

कृत्रीय n. (-य) 1. A frying pan. 2. A hell. E. कृज् to fry, ईषन् Una'di affix : see कृचीय.

कृज् mfn. (-जुः-जुः-जु) 1. Straight. 2. Straight metaphorically, as in morals, upright, honest. E. कृज् to go, affix कृ. [body.]

कृजुकाय m. (-यः) A name of the saint KASYAPA. E. कृजु straight, काय

कृजुता f. (-ता) 1. Uprightness, sincerity. 2. Straightness. E. कृजु with ल् affix ; also with ल, कृजुल.

कृजुकरण n. (-च) Straightening. E. कृजु and करण making ; the vowel lengthened.

कृजुक्त mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Made straight. E. कृजु and क्त made ; the vowel lengthened.

कृत्र m. (-त्रः) A leader. E. कृज् to go, रन् Una'di aff.

कृत्रसान m. (-नः) A cloud. E. कृजि to go, शानच् Una'di aff.

कृष r. 8th cl. (उ) कृषु (अर्षीति or अर्षुते, कृषीति or -षुते) To go ; according to some it is कृन.

कृष n. (-च) 1. Debt. 2. A fort, a strong hold. 3. (In algebra,) Negative quantity, minus. E. कृ to go, क्त affix, deriv. irr.

कृषकटं mfn. (-तां-ची-तं) Getting into debt, indebted. E. कृष and कटं who makes. [re'zed.]

कृषयस्त mfn. (-स्तः-स्ता-स्तं) Indebted, involved in debt. E. कृष and यस्त

कृषयह m. (-हः) 1. Borrowing. 2. A borrower. E. कृष and यह taking.

कृषयाहिन् mfn. (-ही-हिणी-हि) Borrowing, a borrower. E. कृष and याहिन् who takes.

कृषदाह mfn. (-ता-ची-ह) One who pays a debt. E. कृष and दाह who gives. Also कृषद mfn. (-दः-दा-दं) and कृषदायिन् mfn. (-यी-यिनी-यि.)

कृषदान n. (-नं) Payment of debt. E. कृष and दान giving.

कृषमत्कृष m. (-षः) A security, a bail. E. कृष debt, मत्कृष an insect.

कृषमार्ग m. (-षः) A security. E. कृष, मृग् to cleanse, in the causal, and कृष् affix.

कृषमुक्ति f. (-क्तिः) Discharge of a debt. E. कृष and मुक्ति emancipation.

कृषमीच m. (-चः) Paying a debt. E. कृष and मीच released.

कृषवत् mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) Owing, in debt. E. कृष and मतुप् aff.

कृषशीघ्र n. (-नं) Payment or discharge of a debt. E. कृष and शीघ्र purifying.

कृषादान n. (-नं) Recovery of a debt, receipt of money, &c. lent. It is one of the eighteen titles or subjects of judicial procedure. E. कृष and आदान receiving.

कृषान्तक m. (-कः) The planet MARS. E. कृष, अन्त end, and क्त affix of agency : being the patron of debtors.

कृषापनयन n. (-नं) Discharge of a debt. E. कृष and अपनयन removing.

कृषापनीदन n. (-नं) Payment of a debt. E. कृष and अपनीदन removing.

कृषापाकरण n. (-च) Paying off a debt. E. कृष and अपाकरण acquittance.

कृषिक m. (-कः) A debtor. E. कृष debt, कृन् aff.

कृषिन् mfn. (-षी-षिनी-षि) 1. Indebted. 2. Of or belonging to a debt. m. (-षी) A debtor. E. कृष and इनि aff.

कृषीदयह n. (-षः) Recovering a debt in any way from the creditor, by friendly or legal proceedings, by stratagem, or by arrest. E. कृष and उदयह taking.

कृष mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Gone. 2. Enlightened, luminous. 3. Worshipped, respected. 4. True. n. (-तं) 1. Gleaning. 2. Water. 3. Truth. E. कृ to go, affix क्त.

कृषधामन् m. (-मा) A name of VISHNU. E. कृष luminous, धामन् abode ; whose residence is brilliant.

कृषय mfn. (-यः-व्या-व्यं) Seasonable, in season, relating to a season. E. कृषु and यत् aff.

कृषि f. (-तिः) 1. Prosperity, felicity. 2. A road, a way. 3. Abuse, censure, reproach. 4. Envy, emulation. 5. Going, motion. 6. Ill fortune. E. कृष and कृष् aff.

कृषिहर mfn. (-रः-री-र) Propitious, fortunate. E. कृषि and हर what makes.

कृषुपथ्याय m. (-यः) The revolution of the season. E. कृषु and पर्यय revolution.

कृषुप्राप्त mfn. (-प्तः-प्ता-प्तं) Fruitful, fertile, &c. productive in due season. E. कृषु season, and प्राप्त attained.

कृषुमती f. (-ती) A woman during menstruation. E. कृषु, मतुप् aff.

कृषुवृत्ति m. (-त्तिः) A year. E. कृषु a season, वृत्ति being.

कृषुराज m. (-जः) Spring. E. कृषु and राज king.

कृषुलिङ्ग n. (-ङ्गं) 1. A sign of the season. 2. A symptom of menstruation. E. कृषु and लिङ्ग a mark.

कृषुसन्धि f. (-न्धिः) The interval or junction between two seasons : the last seven days of one season and the first seven of the next. E. कृषु and सन्धि union. [suitableness.]

कृषुसाम्रा n. (-स्रा) Diet, &c. suited to the season. E. कृषु and साम्रा

कृषुस्नाता f. (-ता) A woman who has bathed after menstruation. E. कृषु and स्नाता bathed.

कृषते ind. Besides, except. E. कृषत Sautra root, to except, के aff.

कृषतीति f. (-क्तिः) Speaking truth. E. कृषत and उक्ति saying.

कृषुल m. (-लः) The close of a season. 2. The termination of menstruation. E. कृषु and अन्त term.

कृषुलिज् m. (-लिज्) 1. A domestic chaplain, a family priest. E. कृषु a season, यज् to worship, affix कृष्, deriv. irr.

कृषु mfn. (-हः-हा-हं) Prosperous, thriving, rising, &c. n. (-हं) 1. Stored grain. 2. A demonstrated conclusion, a distinct result. E. कृष् to grow, &c. affix क्त.
