कर्णवेष्टन n. (-कं) An ear-ring : see the next.

कर्णनेष्टन n. (-नं) An ear-ring. E. कर्ण, and नेप्टन surrounding.

कर्णमजुली f. (-ली। The outer part of the ear, the cartilage and depressions leading to the auditory passage. E. कर्ण, and मजुल the hollows of the ear.

कर्णग्रुल n. (-लं) Ear-ache. E. कर्ण, and ग्रुल pain.

कर्षत्रव mfn. (-व:-वा-वं) Audible, loud. ह. कर्ण, and अब hearing.

कर्णसंसाव m. (-त:) Discharge of pus from the ear. B. कर्ण, and संसाव suppuration.

कर्णबाव m. (-व:) Discharge of ichorous matter from the ear. E. कर्ण, and बाव running.

कर्णास्त्राच m. (-स:) The flapping of an elephant's ear. E. कर्ण, and पास्त्राच with the same import.

कि जिस mfn. (-ज:-का-कं) 1. Having large or long ears. 2. Having ears. 3. Having a helm. m. (-क:) A steersman. f. (-का) 1. An ear-ring or ornament of the ear. 2. The pericarp of a lotus. 3.
