 आचार्योपासन n. (-न) Waiting upon or serving the spiritual preceptor. E. आचार्य and उपासना worship.  
 आचित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Heaped, accumulated. 2. Covered. 3. Spread, diffused. mn. (-तः-तं) 1. A measure of ten B'haras. 2. A cart-load. E. आङ् and the past participle of चिञ् to collect.  
 आचितिक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) Holding an A'chita. E. आचित and ठक् aff.  
 आचितीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Holding or equal to an A'chita. E. आचित and ख aff.  
 आचूषण n. (-ण) 1. Suction. 2. Application of cupping glasses or horns to the skin, &c. E. आङ् before चूष् to suck, ल्युट् aff.  
 आच्छ r. 1st cl. (-इ) आच्छि (आच्छति) To lengthen or stretch.  
 आच्छन्न mfn. (-न्नः-ना-न्नं) 1. Covered. 2. Clothed. E. आङ् before छद् to cover, affix क्त.  
 आच्छाक m. (-कः) A tree, (Morinda tinctoria.)  
 आच्छाद m. (-दः) Cloth, clothes. E. आङ् before छद् to cover, घञ् aff.  
 आच्छादन n. (-नं) 1. Cloth, clothes. 2. Covering, disappearance. 3. A covering, a sheath, mantle, cloak, &c. E. See the last, affix ल्युट्.  
 आच्छादित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Covered. 2. Clothed. E. आङ् before छद् to cover, affix क्त.  
 आच्छाद्य mfn. (-द्यः-द्या-द्यं) To be covered or clothed. ind. Having clothed or put on. E. आङ् before छद् to cover, causal form, यत् or ल्यप् affix ; also आच्छादनीय and आच्छादितव्य.  
 आच्छिन्न mfn. (-न्नः-ना-न्नं) Cut, cut off. E. आङ् before छद् to cut, क्त aff.

 आच्छेद m. (-दः) Cutting, cutting off, excision. E. आङ् before छिद् to cut, घञ् aff.  
 आच्छेदन n. (-नं) Excision. E. आङ् before छिद् to cut, ल्युट् aff.  
 आच्छेदन n. (-नं) Hunting, the chase. E. आङ् before चुद् to command, with ल्युट् affix, च becomes छ.

 आजकार m. (-रः) Siva's bull. E. आज from अज् to go, and कार what makes.  
 आजगव n. (-वं) The bow of Siva. E. See अजकाव.  
 आजानेय m. (-यः) A horse of a good breed. E. अज् to go, घञ् affix, आज् going : जानेय to be taken : who carries the rider through all opposition, &c.  
 आजि f. (-जिः) 1. War, battle. 2. Level ground. 3. An instant. 4. Abuse, reviling. 5. Going. E. अज् to go, इन् Una'di affix, and आङ् prefixed or अज् with इष् aff.  
 आजिक्रिया f. (-या) Fighting, making war. E. आजि and क्रिया act.  
 आजिगीषु mfn. (-षुः-षुः-षु) Ambitious, desirous to excel or overcome. E. आङ् before जि to conquer, in the desiderative form, affix लृच्.  
 आजिग्रह mfn. (-हः-हा-हं) What takes or seizes. E. आङ् before ग्रह् to take, श् aff.  
 आजिव m. (-वः) Livelihood, subsistence. E. आङ् before जीव् to live, घञ् aff.  
 आजिवन n. (-नं) Livelihood. E. आङ् before जीव् to live, ल्युट् aff.  
 आजिवनार्थ n. (-र्थः) Means of livelihood or subsistence, business, profession. E. आजिवन and अर्थ means.  
 आजिव्य mfn. (-व्यः-व्या-व्यं) 1. Habitable, fertile. 2. To be practised as a means of living. E. आङ् before जीव्य् to be lived, in or by.

 आज्ञप्ति f. (-प्तिः) Order, command. E. आङ् before ज्ञा to know with क्तिन् aff.  
 आज्ञा f. (-ज्ञा) An order, a command. E. आङ् before ज्ञा to know, and अङ् aff.  
 आज्ञाकर mfn. (-रः-री-रं) Obeying, obedient, performing an order. m. (-रः) A servant. E. आज्ञा and कर who makes.  
 आज्ञाकरण n. (-णं) Obedience, execution of orders. E. आज्ञा and करण doing.

 आज्ञाप्रतिघात m. (-तः) Disobedience, rebellion. E. आज्ञा and प्रतिघात re-belling.

 आज्यन n. (-नं) Partial extraction of thorns or arrows and the like from the body. E. आङ् before अज् to go, ल्युट् aff.  
 आज्यनेय m. (-यः) A name of the monkey HANUMA N. E. अज्यना the mother of HANUMA N, and ठक् patronymic affix which leaves एय.

 आटीकन n. (-नं) The leaping motion of a calf. E. आङ् prefixed to टीक् to go, ल्युट् affix ; also written आटीकर and आटीलक.  
 आटीकर m. (-रः) A bull. E. आटीक् leaping, and र who gets or uses.  
 आटीप m. (-पः) 1. Pride. 2. Flatulence, borborygmi. E. आङ् before टुप् a Sautra root, to be proud, and घञ् aff.  
 आङ्ग्वर m. (-रः) 1. Charge sounded by musical instruments. 2. The roaring of elephants. 3. A drum used in battle. 4. Commencement. 5. The eyelid. 6. Pride, arrogance. 7. Anger, passion. 8.
