इन्द्रल m. (-ल:) A portion of the moon, a digit, a crescent, &c. E. इन्द्र and दल a leaf.

इन्द्रुप m. (-प:) A name of Budha, regent of the planet MERCURY. E. इन्द्र and पच the son; the son of Chandra or the moon.

इन्हमत् m. (भृत्) A name of Siva E. इन्ह and सत् who nourishes; Siva wears a half moon on his forehead.

इन्दुमखन n. '-लं' The orb or disc of the moon. B. इन्दु and मण्डल sphere. इन्दुमती f. (-ती) 1. Day of full moon. 2. Name of a princess married to AJA the son of RAGHU. B. इन्द्र and मतुष् poss. affix, fem. इनिष्.

इन्द्र m. (-र:) A rat. E. उन्द to moisten, उर्च् affix, the initial is changed to इ.

इन्द्रत n. (-त') A pearl. E. इन्द्र and रत a gem.

इन्दरेखा f. (-खा A digit of the moon. E. इन्द and रेखा a line.

इन्दुनेखा f. (-खा) 1. A digit of the moon. 2. A plant, (Menispermum glabrum.) 3. The moon plant, (Asclepias acida.) 4. A kind of lovage, (Ligusticum ajwaen:) see चनामिता. E. इन्दु and लेखा a line,

इन्दुनीहक n. (-कं) Silver. E. इन्दु and लीइ iron, कन् added. [creeper. इन्दुनली f. (-ली) The moon plant, (Asclepias acida.) E. इन्दु and नली क इन्दुनत n. (-लं) A religious observance depending on the age of the moon; diminishing the quantity of food by a certain portion daily, for a fortnight or a month, &c. E. इन्दु and ज़त a religious obligation.

इन्द्रकीष m. (-ष:) 1. A platform, a scaffold. 2. A projection of the roof of a house, forming a kind of balcony or terrace. 2. A pin or bracket projecting from the wall. E. इन्द्र best, and कीष a place.

इन्द्रगीप m. (-प:) An insect, (Coccinella of various kinds.) इ. इन्द्र best, गी light, and प from पा who nourishes or possesses.

इन्द्रक्त्रस् n. (-न्द:) A necklace of a thousand strings. E. इन्द्र best, and कृन्दस् a necklace, &c.

इन्द्रजाख n. (-लं) 1. Conjuring, juggling. 2. Deception, cheating. 3. Trick or stratagem in war. ह. इन्द्र an organ of sense, and जान a net.

इन्द्रजालिक min. (-क:-की-कं) 1. A juggler, a conjuror. 2. Deceptive, unreal. B. इन्द्रजाल illusion, and उक् aff. [the conqueror of Indra.

इन्द्रजित् m. (-जित्) The son of RAVANA. E. इन्द्र and जित् who conquers: इन्द्रजिदिजयिन् m. (-यौ) LAKSHMANA, the brother of RAMA. E. इन्द्रजित् and विजयिन a victor, the conqueror of Indrajit.

इन्द्रत्व n. (-लं) A flock of cotton, a flocculent seed, &c. blown about in the air. E. इन्द्र and त्व cotton : Indra's cotton.

इन्द्रत्वक n. (-कं) See the preceding. E. As before, कन् added.

इन्द्राक m. (-क:) A tree, (Pinus devadaru.) E. इन्द्र and दाव tree.

बन्द्र m (-द्र:) A tree, ( Pentaptera arjuna, Rox.) E. बन्द्र and द्र a tree a staff of which is fit to carry the banner of INDRA.

इन्द्रम m. (-म:) See the preceding. E. As before.

इन्द्रनील m. (-ल:) A sapphire, E. इन्द्र best, and नील blue.

इन्द्रनीतन m. (-कः) An emerald. E. See the preceding.

इन्द्रपुषा f. (-था) A medicinal plant; also षशिजिहा. E. इन्द्र and पुषा a flower; also इन्द्रपुष्पिका. [INDRA presiding over it.

इन्द्रपुरीहिता f. (-ता) The asterism Pushya. E. इन्द्र and पुरीहिता priest, इन्द्र प्रस्थ m. (-स्थ:) Ancient Dehli. E. इन्द्र the deity, and प्रस्थ who presides.

