बायाचित mfn. (-तः-ता-त्) Urgently requested or desired. E. बाङ् before वाच् to ask, क्त aff.

बायात mfn. (-तः-ता-त्) Come. E. बाङ् before यात gone.

बायान n. (-न्) 1. The natural temperament or disposition. 2. Coming, arrival. E. बाङ् before या to obtain, affix ल्युट्.

बायान m. (-न्) 1. Length, either in space or time. 2. Breadth, (in mensuration.) 3. Restraint, restraining. E. बाङ् before यम to cease, चञ् aff.

बायामिन् mfn. (-सी-मिनी-मि) 1. Long in space or time. 2. One who restrains. E. बायाम and इनि affix or बाङ् before यम् to cease and चिनुष् aff.

बायास m. (-सः) 1. Fatigue, weariness. 2. Effort, exertion. 3. Trouble, labour. E. बाङ् before यस् to endeavour, to make exertion, and चञ् affix.

बायसिन् mfn. (-सी-सिनी-सि) 1. Making exertion, active, laborious. 2. Exhausted by labour, wearied. E. बाङ् before यस् to endeavour, चिनुष् aff.

बायुःशेष m. (-शः) End of life, death. E. बायुस् and शेष end.

बायु mn. (-यु-यु) Age, duration of life. E. अच् to go, Una'di affix डु.

बायुक्त m. (-क्तः) A minister, an agent or deputy. E. बाङ् before युज् to join, and क्त aff.

बायुध m. (-धः) A weapon in general. E. बाङ् before युष् to fight, क्त aff.

बायुधवर्ध्निणी f. (-णी) A plant, (Eschynomene sesban) : see जयन्ती. E. बायुध a weapon and वर्ध्निणी possessing virtue : having the virtues of a weapon against disease, &c.

बायुधगार n. (-र) An arsenal, an armoury. E. बायुध and गार a house.

बायुधिक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) Relating to arms. m. (-कः) A soldier, a warrior. E. बायुध a weapon, and ठक् aff.

बायुधीय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Relating to or connected with weapons. m. (-यः) A warrior. E. बायुध and छण् aff.

बायुद्रव्य n. (-व्यं) A medicament. E. बायुस् life, and द्रव्य thing.

बायुर्वेद m. (-दः) 1. The science of medicine. 2. The collective writings of authority on medicine, or medical Sastra. E. बायुस् life, and वेद a Veda. [and मयट् aff.]

बायुर्वेदसय mfn. (-यः-वी-यं) Acquainted with medical science. E. बायुर्वेद

बायुर्वेदिन् mfn. (-दी-दिनी-दि) Belonging to medicine, of the medical profession, medical, medicinal, &c. m. (-दी) A practitioner of physic, a physician or surgeon. E. बायुर्वेद and इनि aff.
