. 2. Incidental, adventitious. m. (-तुः) 1. A guest. 2. A stranger, a new comer. 3. An accident, any accidental hurt or wound. E. आङ् before गम् to go, to come, तु affix ; न becomes न् ; also आगतु and आगतुक.

आगतुक mfn. (-कः-का-की-क) 1. Incidental, adventitious, (as pleasure, pain, ornament, &c.) 2. Stray. m. (-कः) 1. A stranger, a new comer. 2. A guest. E. आगतु and कन् affix, what comes and goes : what is not inseparably inherent.

आगम m. (-मः) 1. Arrival, coming, approach. 2. A Sastra or work on sacred science in general, supposed to be of divine origin. 3. A Tantra or any work inculcating the mystical worship of ŚIVA and ŚAKTI. 4. A grammatical augment, a syllable or letter inserted in any part of the radical word. 5. Record, title deed, legal title, a voucher or written testimony, &c. E. आङ् before गम् to go, to come, अच् aff.

आगमन n. (-नः) Arriving, coming. E. आङ् before गम् to go, ल्युट् aff.

आगमनिरपेक्ष mfn. (-क्षः-क्षा-क्ष) Independent of a written voucher or title. E. आगम and निरपेक्ष disregard.

आगमय ind. Having explored or discovered. E. आङ् before गम् to go, causal form, ल्युट् aff.

आगमरहित mfn. (-तः-ता-त) 1. Devoid of a written title or voucher. 2. Without a Sastra. E. आगम and रहित devoid of.

आगमसापेक्ष mfn. (-क्षः-क्षा-क्ष) With or supported by legal vouchers. E. आगम and सापेक्ष regard to.

आगमसापेक्षिन् mfn. (-यि-यिनी-यि) Transient, of short duration. E. आगम and अपेक्षिन् separating, going at the time of arrival.

आगमित mfn. (-तः-ता-त) Read over, perused, studied. E. आङ् prefixed to गम् in the causal form ; participial affix क्.

आगत्य mfn. (-व्यः-व्या-व्य) 1. To be approached, accessible. 2. To be acquired. E. आङ् before गम् with यत् aff.

आगस् n. (-गः) 1. Sin. 2. Transgression, offence, fault. E. आग substituted for इण् to go, असुन् Una'di aff.

आगाध mfn. (-धः-धा-ध) Very deep : see अगाध.

आगान्तु mfn. (-तुः-ता-तु) A guest : see आगतु.

आगामिन् mfn. (-मि-मिनी-मि) 1. Arriving, coming. 2. Future. E. आङ् before गम् to go, णिनि aff.

आगार n. (-रः) A house, a dwelling : see अगार.

आगारदाह m. (-हः) Arson, setting a house on fire. E. आगार and दाह burning.

आगारदाहिन् m. (-ही) An incendiary. E. आगारदाह arson, and इनि aff.

आगुर् f. (-गुः) An agreement : see आगू.

आगुरव mfn. (-वः-वी-व) 1. Consisting of or containing Agallochum. 2. Very heavy. E. अगुर and अण् aff.

आगू f. (-गूः) An agreement. E. आगम to come, ल्युट् affix or आङ् prefixed to गू to come and क्नि affix ; also आगुर्.
