अस m. (-स:) 1. A city, a town. 2. A wharf, a landing place f. (-सा) 1.

A name of the goddess Parvati or Durga. 2. Light, splendor. 3.

Fame, reputation. 4. Turmeric. 5. Flax, (Linum utilatissimum.)
6. Quiet, tranquillity. E. उ particle of calling, and सा prohibition;
i. e. "Practise not austerities," the exclamation addressed to Durga by her mother; in the other senses it may be derived from सा to measure, or सा lustre.

डमासृत m. (-त:) A name Kartikeya. E. डमा and सुत a son, the son of Parvati.

उमेश m. (-म्;) A title of Siva. E. उमा and ईश a lord ; see उमापति.

जमा r. 6th cl. (प) (जमाति) To fill ; also जम.

उस n. (-सं) A field of linseed, (Linum utilatissimum.) E. उसा flax, and यत affix; also श्रीसीन.

उद्भर m. (-र:) The upper-timber of a door-frame. E. उद up, above, ह to screen, अप aff.

इस्बी f. (-स्बी) The stalks of wheat or barley fried over a fire of wet grass, considered as a tonic.

उर:चत n. (-तं) Injury of the lungs, breaking a blood-vessel, consumption. E. उरस् and चत lesion.

डर:खल n. (-लं) The breast, the bosom. E. डरस् the breast, and खल place. डर:स्विका f. (-का) A pearl-necklace. E. डरस् the breast, and स्व thread, टन् aff.

चर Sautra root. (चरति) to go.

उरग m. (-ग:) A snake. E. उरस् the breast, and ग who goes, from गम् to go, affix ड; also उरङ्ग and उरङ्गम.

उरते ind. A particle implying, 1. Assent. 2. Expansion: (it chiefly occurs in composition.) E. ने to weave, रशेन aff.

उररीकार m. (न्र:) A promise, an agreement. E. उररी, कार what makes. उररीकात min. (-त:-ता-तं) 1. Promised, agreed. 2. Spread, diffused. E. उररी and कत made.

उरम्हर m. (-द:) Armour, mail. E. उरस् the breast, and कृद a covering. उरस् mfn. (-रा:-रा:-र:) Best, excellent. n. (-र:) The breast, the bosom. E. स्ट to go, Una di affix सस्न्. the pen. changed to स ; also उर a Soutra root, to go, and सस्न as before.

उरसम् ind. From the breast. E. उरस् and तसि aff.

जरस्ताच n. (-चं) Mail, the breast-plate or cuirass. E. जरस् , नै to preserve, affix खुट्.

उरस्र mfn. (-स्थ:-स्था-स्थ') From the breast. mf. (-स्थ:-या) A legitimate son or daughter, that is, one born from a married couple of the same tribe or cast. E. उरस् the breast, and यत् aff.

उर्तर mfn. (-र:-रा-रं) Greater, larger. E. उन् and तरप aff.

उद्तम mfn. (-म:-मा-मं) Greatest. E. उद् and तमप् aff.

उदताप m. (-प:) Great heat. E. उद much, ताप heat.

उरल n. (-लं) Magnitude, vastness. E. उर and ल affix; also उरता.

उत्मार्ग m. (-र्ग:) A long road. E. उद and सार्ग a road.

उर्री ind. A particle, of 1. Assent. 2. Expansion : see उर्री.
