One of the tutelary female deities of the Jainas. 3. A plant (Hedysarum alhagi.) 4. Prickly nightshade. E. गन्ध the aggregate of गन्ध smell, &c. ग् to go and च् affix; the note being said to be produced by pure and fragrant breath, &c. गान्धरिय m. (-यः) A name of DURYOD'HANA, the son of DHRITARASHTRA. E. गान्धारी the name of the mother of this chief, and ठक् aff.

गान्धिक m. (-कः) 1. A scribe, a clerk. 2. A vender of perfumes, a perfumer. 3. A kind of worm, having a strong fetid smell. E. गन्ध smell, and ठक् aff.

गामुक mfn. (-कः-का or -की-कं) Going, locomotive. E. गम् to go, उक् aff.

गान्धीय n. (-यः) 1. Depth, (of water, sound, &c.) 2. The deep sound of the voice of a jaina saint, like distant thunder or the muttering of clouds. E. गन्धीर deep, affix यञ् or ज्.

गायक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) Singing, one who sings. m. (-कः) A singer. E. गी to sing, लृक् aff.

गायत् mfn. (-यन्-यन्ती-यत्) Singing. E. गी to sing, affix श्ठ.

गायत्रिन् m. (-त्री) A tree that yields the resin formerly called Terra Japonica, (Mimosa catechu;) also गायत्री fem. noun, as below.

गायत्री f. (-त्री) 1. A measure of verse in the Vedas, a stanza usually of twenty-four syllables, variously arranged, but most commonly in three lines. 2. A sacred verse from the Vedas to be recited only mentally; this is usually personified and considered as a goddess, the wife of BRAHMA; the metaphorical mother of the three first classes, in their capacity of twice born, investiture with the sacred and distinguishing string, &c. being regarded as a new birth; there is but one Gayatri of the Vedas, but according to the system of the Tantrikas, a number of mystical verses are called Gayatris; each deity has one in particular. 3. A kind of mimosa, (M. catechu;) see the preceding, &c. E. गायन् who sings, and त्री to preserve, affixes क् and लृक्; this applies especially to the mystical verse, the repetition of which is necessary for salvation; the word is also written गायत्री.

गायन mfn. (-नः-नी-नं) Singing, a singer. m. (-नः) 1. A singer. 2. A chatterer, a gossip. n. (-नः) 1. Singing 2. Professing or practising singing as a livelihood. E. गी to sing, aff. लृट्.

गारिव m. (-वः) Rice, grain, corn. E. ग् to swallow, Unadi affix यिचन्.

गारुड m. (-डः) 1. Gold. 2. A Mantra or charm against poison. 3. An emerald. E. गारुड the vehicle of VISHNU, and च् affix; of or relating to GARUDA.

गारुडिक m. (-कः) A charmer, a dealer in antidotes. E. गारुड the mantra of GARUDA, or a charm against venom, and ठक् aff.

गारुडी f. (-डी) Hog-weed, (Boerhavia diffusa alata.)

गारुडम् n. (-म्) The emerald. E. गारुडम् GARUDA, and च् affix; derived from or relating to GARUDA; the gem is supposed to be generated from his voided phlegm.

गार्ग mfn. (-र्गः-र्गी-र्गं) Descended from the sage GARGA. E. गर्ग, and च् aff.

गार्गिक n. (-कः) A multitude of the descendants of the saint GARGA. E. गार्ग a descendant of GARGA, and बहु affix of multitude; also with ठक्, गार्गिक.

गार्गीपुत्रकायनि m. (-निः) A descendant of the son of GARGI. E. गार्गी the wife of the saint GARGA, पुत्र a son, and फिच् affix, क् augment; also without the augment गार्गीपुत्रकायनि, or with इच् affix, गार्गीपुत्रि.

गार्गी mfn. (-र्गीः-र्गी-र्गा) Descended from the GARGA, son, daughter, &c. E. गर्ग and च् aff.

गार्गी mfn. (-र्गीः-र्गी-र्गा) 1. Derived from a vulture. 2. Greedy. m. (-र्गः) 1.

Desire, greediness, cupidity. 2. An arrow. E. गृह् greedy, affix च्, or गृह् with च् affix, and र rejected optionally.

