

चितिभृत् m. (-भृत्) 1. A prince, a king. 2. A mountain. E. चिति, and भृत् who nourishes.

चितिमण्डल n. (-ल) The earth, the globe. E. चिति, and मण्डल circle.

चितिरुह m. (-रुह) A tree. E. चिति the earth, and रुह what mounts.

चितिवर्धन m. (-नः) A corpse. E. चिति the earth, and वर्धन what increases.

चितिसुत m. (-सुतः) 1. A name of the demon NARAKA, also of 2 Mars. E. चिति and सुत a son.

चितिश m. (-शः) A king. E. चिति, and ईश a prince.

चितिशर m. (-शरः) A king. E. चिति and ईशर a king.

चित्यदिति f. (-दितिः) The mother of KRISHNA. E. चिति the earth, and दिति the mother of the gods; the terrestrial parent of divinity.

चित्वन् m. (-त्वा) Air, wind. E. चि to go, Unadi affix, क्त्विप्, त inserted.

चिद् r. 1st cl. (चिदति) To utter an inarticulate sound, to moan as in grief.

चिप (चौ) चोचिप r. 4th cl. (चिप्यति) (ज, चा) चोचिज् r. 6th cl. (चिपति-ते) To throw or cast, to direct or send. With चधि, prefixed, To abuse, to censure or reproach. With चन, To throw down. With चाङ् 1. To attract. 2. To ridicule. With उत्, To raise up, &c. With नि, To place, to deposit. With प्र, To throw far or violently. With वि To scatter, to disperse. with वि and नि, To deliver over, to resign, to leave. With सम and चाङ् To remove, to send away. With सम्, 1. To abridge, to compress or contract. 2. To disappear.

चिप m. (-पः) 1. Throwing, casting. 2. Reviling. 3. One who throws, &c. f. (-पत्) 1. Sending, casting, throwing, &c. 2. Night see चपा E. चिप् to throw, affix क्.

चिपक m. (-कः) A warrior, a fighter. E. चिप throwing or directing, (darts, &c.) क् Unadi aff.

चिपण n. (-ण) 1. Sending, dismissing, throwing, casting, &c. 2. Reviling, abusing. E. चिप् to throw, &c. affix छट् the radical vowel unchanged.

चिपणि m. (-णिः) A missile weapon f. (-णिः-णी) An oar. E. चिप् to throw to cast, Unadi affix णि, and the radical vowel unchanged.

चिपणु m. (-णुः) Air, wind. E. चिप् to throw or send, to waft, Unadi affix णु.

चिपण्यु mfn. (-ण्युः-ण्युः-ण्युः) 1. fragrant, sweet-smelling. 2. Diffusive, what may be sent or scattered. m. (-ण्युः) 1. The body. 2. Spring, the season of spring. E. चिप् to send, &c. कण्युच् Unadi affix.

चिपत् mfn. (-पत्-पत्नी-पत्) 1. Throwing, casting. 2. Abusing, reproaching E. चिप् to throw, affix शट्.

चिप् mfn. (-प्-प्-प्) Obstructive, throwing obstacles in the way; also चिप्यु E. चिप् to cast, &c. क् aff.

चिप्त mfn. (-प्तः-प्तः-प्तः) 1. Thrown, cast. 2. Sent, despatched 3. Dismissed. f. (-प्ता) Night; also चिपा and चपा E. चिप् to throw, &c. affix क्.

चिप्तदेह mfn. (-हः-हा-हं) Prostrate, lying down. E. चिप्त, and देह the body.

चिप्ति f. (-तिः) 1. Throwing. 2. Sending, ordering. 3. Solving a riddle, explaining or understanding a hidden meaning. E. चिप् to throw, क्त्विप् aff. [send, शट् aff.

चिप्यत् mfn. (-प्यन्-प्यन्ती-प्यत्) 1. Throwing. 2. Sending. E. चिप 4th cl. to चिप्यमाण mfn. (-णः-णा-णं) 1. Tossing, throwing 2. Casting aside, throwing off. 3. Sending, directing. E. चिप and शानच् aff.

चिप्र mfn. (-प्रः-प्रा-प्रं) Quickly, speedily, quick, swift. adv. n. (-प्रं) Quickly. E. चिप् to send or despatch, Unadi affix रक्.

चिप्रपाकिन् m. (-की) A kind of tree, (Hibiscus populneoides:) see गर्डूमाण्ड E. चिप्र quick, and पाकिन् what ripens.

चिया f. (-या) Loss, waste, destruction. E. चि to waste, चङ् and टाप् affixes, इ substituted for the penultimate.