इन्द्रमहर्ग n. (-जं) Indra s thunderbolt. E. इन्द्र and महरण a weapon.

इन्द्रभेषज n. (-जं) Dried ginger. E. इन्द्र best, and भेषज medicament.

इन्द्रमह्लामुक m. (-का:) A dog. B. इन्द्र, मह a sacrifice and कामुक desirous.

इन्द्रमुख n. (-खं) A flock of cotton : see इन्द्रतुख.

इन्द्रयव mn. (-व:-वं) The seed of the Wrighten antidysenterica. E. इन्द्र the plant, and यव seed : it is used medicinally in cases of diarrhœa, dysentery, &c.

इन्द्रजुत mn. (-म:-मं) Morbid, baldness, falling of the hair of the head : according to some authorities, loss of beard. E. इन्द्र best, जुन्न lost.

इन्द्रजप्तक m. (-क:) See the preceding. E. As before, जुन aff.

इन्द्रजीक m. (-क:) Swarga or paradise, the heaven of Indra. E. इन्द्र and जीक world.

इन्द्रजीकिश m. (-श्:) 1. Indra. 2. A guest, hospitality to whom secures paradise, E. इन्द्रजीक and ईश lord.

इन्द्रवाकिया f. (-का) Colocynth, a wild bitter gourd, (Cucumis colocynthis.) E. कन added to इन्द्रवाक्षी.

इन्द्रवार्गी f. (-गी) See the preceding. E. इन्द्र and वर्ग the two deities so called, affixes पण् and ङीप्; the favourite plant of Indra and Varuna.

इन्द्रबच m. (-च:) A kind of fir; see देवदात. E. इन्द्र for any god, इच a tree. इन्द्रबत n. (-तं) One of the duties of a king, to distribute gratification, as Indra pours down rain. E. इन्द्र and बन observance.

बन्दबडा f. (-डा) A sore, an ulcer.

इन्द्रमित f. (-ति:) Indrani, the wife or personified energy of Indra. E. इन्द्र and मित power. [the son of the sun.

इन्द्रसावर्षि m. (-र्ष:) The last of the fourteen Menus. E. इन्द्र and सावर्षि इन्द्रस्त m. (-त:) The monkey king Ball. E. इन्द्र and स्त a son; the son of Indra: the epithet is also applied to Arjuna and Jayanta.

इन्द्रस्रस m. (-स:) A shrub, the leaves of which are used in discutient applications, (Vitex negundo;) also सिन्द्रवार. E. इन्द्र best, स good, and रस juice; whose juice is excellent. [changed to इ.

इन्द्रसुत्स m. (-स:) See the preceding. E. As before, the pen. being इन्द्रसुत m. (-त:) The son of Indra: see इन्द्रसुत.

इन्द्राग्निषूम m. (-म:) Frost. [word.

इन्द्राणिका f. (-का) Vitex negundo: see इन्द्रसुरस. E. कन् added to the next इन्द्राणी f. (-णी) 1. The wife of INDRA. 2. A plant, (Vitex negumdo:) see the preceding. E. इन्द्र, डीव affix, and बानुक augment.

इन्द्रानुज m. (-ज:) A name of Vishnu. E. इन्द्र and बनुज younger born: the younger brother of Indra.

इन्द्रायुष m. (-प:) The rainbow. f. (-पा) A kind of leech of various tints on the back. s. इन्द्र and बायुष a weapon; Indra's weapon.

इन्हारि m. (-रि:) An Asura or demon. B. इन्ह and बरि an enemy.

इन्हावरज m. (-ज:) VISHNU. E. इन्ह and भवरज after-born; the younger brother of INDRA.

इन्ह्राभन m. (-न:) 1. Hemp, dried and chewed. 2. The shrub which bears the seed used as a jeweller's weight, (Abrus precatorius.) E. इन्ह्र and अभन food: the food of INDRA.

इन्द्रासन n. (-नं) 1. The throne of INDRA 2. Any throne. E. इन्द्र and अस्क a seat.