गार्गीपक्ष m. (-क्षः) An arrow. E. गार्गी and पक्ष a wing; formed with vulture's feathers.

गार्गीपत्र m. (-त्रः) An arrow. E. As before, पत्र a leaf, a wing.

गार्गी n. (-र्गी) 1. Greediness. 2. Desire. E. गृह् greedy, यच् aff.

गार्गी, mfn. (-र्गीः-र्गी-र्गा) Derived from a vulture, E. गृह् and च् aff.

गार्गीपक्ष m. (-क्षः) An arrow. E. गार्गी, and पक्ष a wing.

गार्गी mfn. (-र्गीः-र्गी-र्गा) 1. Uterine, foetal. 2. Relating to conception, (any act or ceremony, &c.) E. गर्भ and च् aff.

गार्गीक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) 1. Foetal, uterine. 2. Relating to or connected with gestation or the foetus in utero. E. गर्भ and ठक् aff.

गार्गीय n. (-यः) A number of pregnant woman. E. गर्भिणी a pregnant woman, and च् aff.

गार्गीय n. (-यः) An assembly of pregnant women. E. गर्भिणी as above, and यच् aff.

गार्गीय m. (-यः) A sacred fire perpetually maintained by a household-er, received from his father, and transmitted to his descendants, and from which fires for sacrificial purposes are lighted. E. गृह्पति a householder, (from गृह् a house, and पति master,) and य् referential aff. [यच् aff.]

गार्गीय n. (-यः) The order or estate of a householder. E. गृह्य and गाल m. (-लः) 1. Flowing, liquefying. 2. Flowing, dropping. 3. A flux. E. गल् to flow, च् aff.

गालन n. (-नः) 1. Straining fluids. 2. Fusing, liquefying, &c. E. गल् to flow, causal form, affix लृट्.

गालव m. (-वः) 1. A tree, the bark of which is used in dying, Lod'h, (Symplocos recemosa, Rox.) 2. A pale species of the same: see लोह. 3. A kind of ebony; also कौटुक, (Diospyros glutinosa.) 4. A particular Muni or saint, a disciple of VISWAMITRA. E. गाल flux, and व what prevents; referring to the astringent qualities of the Lod'h.

गालि m. (-लिः) A curse, execration or imprecation. E. गल् in the causal from to cause to drop, and इन् aff.

गालित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Melted, fused. 2. Strained. 3. Distilled, dropped. E. गल् to drop, causal form, क् aff.

गालिन् mfn. (-ली-लिनी-लि) 1. Fusing, liquefying. 2. Distilling 3. Abusive, abusing. f. (-नी) A particular gesticulation or Mudra. E. गल् to flow, causal form, यिनि aff.

गालीय n. (-यः) The seed of the lotus.

गाह (ज) गार्ह r. 1st cl. (गाहते) 1. To churn, to stir or agitate. 2. To penetrate. 3. To destroy. With च् or वि prefixed, To bathe, to perform ablutions. With वि, to shake, to agitate.

गाहित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Shaking, trembling. 2. Destroyed. 3. Plunged into, immersed. E. गाह् to agitate, क् aff.

गाहित mfn. (-ता-ची-ह) 1. Shaking, agitating. 2. Destroying, a destroyer. 3. One who plunges into water, bathes, dives, &c. E. गाह् to agitate, ह् aff.

गिर् f. (-गीः) 1. Speech, speaking. 2. A name of SARASWATI the goddess of speech. 3. Fame, celebrity. E. गृ to sound, affix क्, च् is changed to इर्.

गिरण n. (-णः) Swallowing. E. गृ to swallow, लृट् aff.

गिरा f. (-रा) Speech. गृ to sound, क् and टाप् affs.

गिर mfn. (-रिः-रिः-रि) Venerable, respectable worshipful. m. (-रिः) 1. A mountain, a hill. 2. A wooden ball with which children play. 3. A disease of the eyes. f. (-रिः) 1. Swallowing. 2. A small rat, a mouse. 3. A title given to one order of the Dasnami Gosains. E. गृ to swallow, &c. इ Unadi aff.

गिरिकण्डक m. (-कः) INDRA'S thunderbolt. E. गिरि a mountain, and कण्डक a thorn, tearing or splitting rocks.
