गत्वगुण mfn. (-च:-चा-चं) Having the property of odour. E. नन, and गुण quality.

गमत्राच n. (-च') Smelling any odour. E. मस, and नाचं smelling.

गन्धचेलिका f. (-का) Musk. E. गन्ध fragrance, चेलि clothes, affix क्रन् ; being used for scenting clothes.

गम्बजात n. (-तं) The leaf of the Laurus cassia. ह. गम्ब smell, जीत produced ; fragrant.

গৰ্মা f. (-লা) The nose E. নৰ scent, and লা who knows.

गसतूर्य n. (-खं') A musical instrument, one of a loud sound used in battle: (a drum or trumpet.) E. गस pride, and तूर्य a musical instrument.

गसदण n. (-w') A fragrant grass, (Andropogon scheenanthus.) E. गस, and दश grass.

गमलच् f. (-लक्) A sort of perfume, commonly Elabaluka. B. गम and लच् skin, rind.

गम्बद्धिप m. (-प:) An elephant of the best class, supposed to emit a particular smell at all times. E. गम्ब, and द्विप an elephant.

गस्यूचि f. (-चि:) Musk, the fragrant secretion of the musk-deer. ष्ट. गस्य fragrant, and यूचि dust.

गसन n. (-न) 1. Continued effort, perseverance. 2. Injury, hurting, killing. 3. Intimation, information. 4. Manifestation. E. गस् to hurt, to move, &c. affix खंड.

गसनजुल m. (-ल:) The musk-rat of Bengal. (Sorex moschata.) E. गस scented, and नजुल an ichneumon.

गमनाजुली f. (-ली) A plant, possibly the serpent Ophioxylon : see रासा, E. गम smelling, and नाजुली the same plant.

गमनामन् m. (-सा) A fragrant kind of basil. E. गम fragrance, and नामन् a name.

गमनाली f. (-ली) The nose. E. गम scent, and नाली tubular canal.

गन्धनिलया f. (-था) Double jasmin, (J. Zambac floribus multiplicatis.) E. गन्ध smell, and निलय a house.

गसपच m. (-न:) A white sort of basil, (Ocymum gratissimum:) see श्रीतपर्णास f. (-नी) l. A sort of zedoary. (-ना) Ajwaen, (Ligusticam ajwaen.) 2. Another plant, (Physalis flexuosa.) ह. गस, and पन a leaf.

गत्वपलाणिका f. (-का) Turmeric. E. गत्व smell, पलाभ a leaf.

गन्धपलाशी f. (-शी) Zedoary, (Curcuma zerumbet.) E. गन्ध and प्लाश a leaf. गन्धपालाचा m. (-च:) Sulphur. E. गन्ध smelling, and पालाचा a stone.

गन्यपिशाचिता f. (-का) The smell of incense, diffusive incense. E. गन्य smell funtचिता female demon; imp-like, from its dark colour or cloudy nature; or attracting demons by its fragrance.

गत्यपीता f. (-ता) A species of zedoary. E गत्य and पीत yellow.

गमपुष m. (-ष:) 1. A kind of cane, (Calamus rotang.) 2. Another plant, (Alangium hexapetalum :) see बद्धीट. 3. Sebesten. (Cordia myxa.) f. (-षा) 1. The indigo plant. 2. Ganiyari, (Premna spinosa, &c.) see गियारी. n. (-ष') Flowers and Sandal presented together at seasons of worship. E. गम smell, and पुष flower; having odoriferous flowers.

गन्यफ m. (-त:) 1. Elephant or wood apple : see निषय 2. The Bel, (Ægle cratæva.) f. (-ता or -ती) 1. A plant bearing a fragrant seed: see प्रियङ्ग 2. The gum olibanum tree. f. (-ती) The blossom of the champaca : see चम्पन. E. गन्ध smell, and फल a fruit.

गत्मनांसी f. (-सी) A kind of Indian spikenard : see जटानांसी.

गन्समाद f. (-ता) The earth. E. गन्स scent, and साद the mother; the property of fragrance residing in the earth or earthy atoms.

गसमादन mn. (न:नं) The name of a particular mountain, forming the division between Ilavritta and Bhadraswa or to the east of Mern. m. (न:) 1 A large black bee. 2. Sulphur. 3. The name of one of the monkey chiefs. f. (नी) Spiri tuous liquor; also in some books read गसमादिनी. E. गस smell, मद to inebriate in the causal form and खाट aff.

गन्धमादिन् mfn. (-दी-दिनी-दि) Strong scented, of intoxicating odour. f. (-नी) 1. Lac, 2. A sort of perfume. 3. Wine or spirituous liquor. E. गन्ध and सादिन what intoxicates.

गन्धम् च m. (-ल:) A plant with a fragrant and tuberous root, one of the Scitaminea, (Alpinia galanga:) see जुलझन. f. (-ला or लो) 1. A species of Cucumber, (C. reclinata, Rox.) 2. The olibanum tree. E. जन्म smell and मृल a root, fem. affix टाप् or ड्रोष् also with कन् affix गन्धमृलक.

गन्धमूलक m. (-क:) A sort of Cucumber also गन्धमूली ; see the preceding. गन्धमूषिक mf. (-क:-का) The musk-rat or shrew, (Sorex moschata;) also in the fem. गन्धमूत्री.

गन्धरंग m. (-गः) The civet-cat. E. गन्ध smell, and स्म a deer; the name also may be applied to the musk-deer.

गन्धमीदन n. (नं) Sulphur, E. गन्ध, and मीदन pleasing.

गन्धमैथुन m. (-नः) A bull. B. गन्ध smell, and मैथुन copulation.

गत्यमीहिनी f. (-नी) The champaca flower. E. गत्य smell, and मीहिनी de lighting.

गन्दस m. (स:) Myrrh. E. गन्द smell, and रस essence; also रसगन्द

गन्धराज n. (-ज') 1. Sandal. 2. Any sweet smelling flower. f. (-जी) 1. A sort of perfume, commonly, Nak'hi : see नखी. E. गन्ध smell, and राज what excels, from राज to shine, affix অব ; fem. affix ভীব.

गमर्के m. (क्ये:) 1. A Gand'harba or celestial musician; these demigods inhabit Indra's heaven, and form the orchestra at all the banquet of the principal deities. 2. A horse. 3. A kind of deer; according to some authorities, the musk-deer. 4. The soul after death, and previous to its being born again, corresponding, in some respects to the western notion of ghosts. 5. A singer in general. 6. The Kokila or black cuckoo. 7. The sun. 8. A sage, a pious man.
