

चेषण n. (-ण) 1. Sending, directing. 2. Throwing, casting. 3. Passing away time. 4. Abusing. E चिप् to throw, affix ल्यट्.

चेषिण f. (-णि: or णी) 1. An oar. 2. A net, a fishing net. E, चिप् to cast or throw, ञ् and डीप् affs.

चेपिमन् m. (-म) Great velocity. E. चिप् quick, and इमनिच् affix, deriv irr.

चेपिष्ठ mfn. (-ष्ठ: -ष्टा-ष्ठ) Very quick, quickest. E. चिप् quick, and इष्ठन् superlative affix, र rejected.

चेपीयस् mfn. (-यान्-यसी-यः) Very quick. E. चिप्, and ईयसुन् aff.

चेम् mfn. (-ता-मू-मू) Who or what throws, sends, orders, &c. E. चिप् to throw, टच् aff.

चेम mfn. (-म: -मा-मं) Happy, well, prosperous, right, &c. mn. (-म: -मं) 1. Happiness, well being. 2. Preserving, protecting, keeping what is acquired. 3. Final emancipation or eternal happiness. 4. The proper term of civil address to Vaisya, as चेममस्ति चेमं भवतु Is it well, or may it be well, &c. f. (-मा) A name of DURGA. E. चि to remove, and मन् Unadi affix; what removes or destroys sorrow, &c.

चेमक m. (-क:) A perfume, commonly Chor. E. कन् added to चेम.

चेमकर mfn. (-र: -रा-रं) Propitious, conferring happiness or good fortune. E. चेम and क् to make, ञ्च् aff.

चेमकार mfn. (-र: -री-रं) Auspicious, propitious, conferring happiness or good fortune. E. चेम happiness, and क् to make, ञ्च् aff.

चेमङ्कर mfn. (-र: -री-रं) Propitious, &c. : see the preceding. f. (-री) The Brahmani kite or Coromandel eagle, which is considered as a bird of good omen, (Falco ponticeriaus.) E. चेम and क् to make, with खच् aff.

चेमवत् mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) Happy, prosperous. E. चेम and मतुप् aff.

चेमफला f. (-ला) Opposite leaved fig tree. E. चेम auspicious, and फल fruit.

चेम्य mfn. (-म्य: -म्याम्यं) 1. Lucky, prosperous, thriving. 2. Healthy, salubrious. E. चेम and यत् added.

चेव (ङ) चैव r. 1st cl. (चैवति) To spit, to eject from the mouth.

चे र. 1st cl. (चायति) To wane, to waste or decline.

चेच n. (-च) A multitude of fields &c. E. चैव a field, &c. and ञ्च् aff.

चेचज्ञ n. (-ज्ञ) Spirituality, the nature of the soul. E. चैवज्ञ and ञ्च् aff.

चेचज्ञा n. (-ज्ञा) Spirituality, the nature of the soul, the knowledge of it, &c. E. चैवज्ञ and यच् aff.

चेरेयी f. (-यी) Milk and rice, or any preparation of milk. E. चीर milk, aff. टच् fem. affix डीप्; some copies read this word चीरेयी.

चोड m. (-ड) The post to which an elephant is bound.

चोजन n. (-नं) Sound of the flute.

चोणि f. (-णि: or णी) The earth. E. च् to sound, ञ्णि affix, fem affix optionally डीप् also चोणि.

चोद m. (-द:) 1. Powder, pulverized substance. 2. A piece, a small piece or particle. 3. The stone or slab on which any thing is ground or powdered, a mortar, &c. 4. Dust. E. च्द to bruise or pound, affix ञ्च्.

चोदारज mfn. (-ज: -जा-ज) Ground, pulverized. E. चोद and रज for रजस् dust.

चोदित mfn. (-त: -ता-त) Pounded, ground, comminuted. n. (-त) Powder, dust, substance pulverized or ground E. च्द to bruise or pound, affix क्.

चोदिमन् m. (-म) Minuteness, exceeding smallness or inferiority. E. च्द small, &c. affix इमनिच् deriv. irr.

चोदिष्ठ mfn. (-ष्ठ: -ष्टा-ष्ठ) Finely pounded or levigated, very small or minute. E. च्द small, इष्ठन् affix of the superlative, र rejected.

चोदीयस् mfn. (-यान्-यसी-यः) Very fine or small. E. च्द and ईयसुन् affix of the superlative.

