- कपिरथ m. (-य:) A title of RAMA. E. किप and रथ a car; having been carried by his monkies.
- कपिल mfn. (-ल:-ला-लं) Tawny. m. (-ल:) 1. Kapila, a celebrated Muni or saint, the founder of the Sankhya system of philosophy: the son of Kerddama by Devahuti, and according to some, an avatar of Vishnu. 2.
