ऋमञ्ज m. (-ञः) A name of SIVA. 2. A Jaina saint. E. ऋम and ञञ a sign; he whose symbol is a bull.

ऋषि m. (-षिः) A Rishi or sanctified personage so called: there are seven orders of these saints, as the Srutarshi, Kandarshi, Paramarshi, Maharshi, Rajarshi, Brahmarshi and Devarshi: the uncompounded name is especially applied to seven sages, of the Brahmarshi order, contemporary with each MANU; those of the present Manwantara, are MARICHI, ATRI, ANGIRAS, PULASTYA, Pulala KRATU and VASISHTHA: the names of each series differ: specified also form, in astrology, the asterism of the greater bear: the Rishi of a Mantra or mystic prayer in the Vedas, is the saint by whom it is supposed to have been remembered or recited. 2. A Veda. 3. A ray of light. 4. A saint or sanctified sage in general. f. (-षी) The wife of a Rishi. ऋषिजाङ्गलिकी f. (-की) A potherb, (Convolvulus argenteus:) see इहताडक.

E. ऋषि and जाङ्गलिक a dealer in antidotes, affix डीष्.

ऋषिप्रोक्ता f. (-क्ता) A plant: see माषपर्णी. E. ऋषि, प्रोक्त mentioned.

ऋषियज्ञ m. (-ज्ञः) The study of Scripture. E. ऋषि a sage, and यज्ञ sacrifice.

ऋषीवह mfn. (-हः-हा-हे) Bearing or conveying a Rishi. E. ऋषि and वह what bears, the final made long.

ऋषि f. (-षिः) A sword. E. ऋष् to go, affix णिन्.

ऋष्य m. (-ष्यः) The painted or white-footed antelope. n. (-ष्यः) A sort of leprosy. E. ऋष् to go, ऋष् affix: also ऋष्य, रिष्य.

ऋष्यकेतु m. (-तुः) A name of ANIRUDDHA the son of KANDARPA. E. ऋष्य and केतु a sign; having a deer for his symbol: some read this रिष्यकेतु, and others ऋष्यकेतु, ऋष्यकेतन, रिष्यकेतु, &c.

ऋष्यगता f. (-ता) A plant, (Asparagus racemosus.) E. ऋषि and ग before गत gone.

ऋष्यमन्वा f. (-न्वा) A potherb, (Convolvulus argenteus:) see इहताडक. E. ऋषि, मन्व priv. and मन्व smell.

ऋष्यजिह्व n. (-ह्वः) A sort of leprosy. E. ऋष्य the deer and जिह्व the tongue; to which the blotches are compared.

ऋष्यप्रोक्ता f. (-क्ता) 1. Cowach, (Carpogon pruriens.) 2. Asparagus racemosus. 3. Sida, (cordifolia and rhombifolia.) E. See ऋषिप्रोक्ता,

ऋष्यसूक m. (-कः) A mountain in the Daks'hin, the temporary abode of RAMA with the monkey-chief SUGRIVA. E. ऋष्य a deer, सूक dumb.

ऋष्यशङ्ख m. (-शङ्खः) The name of a holy sage celebrated in the first book of the Ramayana.

एककर mfn. (-रः-रा-री-रं) 1. Making one. 2. One-handed. 3. One-raised. E. एक and कर making, &c.

एककार्ये mfn. (-र्थः-र्या-र्यं) Performing the same office, answering the same end. E. एक and कार्य act.

एककाल m. (-लः) One or the same time. E. एक and काल time.

एककालभोजन n. (-नः) Eating but one meal in any given time. E. एककाल and भोजन food. [ing to time.]

एककालीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Coeval, cotemporary. E. एक and कालीन relat-

एककुण्डल m. (-लः) 1. A name of BALAHAMA. 2. An epithet of KUMARA. E. एक and कुण्डल an ear-ring: wearing it in one ear.

एकचीर n. (-रं) The milk of one (nurse; &c.) E. एक and चीर milk.

एकगुरु m. (-रुः) A spiritual brother, pupil of the same preceptor. E. एक and गुरु a religious preceptor; also with कन् added एकगुरुक.

एकग्रामीण mfn. (-णः-णा-णं) Of the same town or village. E. एक one, ग्रामीण villager.

एकचक्र m. (-क्रः) The name of a city: see ऋषिरुद्र. E. एक, चक्र a circle.

एकचर mfn. (-रः-रा-री-रं) 1. Solitary, alone. 2. Having one follower. m. (-रः) A rhinoceros. E. एक alone, and चर who goes.

एकचारिन् mfn. (-री-रिषी-रि) Going alone or with one follower only. m. (-री) A follower of BUDDHA. E. एक one, चर् to go, षिनि aff.

एकचित्त mfn. (-त्तः-त्ता-त्तं) 1. Thinking of one thing only, intent upon, absorbed in. 2. Of one mind, agreeing, concurring. E. एक one, चित्त the mind.