चोभ m. (-भ:) 1. Agitation, emotion. 2. Shaking, trembling, tossing. E. च्भ् to be agitated, ञ्च् aff.

चौम mn. (-म: -मं) A room on the top of a house: see चौम n. (-मं) Wove silk E. च् to make a sound, Unadi affix मन्; also चौम.

चोणि f. (-णि: or णी) The earth, E. चोणि the earth, and ञ्च् pleonastic, with इन् or डीप् fem. terminations added.

चोणोप्राचीर m. (-र:) The ocean. E. चोणी the earth, and प्राचीर an enclosure.

चोद n. (-दं) 1. Honey. 2. Water. m. (-द्र:) A flower, (Michelia cham-paca.) E. च्द्रा a fly, &c. affix ञ्च्.

चोदक्य mfn. (-क्य: -क्यी-क्यं) Small, minute. E. च्द्र small, चाट् pleonastic aff.

चोम mfn. (-म: -मी-मं) Linen, made of linen, covered with it, &c. f. (-मी) Lin or flax, (Linum usitatissimum.) mn. (-म: -मं) 1. An airy room on the top of a house. 2. An apartment on the top of a hall. 3. The back of an edifice. 4. A fortified place in front of a building. 5. A building of a particular form 6. Wove silk: 7. Linen cloth E. चौम q. v. ञ्च् added.

चौमक m. (-क:) Chor, a species of perfume.

चौर m. (-र:) 1. Shaving the head. 2. Shaving in general. f. (-री) A razor. E. चुर a razor, affix ञ्च्.

चौरिक m. (-क:) A barber. E. चुर a razor, affix टक्.

चूर् r. 2nd cl. (चूर्ति or with सम् prefixed संचूर्ते) To whet, to sharpen. (चूर्ति) To take away, to remove.

चूर्त mfn. (-त: -ता-त) Whetted, sharpened. E. चूर् to whet, affix क्.

च्चा f. (-च्चा) The earth. E. च्च् to bear, Unadi affix ञ्च्, and the penultimate dropped.

च्चातल n. (-लं) The surface of the earth. E. च्चा, and तल below.

च्चासुज् m. (-ज्) A king. E. च्चा, and भुज् who enjoys.

च्चायत् m. (-यत्) 1. A king, a prince. 2. A mountain. E. च्चा the earth, and भत् who nourishes, from च्च्, affix क्णिप्, तुक् added.

च्चाय (ङ) च्चायी r. 1st. (च्चायते) To shake, to make tremble.

च्चायित mfd. (-त: -ता-त) Shaken, trembling. E. च्चाय, and क् aff.

च्चायिष्ठ mfn. (-ष्ठ: -ष्टा-ष्ठ) Trembling, shaking. E. च्चाय, and टच् aff.

च्चील r. 1st cl. (च्चीलति) To wink or twinkle, to close as the eye lids.

च्चील्य mfn. (-ल्य: -ल्यी-ल्यं) 1. Sounded, 2. Soft, unctuous. E. च्चीद् to sound, &c. क् aff.

च्चीद (-जि, चा) च्चीदिदा r. 1st cl. (च्चीदति) To sound inarticulately. r. 4th cl. (च्चीदति) 1. To be unctuous, to be soft or bland. 2. To liberate, to free: some consider these roots as more properly read च्चीद्.

च्चीड mfn. (-ड: -डा-ड) 1. Crooked, bent. 2. Wicked, depraved. m. (-ड:) 1. Venom, poison. 2. Sound, noise. 3. Tingling or buzzing in the ear, from hardening of the wax, &c. 4. Ghosha, with yellow flowers; see चोष. n. (-ड) 1. The flower of the Ghosha plant. 2. The fruit of a red kind of swallow wort. f. (ङा) 1. A war whoop, a battle cry. 2. A bamboo rod or stake. E. च्चीद् to sound inarticulately, to be soft or bland, &c. affix च, and ड् substituted for द, or च्चुल् to shake, &c. ञ्च् affix, and ल् changed to ड्.

च्चीडित n. (-तं) A battle cry, a war whoop. E. च्चीद् to sound inarticulately, affix क्.

च्चील (ङ) च्चील r. 1st cl. (च्चीलति) 1. To shake, to tremble. 2. To go, to move.
