 ईप्सन n. (-नं) Desiring, wishing to obtain. E. आप् to obtain, desiderative form, ल्युट् aff.
 ईप्सित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Wished, desired. E. आप् to obtain, desiderative form, क्त aff.
 ईप्सु mfn. (-सुः-सुः-सुः) Desirous, wishing to get or obtain. E. आप् to obtain, desiderative form, उस् aff.
 ईर r. 2nd cl. (ईरते) 1. To go. 2. To shake. r. 1st and 10th cls. (ईरति, ईरयति) 1. To go. 2. To throw or direct, to drive or force on; with उत् prefixed, to say or speak; with प्र, to send, to make to go; with सन्, to go like the wind.
 ईरिवस् mfn. (-वान्-युषी-वस्) 1. Gone, having gone. 2. Having obtained. E. ईष् to go, क्तसु aff. form irr.
 ईरिण mfn. (-णः-णा-णं) 1. Desert. 2. Saline and barren (soil). E. ऋ to go, and इरन् aff.

 ईर्ष्य r. 1st cl. (ईर्ष्यति) To envy, to feel impatient at another's prosperity.
 ईर्ष्य n. (-र्षं) A sore or wound. E. ईर् to send, and मक् aff.
 ईर्ष्या f. (-र्ष्या) Wandering about as a religious mendicant. E. ईर् to go, affix क्यप्.
 ईर्ष्वारु m. (-रुः) A cucumber, (Cucumis utilatissimus); also ईर्ष्वालु and ईर्ष्वारु, &c. [read ईर्ष्यां.]
 ईर्ष्या f. (-र्ष्या) Impatience, envy of another's success; more properly ईर्ष्यालु mfn. (-लुः-लुः-लुः) Impatient of another's success, envious. E. ईर्ष्या and आलुच् affix; see ईर्ष्यालु.
 ईर्षित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Envied. n. (-तं) Envy. E. ईर्ष्या and इतच् affix, or ईर्ष् with क्त aff.
 ईर्ष्य r. 1st. cl. (ईर्ष्यति) To envy.
 ईर्ष्य mfn. (-र्ष्यः-र्ष्या-र्ष्यं) Envious, envying. f. (-र्ष्या) 1. Envy or impatience of another's success. 2. Spite, malice. E. ईर्ष्य to envy, and अच् and टाप् affixes; also, but according to the best writers, inaccurately written ईर्ष्या.
 ईर्ष्यक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Envious, envying. E. ईर्ष्य and लुन् aff.

 ईर्ष्यालु mfn. (-लुः-लुः-लुः) Envious. E. ईर्ष्य and आलुच् affix; also written ईर्ष्यालु.
 ईर्ष्यावश mfn. (-शः-शा-शं) Being overcome with envy. E. ईर्ष्या and वश subjection.
 ईर्ष्यिन् mfn. (-र्ष्यि-र्ष्यि-र्ष्यि) Envious, spiteful. E. ईर्ष्या and इनि affix. So ईर्ष्यावत् (-वान्-वती-वत्) and ईर्ष्यामय (-यः-यी-यं.)
 ईलि f. (-लिः) See ईली. [to ल.]
 ईलित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Praised. E. इड् to praise, affix क्त, and ड changed
 ईली f. (-ली) A weapon, sometimes considered as a cudgel, and sometimes as a short sword, or a stick shaped like a sword. E. ईर् to go, &c. क्त and डीप् affixes, and र changed to ल; see इली; also ईलि, &c.

 ईशिता f. (-ता) Superiority, supremacy, one of the eight attributes of divinity. E. ईश a master, and तल् abstract affix; also ईशिल.
 ईशित m. (-ता) 1. A master, an owner or proprietor. 2. A king. E. ईश् to rule, and हच् aff.
 ईशिल n. (-लः) See ईशिता.
 ईश्वर m. (-रः) 1. The supreme ruler of the universe, God; it is therefore applied to all the different divinities, but mostly designates SIVA, in mythological and popular acceptance. According to the Sankhyas, Iswara is the liberated spirit; finite, according to KAPILA; infinite, according to PATANJALI. In the Nyaya system, Iswara is also a finite spirit endowed with attributes. In the Vedanta, Iswara is infinite and universal spirit, the cause and substance of creation. 2. A name of SIVA, especially in a compound, when the form of the deity implied is a Linga, as Visweswara, Someswara, Rameswara, &c. 3. KAMADEVA. mfn. (-रः-रा-री-रं) 1. An owner, a proprietor, a chief or head. 2. Able, competent. f. (-रा or -री) 1. A name of DURGA. 2. Of LAKSHMI, or of any other of the Raktis or female energies of the deities. E. ईश् to rule, and वरट् or वरच् affix, consequently डीप् or टाप् for the feminine.
 ईश्वरभाव m. (-वः) Royal or imperial nature. E. ईश्वर a sovereign, and भाव disposition.
 ईश्वरसभा f. (-भा) Royal court or assembly. E. ईश्वर and सभा an assembly.
 ईश्वराधीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Subject to a king, dependent on a master or on God, &c. E. ईश्वर, अधि over, ख aff.
 ईश्वराधीनता f. (-ता) Dependence upon God, subjection to a ruler. E. ईश्वराधीन and तल् added; also with ल, ईश्वराधीनल.
 ईष r. 1st cl. (इ) ईषङ् (ईषते) 1. To go or move. 2. To kill or hurt. 3. To see. 4. To give. (उ) ईषु (ईषति) To glean.
 ईष m. (-षः) The month Aswin: see इष.
 ईषजल n. (-लं) Shallow water, a little water. E. ईषन् and जल water.
 ईषत् ind. A little. E. ईष् to go, अत् aff.
 ईषत्कर mfn. (-रः-री-रं) 1. Diminutive, delicate. 2. Doing little. 3. What little is done to or made of. E. ईषत् a little, and कर what makes.
 ईषत्पान mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) What is little drunk or drank little of. E. ईषत् and पान drink. [profit.]
 ईषत्प्रलभ mfn. (-भः-भा-भं) What is little gained of. E. ईषत् and प्रलभ
 ईषदुष्ण mfn. (-णः-णा-णं) Tepid, slightly warm. E. ईषत् and उष्ण warm.
 ईषद्गुण mfn. (-णः-णा-णं) Of little merit. E. ईषत् and गुण quality. [pale.]
 ईषत्पाण्डु m. (-ण्डुः) A pale or light brown colour. E. ईषत् a little, and पाण्डु
 ईषत्युरुष m. (-षः) A mean man. E. ईषत् and पुरुष a man.
 ईषद्गुण mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Not quite complete or entire. E. ईषत् and गुण less.
 ईषद्दर्शन n. (-नं) A glance at, a slight inspection. E. ईषत् and दर्शन seeing.
 ईषद्हास m. (-सः) A smile. E. ईषत् a little, and हास laughter.
 ईषद्द्रक्त mfn. (-क्तः-क्ता-क्तं) Of a pale red (colour). E. ईषत् and रक्त red.
 ईषद्निमय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Exchanged for a little. E. ईषत् and निमय barter.
 ईषद्भ्रम mfn. (-भः-भा-भं) What little is or can be gained of. E. ईषत् and लभ what gets.