चिव (उ) चिवु r. 4th cl. (चोच्यति) To eject from the mouth, to vomit.

चौर r. 1st cl. (चौरति-ते) To hurt or injure.

चौज r. 1st cl. (चौजति) To sound inarticulately, to sigh or groan as in distress.

चौजन n. (-जं) The whistling of hollow reeds or bamboos. E. चौज् to sound inarticulately, affix ख्युट्.

चौष mfn. (-षः-षा-षं) 1. Thin, emaciated, feeble. 2. Thin, slender. 3. Wasted, diminished, worn away, expended. 4. Destroyed, lost. 5. Injured, broken, torn. 6. Subdued, suppressed. 7. Poor, miserable. E. चि to waste, affix क्त, deriv. irr.

चौषला f. (-ला) 1. slenderness, delicacy. 2. Thinness, emaciation. 3. Diminution, decay. E. तल् added to the last; also with ल्, चौषल.

चौषपाप mfn. (-पः-पा-पं) Purified, having suffered the consequences of sin. E. चौष, and पाप sin.

चौषपुण्य mfn. (-ण्यः-ण्यः-ण्यं) 1. Abandoned. 2. Having enjoyed the fruits of virtue, and being doomed by another birth to labour for more. E. चौष, and पुण्य virtue.

चौषमध्य mfn. (-ध्यः-ध्या-ध्यं) Slender-waisted. E. चौष, and मध्य middle.

चौषवत् mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) Wasted, decayed. E. चि to waste, and क्तवत् aff.

चौषवासिन् mfn. (-सी-सिनी-सि) Inhabiting a destructible house. m. (-सी) A dove or pigeon. E. चौष, and वासिन् abiding.

चौषविक्रान्त mfn. (-न्तः-न्ता-न्तं) Cowed, deprived of courage or prowess. E. चौष, and विक्रान्त valiant.

चौषवृत्ति mfn. (-त्तिः-त्तिः-त्ति) Out of employ. out of bread, having no maintenance. E. चौष lost, and वृत्ति practice.

चौषशक्ति mfn. (-क्तिः-क्तिः-क्ति) Weak, feeble, impotent. E. चौष, and शक्ति vigour.

चौषाण्यकर्मन् m. (-र्मा) A Buddha.

चौषाण्यकर्मन् m. (-र्मा) A Jina, an inspired teacher according to the Jainas. E. चौष, and षट्कर्मन् eight natural acts.

चौव (चट्) चौवृ r. 1st cl. (चौवते) To be intoxicated, (literally or metaphorically.)

चौव mfn. (-वः-वा-वं) Drunk, intoxicated. E. चौव् to be drunk, affix क्त, deriv. irr.

चौवता f. (-ता) Intoxication. E. तल् added to the last; also with ल्, चौवल.

चौवमाण्य mfn. (-ण्यः-णा-णं) Perishing, wasting away. E. चि to perish, शानच् aff.

चौर n. (-रं) 1. Water. 2. Milk. f. (-री) A small shrub (Asclepia rosea); also दुग्धिका. 2. A tree, a species of Mimosa, (M. kauki, Rox) also चौरिका. 3. Gigantic swallow-wort. 4. Euphorbia; several kinds, particularly, E. hirta. E. thymifolia, and E. chamæsyce. E. चस् to eat, ईरन् Unadi affix; the fem. nouns are derived from चौर milk. the plants yielding a milky juice or sap, upon expression or incision.

चौरकण्ड m. (-ण्डः) An infant, a young child. E. चौर milk, and कण्ड throat; also with कन् added चौरकण्डक.

चौरकान्दा f. (-न्दा) A kind of potherb, black Bhuincaonra, (Convolvulus paniculatus.) E. चौर water, and कन्द root; having a watery root.

चौरकाकोलिका f. (-का) A drug, and one of the eight principal medicaments of the Hindus; it is a root from the Himalaya. E. चौर milk, and काकोलि a drug, कन् added; yielding, when fresh, a milky juice; also चौरकाकोली.

चौरकाकोली f. (-ली) See the preceding.

चौरकौट m. (-टः) An insect or animalcule generated by the fermentation of milk. E. चौर milk, and कौट a worm.

चौरज n. (-जं) Coagulated or curdled milk. E. चौर milk, and ज produced.

चौरद mfn. (-दः-दा-दं) What gives or yields milk. E. चौर, and द what gives.

चौरदल m. (-लः) Gigantic swallow-wort. E. चौर milk, and दल leaf; the leaves, &c. yielding, on expression or incision, a milky juice.

चौरनीर n. (-रं) Embracing, embrace. E. चौर milk, and नीर water; mixing like milk and water.
