

उद्भूत m. (-भूः) 1. Pure and virtuous man. 2. Tidings, intelligence. 3. One who gets a livelihood by a trade, &c. E. उद् disjunctive, and भून् end, term. [ing.]

उद्भूतक m. (-कः) News, tidings, intelligence. E. कन् added to the preced-
उद्भूतिका f. (-का) Satisfaction, satiety. E. उद् complete, भून् end, कन् aff.
उद्भूता f. (-त्वा) Thirst. E. उद्क् water, क् affix, the final क् is changed to न्.

उद्भवत् m. (-भवात्) The ocean. E. उद् water, and भवत् possessive aff.
उद्भात्र n. (-त्रं) A water-cup, a ewer. E. उद् water and पात्र a vessel.
उद्धान mn. (-नः) A well. E. उद् water, पा to drink, and छुट् affix; the place where water is drunk.
उद्देष n. (-षं) A paste, any thing ground with water. E. उद् water and पेष grinding.
उद्धार m. (-रः) 1. A cloud. 2. A water carrier. E. उद् water and भार a load.
उद्दय m. (-यः) Barley water. E. उद् and दय scum; also उद्दकमय.
उद्दमेघ m. (-घः) A watery cloud. E. उद् and मेघ a cloud.
उद्दय m. (-यः) 1. The rising of the sun and planets in general. 2. The eastern mountain, behind which the sun is supposed to rise. 3. Rising, ascending. 4. Light, splendor. 5. Prosperity, good fortune. 6. Creation, the rising of the world. 7. (In law) Income. E. उद् up, द्य to go, and अच् aff.
उद्दयन u. (-नं) Rising, ascending. m. (-नः) 1. A name of AGASTYA; see अगस्त्य. 2. The name of a sovereign, king of Kausambi, and hero of the Vasavadatta, a dramatic poem; also, of part of the Vrihat Katha. E. उद् above, द्य to go, and छुट् aff.
उद्दयपर्वत m. (-तः) The eastern mountain behind which the sun rises. E. उद्दय and पर्वत a mountain; also similar compounds, as उद्दयगिरिः, उद्दयशैलः, उद्दयाचलः, उद्दयाद्रिः, &c.
उद्दयिन् mfn. (-यि-यिनी-यि) 1. Rising, ascending. 2. Prosperous, flourishing. E. उद्दय and इनि aff.
उद्दर n. (-रं) 1. The belly. 2. War. 3. Any morbid abdominal affection, as liver, spleen, &c. f. (-रौ) Enlargement of the abdomen from dropsy or flatulency. E. उद् up, द् to go, अच् affix; what goes up or swells with food, slaughter, &c. or उद् prefixed to द् to burst, and अच् or अल् Una'di aff.
उद्दरक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) 1. Rubbing the belly, &c. 2. Abdominal. E. उद्दर and कन् aff.
उद्दरग्रन्थि m. (-ग्रन्थिः) The spleen, (the disease; a chronic affection of this organ not uncommon in India.) E. उद्दर abdomen, and ग्रन्थि a knot.
उद्दरघाण n. (-णं) 1. A cuirass, armour covering the front. 2. A girth, a belly-band. E. उद्दर the belly, and घाण what preserves.
उद्दरग्रि m. (-ग्रिः) 1. The ocean. 2. The sun. E. उद् freely, द् to go, and ग्रिर् Una'di aff.
उद्दरपिशाच mfn. (-चः-चा-चं) A glutton, voracious, one who devours every thing, flesh, fish, &c. E. उद्दर and पिशाच a demon, who is a devil for his belly.
उद्दरभ्रि mfn. (-रिः-रिः-रिः) Selfishly voracious, gluttonous. E. उद्दर, भ्र to nourish, इन् affix, and सुन् is inserted.
उद्दरग्रय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Sleeping on the face or belly. E. उद्दर and ग्रय who sleeps. [ness.]
उद्दरामय m. (-यः) Dysentery, diarrhœa. E. उद्दर the belly, and आमय sick-
उद्दरावर्त्त m. (-वर्त्तः) The navel. E. उद्दर and आवर्त्त whirl.
उद्दराविष्ट m. (-ष्टः) Tape worm. E. उद्दर and आविष्ट what surrounds.
उद्दरिन् mfn. (-रि-रिणी-रि) 1. Fat, corpulent. 2. Abdominal. f. (-णी) A pregnant woman. E. उद्दर the belly, इनि possessive aff.
उद्दरिल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Fat, corpulent. E. उद्दर the belly, and इलच् aff.
उद्दक m. (-कः) 1. Future or remote consequence. 2. Future time. 3. A plant (*Vangueria spinosa*;) see मद्दन्. E. उद् much, क् to praise, affix घञ्.

