

आपतन n. (-नं) 1. Coming, approaching. 2. Descending, alighting. 3. Happening. E. आङ् before पत् to go, लुट् aff.

आपतिक mfn. (-कः-कौ-कं) Accidental, unforeseen, sent from heaven. m. (-कः) A hawk, a falcon. E. आङ् before पत् to go, to fall, इकन् Una'di aff.

आपतित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Happened, befallen. 2. Alighted, descended. E. आङ् before पत् to go, affix क्त.

आपत्काल m. (-तः) Season of distress. E. आपद् and काल time.

आपत्कालिक mfn. (-कः-कौ-का-कं) Occurring in a time of calamity, belonging to it. E. आपत्काल and ठक् or ठज् aff.

आपत्ति f. (-त्तिः) 1. Misfortune, calamity. 2. Obtaining, procuring. 3. Fault, Transgression. 4. Remonstrance, expostulation. E. आङ् before पद् to go, क्तिन् aff.

आपत्प्राप्त mfn. (-प्रः-प्रा-प्रं) Unfortunate, unhappy, afflicted. E. आपद् misfortune, and प्राप्त obtained.

आपद् f. (-पद्-पत्) Misfortune, calamity. E. आङ् before पद् to go, क्तिप् aff.

आपद्ग्रस्त mfn. (-स्तः-स्ता-स्तं) Unfortunate, unhappy, in misfortune. E. आपद् and ग्रस्त seized.

आपद्धर्म n. (-र्मः) Practice or profession other than that proper to caste, but allowable in time of distress. E. आपद् and धर्म virtue.

आपदा fn. (-दा-दं) Misfortune, calamity. E. आङ् before पद् to go, अङ् and टाप् affs. ; also आपद्.

आपन n. (-नं) 1. Obtaining. 2. Pepper. E. आप् to obtain, ल्युट् aff.

आपनिक m. (-कः) 1. An emerald. 2. A barbarian. E. आङ् before पन् to praise, and इकन् Una'di aff.

आपन्न mfn. (-न्नः-न्ना-न्नं) 1. Unfortunate, afflicted. 2. Gained, obtained, acquired. E. आङ् before पद् to go, क्त participial aff.

आपन्नसल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Impregnated, pregnant. f. (-ला) A pregnant woman. E. आपन्न obtained, सल thing, substance, टाप् aff.

आपनित्यक n. (-कं) Property, &c. obtained by barter. E. अपनित्य having changed, ककन् aff. [and ठज् aff.]

आपराह्निक mfn. (-कः-कौ-कं) Occurring in the afternoon, &c. E. अपराह्न आपव m. (-वः) A name of VASSISHTHA.

आपस् n. (-पः) 1. Water. 2. Sin. E. आप् to obtain, असुन् aff.

आपस्कार n. (-रं) The root or extremity of the trunk or body. E. अपस्कर filth, अण् aff.

आपस्तम्ब m. (-म्बः) The name of a sage and legislator.

आपाक m. (-कः) 1. A potter's kiln. 2. A baking oven. E. आङ् before पच to bake, घञ् aff.

आपाखुर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Slightly pale, palish. E. आङ् dimin. पाखुर pale.

आपात m. (-तः) 1. Throwing down, causing to descend. 2. Falling, descending. 3. The instant, the current moment. E. आङ् before पत् to go, to fall, घञ् aff.

आपाततस् ind. Immediately, instantly. E. तसि added to the last.

आपान m. (-नः) A tavern, a liquor-shop, a place for drinking in society. E. आङ् before पा to drink, लुट् aff.

आपालि m. (-लिः) A louse. E. आङ् before पल to go, इन् affix ; the penultimate irregularly long.

आपी f. (-पी) The twentieth Nakshatra or lunar mansion.

आपीड m. (-डः) 1. Squeezing, compressing. 2. Giving pain, hurting. 3. A chaplet tied on the crown of the head. E. आङ् before पीड to pain, अच् affix.

आपीडन n. (-नं) 1. Squeezing, compressing, tying or drawing tightly. 2. Embracing, clasping. 3. Giving pain, hurting. E. आङ् before पीड to pain, affix ल्युट्.

आप्ति f. (-प्तिः) 1. Gain, acquisition. 2. Binding, joining. 3. Connexion, relation. 4. Fitness, aptitude. E. आप् to obtain, क्तिन् aff.

आप्तीक्ति f. (-क्तिः) 1. An augment or affix, (in grammar.) 2. A word of received acceptation, and established by usage only. E. आप्त received, उक्ति speech.

आप्य m. (-प्यः) The sign Aquarius.

आप्य mfn. (-प्यः-प्या-प्यं) 1. Watery, consisting of water, as froth, &c. 2. Obtainable, to be obtained. n. (-प्यं) A plant, a kind of costus. E. अप् water, यञ् affix ; or आप् to get, यत् aff.

आप्यान mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) 1. Stout, robust. 2. Fat. E. आङ् before स्नाय to grow, क्त aff.

आप्रपद n. (-दं) A dress reaching to the feet. E. आङ् and प्र before पद् a

आप्रपदीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) A dress reaching from the shoulders to the feet. E. आङ् and प्र prefixed to पद् a foot, ख aff.

आप्रपदीनक n. (-कं) See the preceding. E. कन् added.

आप्रव m. (-वः) 1. Bathing. 2. Sprinkling with water. E. आङ् before प्रुङ् to swim, अप् aff.

आप्रवन n. (-नं) 1. Sprinkling with water. 2. Bathing. E. आङ् before प्रुङ् to swim, affix ल्युट्.

आप्रव्रतिन् m. (-तौ) An initiated householder, one who has passed through the first order, that of the Brahmachari, and is admitted into the second. E. आङ् before प्रव्र bathing, व्रतिन् performer of a व्रत, or religious obligation ; bathing being part of the prescribed ceremony.

आप्रवाव m. (-वः) 1. Bathing. 2. Sprinkling, wetting. 3. A submerging. 4. A flood, an inundation. E. आङ् before प्रुङ् to swim, घञ् aff.
