**क्षतवृत्ति** f. (-त्तिः) Destitution, being without the means of support, living on what one can get. **३.** क्षत and वृत्ति maintenance.

**क्षतव्रत** mfn. (-तः-ता-तः) A violator of a vow or religious engagement. **३.** क्षत broken. and व्रत a religious obligation,

**क्षतहर** n. (-रः) Agallochum or aloe wood : see अगुरु. **३.** क्षत a wound, and हर what removes.

**क्षतारि** mfn. (-रिः-रिः-रिः) Victorious, triumphant. **३.** क्षत struck, and अरि a foe.

**क्षति** f. (-तिः) A wound. **३.** क्षप् to hurt, क्तिन् aff.

**क्षतौजस्** mfn. (-जाः-जाः-जः) Weakened, reduced, impaired. **३.** क्षत, and औजस् strength.

**क्षत्** mfn. (-चा-क्षी-क्षु) Occupied, engaged in work, m. (-क्त) 1. A charioteer, a coachman. 2. A doorkeeper, a porter, 3. The son of a Sudra by Kshetriya woman, whose employment is catching animals that live in holes. 4. The son of a female slave. 5. A name of BRAHMA. 6. The son of a Sudra man and Vaisya woman. **३.** क्षद् a Sautra root, to screen or defend, to join or mix, Unadi affix टच्.

**क्षत्र** m. (-त्रः) A man of the second or military and regal class. n. (-क्ष) The body. **३.** क्षद् Sautra root, to divide or eat, Unadi affix त्; this word and its derivatives are commonly, for the sake of convenience, written with one त, क्षत्र.

**क्षत्रधर्म** m. (-धर्मः) The duty of a Kshetriya, bravery, military conduct. **३.** क्षत् and धर्म duty.

**क्षत्रधर्मानुग** mfn. (-गः-गा-गः) Following or observing the duty of a soldier. **३.** क्षत्रधर्म, and अनुग who follows.

**क्षत्रवन्धु** mfn. (-न्धुः-न्धु- or -न्धुः-न्धु) 1. A mere Kshetriya, a certain Kshetriya. 2. A Kshetriya, one of the military tribe : see ब्रह्मवन्धु.

**क्षत्रिण** m. (-त्री) A man of the military class. **३.** क्षत् and इति aff.

**क्षत्रिय** mf. (-यः-या or याणी) A man or woman of the second or military tribe. f. (-यी) The wife of a Kshetriya. **३.** क्षत्र, affix घ, fem. टाप् or डीष्, in one form, with आनुक् inserted.

**क्षत्रियजाति** f. (-तिः) The military tribe or caste. **३.** क्षत्रिय, and जाति caste.

**क्षत्रियधर्म** m. (-धर्मः) The duty or occupation of the warrior tribe, war, government, &c. **३.** क्षत्रिय, and धर्म duty.

**क्षत्रियप्राय** mfn. (-यः-या-यः) Full of or abounding with the military tribe. **३.** क्षत्रिय, and प्राय most.

**क्षद्** Sautra r. 1st cl. (क्षदति) 1. To eat. 2. To pull to pieces, to divide.

**क्षम** (उ, ष, जि) लिचसुष r. 1st cl. (क्षमते) To bear or endure. (उ, इर, ष इरक्षसुभ r. 4th. cl. (क्षाम्यति) To bear or endure.

**क्षम** mfn. (-मः-मा-मः) 1. Patient, resigned, enduring. 2. Refraining from, forbearing. 3. Able, adequate. 4. Benevolent, friendly. 5. Fit, appropriate, suitable, proper. f. (-मा) 1. Patience. 2. The earth. 3. Night. 4. A name of DURGA. n. (मं) Propriety, fitness. **३.** क्षम as above, affix ञच्.

**क्षमान्वित** mfn. (-तः-ता-तः) 1. Patient, enduring. 2. Forgiving. **३.** क्षमा, and अन्वित possessed of.

**क्षमापर** mfn. (-रः-रा-रः) Patient, forbearing. **३.** क्षमा, पर practising.

**क्षमासुज** mfn. (-जः) Patient. m. (-क्ष) A king, a prince. **३.** क्षमा, the earth, &c. and सुज् who possesses.

**क्षमायुक्त** mfn. (-क्तः-क्ता-क्तः) Patient, enduring, **३.** क्षमा. and युक्त joined with.

**क्षमावत्** mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) Patient, enduring. **३.** क्षमा, and सत्तुप् aff.

**क्षमिह** mfn. (-ता-क्षी-ह) Patient, enduring. **३.** क्षम् to bear, affix टच्.

**क्षमिन्** mfn. (-मी-मिनी-मि) 1. Patient. 2. Capable, able. **३.** क्षम् to bear, विनुष् aff.

**क्षय** m. (-यः) 1. Loss, waste, destruction, removal, &c. 2. A destruction of the universe. 3. Consumption, Phthisis pulmonalis. 4. A house, an abode. 5. Sickness in general. 6. Decay, wasting away. 7. In algebra, negative quantity, minus. **३.** क्षि to waste or destroy, अस् aff.

**क्षयकर** mfn. (-रः-री-रः) 1. Destroying, terminating. Liberating, from existence. **३.** क्षय, and कर who makes.

**क्षयकाल** m. (-कालः) The end of all things, the period of destruction. **३.** क्षय, and काल time. [cough.

**क्षयकास** m. (-सः) A consumptive or phthisical cough. **३.** क्षय, and कास

**क्षयरोग** m. (-गः) Consumption. **३.** क्षय, and रोग disease.