उद्दिग्ध mfn. (-ग्धिः-ग्धिः-ग्धिः) Luminous and ascending. m. (-ग्धिः) 1. A name of VAHNI or fire, 2. SIVA. 3. KANDARPA. E. उद् upwards, and दिग्ध flame.

उद्दं m. (-दं) Erysipelas. E. उद् up, दं to go, अच् aff.

उद्दलावणिक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) Salted, prepared with brine. E. उद् water, लवण salt and ठक् aff.
उद्दवज्जु m. (-जुः) A thunderbolt of water, a water spout. E. उद् and वज्जु a thunderbolt. [deriv. irr.]
उद्दवसित n. (-तं) A house. E. उद् water, and वसित covered, defended.
उद्दवास n. (-सं) 1. A house in the margin of a stream or pond. 2. A marine grotto, &c. E. उद् and वास abode.
उद्दवाहन m. (-नः) 1. A cloud. 2. Any water vessel. E. उद् and वाहन vehicle.
उद्दविन्दु m. (-न्दुः) A drop of water. E. उद् and विन्दु a drop.
उद्दव्यित् n. (-व्यित्) Buttermilk, with an equal proportion of water. E. उद् water, व्यि to increase, affixes क्तिप् and तुक्.
उद्दक्ष mfn. (-क्षः-क्षा-क्षं) 1. Cast, thrown. 2. Expelled, cast out. 3. Cast up. 4. Humbled, shamed. 5. Scattered. 6. Removed. E. उद् before अस् to throw, क् aff.
उद्दखाली f. (-खाली) A caldron, a kettle. E. उद् water and खाली a pot.
उद्दख ind. 1. Having taken pains, made an effort, &c. 2. Having thrown, having cast up or tossed. 3. Having scattered. 4. Having expelled. E. उद् before अस् to be or throw, खप् aff.
उद्दहार m. (-रः) 1. A water carrier. 2. A cloud. E. उद् and हार who takes.
उद्दाम m. (-जः) Commanding, directing bodies of men. E. उद् before अच् to go, घञ् aff.
उद्दान mfn. (-दानः-दानं) 1. Generous, gentle and bountiful. 2. Giving, a donor. 3. Great, illustrious. 4. Dear, beloved. 5. Accented. m. (-दानः) 1. The acute accent, a high or sharp tone. 2. Gift, donation. 3. A musical instrument, a large drum. 4. An ornament, (in rhetoric) E. उद् high, up, and दान pronounced, sounded; or from दा to give or have, with आङ् prefixed, affix क्त : see अनुदात्त.
उद्दान m. (-नः) 1. One of the five vital airs, that which rises up the throat and passes into the head. 2. The navel. 3. A snake. 4. An eye-lash. E. उद् above, आङ् prefixed to दान to breathe, to be, affix घञ्.
उद्दार mfn. (-रः-रा-री-रं) 1. Generous, liberal, munificent. 2. Great. 3. Unperplexed. 4. Gentle. 5. Upright, honest, sincere. 6. Eloquent. 7. Proper, right. E. उद् well, आङ् prefixed to द् to go, and अच् affixed.
उद्दारचेतस् mfn. (-तः-ता-तः) High-minded, magnanimous. E. उद्दार and चेतस् the mind.
उद्दारधी mfn. (-धी-धी-धि) Wise, sagacious, noble-minded. E. उद्दार and धी understanding.
उद्दावसर m. (-रः) A year, one of the five sorts of years astrologically considered. E. उद् and आङ् before वसर a year.
उद्दावर्त्त m. (-वर्त्तः) A disease of the bowels, iliac passion. f. (-ता) Difficult menstruation. E. उद् upper, आवर्त्त abode.
उद्दास m. (-सः) 1. Throwing or directing upwards. 2. Elevation, being above or over. 3. A stoic, a philosopher. 4. Stoicism. mfn. (-सः-सा-सं) Indifferent, unconcerned, apathetic. E. उद् and आस who casts.
उद्दासिह mfn. (-हा-ही-हं) Indifferent, disregarding, void of concern or affection. E. उद् before आस् to cast, हच् aff.
उद्दासिन् mfn. (-सि-सिनी-सि) Indifferent, disregarding. m. (-सि) A stoic, a philosopher, one who has no passion nor affection for any thing: in popular acceptation, a religious mendicant in general, or one of a particular order. E. उद्दास and इनि aff.
उद्दासीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) 1. Indifferent, free from affection. (In law,) One
