- गङ्गाचिल्ली f. (-ल्ली) The black headed gull, (Larus ridibundus.) E. नङ्गा the Ganges, and चिन्नो a kite, considered by the Hindus as a species of that bird; the Gangetic kite.
- गङ्गाज m. (-ज:) 1. A name of Bhishma. 2. A name of the deity Karti-KEYA. E. TET the river goddess, and of born; the son of GANGA.
- मङ्गाजल n. (-ल:) The water of the Ganga. E. गङ्ग, and जल water.
- सङ्गाढेय mfn. (-य:-यी-यं) Going in or to the Ganges. m. (-य:) A shrimp or prawn ; also गलाविल. E. गङ्गा the river, and पर to go, पन् affix, गङ्गार, and इस added.
- नहाहार n. (-रं) The place where the Ganga enters the plains; also Haridwar, E. गङ्गा, and हार gate.
- महातीर n. (-रं) The bank of the Ganga. E. महा, and तीर a bank.
- गहाचर m. (-र:) 1. An epithet of Siva. 2. The ocean. E. गहा the Ganges. and we who possesses or receives; according to the legend, the Ganges in its descent first alighted on the head of SIVA, and continued for some period entangled in his hair.
- गङ्गापार n. (-रं) The bank of the Ganges. E. गङ्गा, and पार the bank.
- बहापुच m. (-च:) 1. Bhishma. 2. A man of a mixed and vile caste, employed to remove dead bodies. 3. A Brahman who conducts the ceremonies of pilgrimage at some places on the Ganges, especially at Benares. E. 181, and ya a son.
- गञ्जामध्य n. (-ध्यं) The bed or stream of the Ganges, E. गङ्का, and सध्य centre.
- बहान्द n. (न्द्) 1. Pure rain water, such as falls in Aswin. 2. Ganges water. E. गङ्गा, and प्रस्त water.
- गङ्गयावा f. (-वा) 1. Pilgrimage to the Ganga. 2. Carrying a sick person to the river side to die there. E. बहुन, and याचा going.
- गङ्गासूत m. (-त:) 1. A name of KARTIKEYA. 2. A name of the hero BHISHMA : see गङ्गाज. E. गङ्गा, and सत् a son ; the son of GANGA.
- गङ्किका f. (-का) The Ganges. E. गङ्का, and कन affix fem. from ; also गङ्कका, and महाका.
- गङ्गीभृत mfn. (-त:-ता-तं) Become as the Ganges, as sacred, &c. E. गङ्गा. and भूत become, चि augment.
- गच्छ m. (-चः) A tree. E. गम् to go, and स Unadi affix, what goes or grows ; also अगच्छ.
- गच्छत् min. (-च्छन्-च्छन्ती-च्छत्) Going. E. गम् to go, श्रत aff.
- गज r. 1st cl. (गजित) To be drunk, to be confused or inebriated ; r. 1st and 10th cls. (गजति, गजयित) also (इ) गिज r. 1st cl. (गञ्जति) To sound.
- गज m. (-ज:) 1. An elephant. 2. A measure of length, the Gaz, a yard, a measure of two cubits. 3. A mound of earth sloping on both sides, on which a house may be created. 4. A small hole in the ground for a fire, over which to prepare medicines. E. गज to sound, to roar, affix अच्.

- गजटका f. (-का) A kettle-drum carried on an elephant. E. गज an elephant, and zer a large drum.
- गजाता f. (-ता) A multitude of elephants. E. गज an elephant, तल aff.
- गजदञ्च mfn.(ज:-ज्ञी--ज्ञ') As high or tall as an elephant E. गज, and
- गजदन m. (-न:) 1. A name of GANESHA. 2. Ivory, the elephant's tooth. 3. A bracket or pin projecting from the wall. E. 43 a elephant. and इन a tooth ; GANESHA is represented with an elephant's head.
- गजदान n. (-नं) The liquor exuding from an elephant's temples. E. गज and दान the same.

- गजिपपनी f. (-ली) A plant bearing a seed which resembles pepper, (Pothos officinalis) E. नज an elephant, and पिपली long pepper ; considered to be a large species of pepper : see similar names, as aft-पिपाली, इसकचा, &c.
- बाजपुद्धव m. (-व:) A large and excellent elephant. E. बाज, and पुद्धव implying eminence.
- गज्युट m. (-ट:) A small hollow for a fire, over which to prepare medical decoctions, extracts, &c. E. 151, and uz a hollow.
- गजपिया f. (-या) The gum olibanum tree, (Boswellia serrata.) E. गज an elephant, and प्रिय beloved; also वसनी.
- गजबन्धनी f. (-नी) A post to which an elephant is bound, B. गज, and बन्धन a binding.
- गजभचक m. (-क:) The sacred fig tree. E. गज, and भचक eater ; the young branches of the Pipal being the elephant's favourite food.
- गजभचा f. (-चा) The gum olibanum tree : see गजप्रिय E. गज an elephant and भन्ना food; also गजभन्या.
- गजमखिला f. (-का) A ring or circle of elephants surrounding a car. &c. E. गज, मण्डल a circle, कम affix fem. form.
- गजमाचल m. (-ल:) A lion. E. गज an elephant, मा fortune, and चल what goes: the destroyer of the elephant.
- गजमात mfn. (-त:-ती-चं) As tall as an elephant. E. गज, ond माचच ् aff.
- गजमुत्ता f. (-ता) A pearl, supposed to be found in the head of an elephant. E. गज, and मुक्ता a pearl.
- गजमीटन m. (-न:) A lion. E. गज an elephant, सूट to run away, in the causal from, affix खाट ; or with मुच् to go, गजनीचन as it is sometimes read.
- गज्यथ m. (-य:) A herd of elephants. E. गज, and यथ a herd.
- ब्जबद्द m. (-न:) A name of GANESHA, who is represented always with the head of an elephant. E. गुज, and ब्दन a face.
- ৰ্বব্ৰ mfn. (ব:-লা-ন') Who walks like an elephant. n. (-ল') 1. A troop of elephants. 2, The pace of an elephant. E. गज, and बज a number or going, who goes, &c.
