 आत्मग्राहिन् mfn. (-ही-हिणी-हि) Selfish, greedy, taking care of one's self,
 appropriating, taking for one's self. E. आत्मन् and ग्राहिन् who seizes.
 आत्मघात m. (-तः) 1. Suicide. 2. Heresy, schism. E. आत्मन् and घात killing.
 आत्मघातिन् mfn. (-ति-तिनी-ति) 1. A suicide. 2. A heretic, a schismatic,
